The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Kentucky Wesleyan College Panthers in Great Midwest Athletic Conference action tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville is 1-10 (0-0 G-MAC) on the year after dropping their tenth consecutive game 68-62 in overtime on Dec. 21 at Maryville in St. Louis, Missouri.

Kentucky Weslevan is 7-6 with a 2-0 G-MAC record. The Panthers lost their most recent contest to NCAA #9 Southern Indiana 80-68 on Dec. 21 in Evansville, Indiana, KWC is the unanimous choice to win the 2013-14 G-MAC title in voting by the league's coaches.


The Yellow Jackets are under the leadership of 6th-year head coach Pat Estepp (119-54, .688). He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

Four players are hitting in double-figures for Cedarville after the first 11 games of the 2013-14 season.

Topping the scoring list is junior guard Marcus Reineke who is tossing in 15.7 points per game. He also leads the team with 23 three-point field goals.

Junior guard Jason Cuffee is averaging 12.6 points per game while grabbing a team-best 5.5 rebounds per contest.

Freshman J.C. Faubion adds 10.6 points and four rebounds per game. He is also connecting at a team-best .816 clip from the free throw line with team-highs of 31-of-38.

The Panthers are led by first-year head coach Happy Osborne who previously spent 15 years at NAIA-powerhouse Georgetown College.

Pacing the KWC attack is senior Lonnie Hayes with a 19.8 ppg scoring average. The 6-2 slashing guard also tops the Panthers with an impressive 90-of-114 effort at the free throw line.

Ken-Jah Bosley is the second-leading scorer at 16.6 points per contest. The rookie guard leads the team with 23 three-point field goals.

Dominique Dawson, a 6-8 senior center adds 10.8 points to the offense while grabbing a teambest 8.1 rebounds per game.

Lucas Barker, a 6-0 sophomore guard, contributes 5.3 points while leading KWC with 50 assists and 24 steals.

The Yellow Jackets are scoring 71.5 points per game (7th in G-MAC) while allowing 86.3 points per night (6th in G-MAC).

Kentucky Wesleyan averages 82.7 points per contest (3rd in G-MAC) while allowing opponents 73.7 (3rd in G-MAC). The Panthers lead the Great Midwest Athletic Conference and NCAA II with 323 made free throws.

Kentucky Weslevan won the only other previous meeting with the Yellow Jackets - an 83-68 Panther win on December 10, 2011 in Owensboro, Kentucky.

Last Time Out



ST. LOUIS, Mo. - Maryville scored the only six points of overtime to hold off the Yellow Jackets, 68-62. in a non-conference men's basketball contest on Saturday, Dec. 21.

Brian Grant's three-point play with seven seconds left in regulation forced the extra session. Cedarville missed all five of its shots in the five-minute period while falling in overtime for the second time in the last three games - both coming against Great Lakes Valley Conference members.



After Maryville, 6-3 overall, jumped out to a 13-5 lead, CU recovered and made it close the rest of the way. The largest advantage either team had in the final 34 minutes of regulation was five points.



The Yellow Jackets' last lead was 57-56 with 3:51 to go on a three-pointer by Lane Vander Hulst, who finished with a season-high 14 points. Grant totaled 11 points and 8 rebounds while J.C. Faubion chipped in 11 points.



Head Coach Pat Estepp

Pat Estepp has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estepp was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCCAA Championship.



Cedarville was 23-9 performance during their NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estepp was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Mideast Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament

Estepp's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estepp's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estepp took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Mideast Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estepp. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estepp was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estepp spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estepp comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estepp also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 12, and Grant, 9, as well as daughter, Merynn, 3.

Walter Brock has been named the G-MAC Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the second time

after scoring a G-MAC high 30 points this past week, while also grabbing 10 rebounds, which was second in the conference last week.

In the team's only game last week, against Glenville State, the Tigers dropped a close game 102-93 battle. Brock had a team-high 30 points on 7-13 shooting and was a perfect 15-15 from the free throw line. He added 10 rebounds, including four offensive, with three assists, two steals and one blocked shot in only 25 minutes of action.

With his scoring efforts last week, Brock has moved into a tie for fourth among the scoring leaders at 16.6 points per game. He also ranks among the best in the conference with 6.6 rebounds per game, ranking seventh. Despite his solid performance, he actually lowered his season shooting percentage which stands third in the G-MAC at 64.6%.

Brock leads his team in both scoring and rebounding, coming on a roster that combines to score 98.6 points per game as a team.






