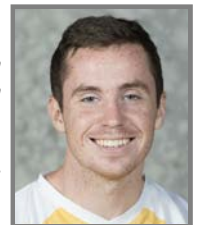

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Mercyhurst University Lakers in a non-conference game tonight at Yellow Jacket Field. It is also Senior Night.

Cedarville is currently 6-6-2 overall including a 1-0 Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) win at Malone University on Saturday.

The Lakers, NCAA II members of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC), are 10-3-1 in 2016. Mercyhurst posted a 4-0 victory against visiting league foe Lock Haven on Saturday.

The Yellow Jackets are under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach Brett Faro (48-17-10).

Sophomore midfielder Bryce Childers leads the squad in scoring with four goals and an assist for nine points.

2015 G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year and fifth-year forward Connor Gilmour, although being hampered by injury, is second on the team with four goals for eight points. He is fourth all-time at CU with 47 career goals.

Junior John Schwien is the Jackets' third-leading scorer with a goal and a team-high four assists.

Jon Brown and Sebastian Duque have two goals each.

Yellow Jacket senior keeper Paulo Pinto ranks second in CU's career goals against average list (0.89). Pinto has allowed 14 goals in 10 games this year while making 42 saves.

Mercyhurst is led by Head Coach Nenad Vidakovic. He is in his second year of coaching with the Lakers (19-11-2).

Graduate student Thom Derks tops the Lakers scoring charts with 14 goals and four assists for 32 points.

Rookie forward Jorge Gonzalez is second on the team with 19 goals and a pair of assists for 22 points.

Alex Brems, a sophomore keeper, is getting most of the action in goal this season. He has three shutouts and a 1.16 goals against average while making 47 saves.

The all-time series between the schools is tied at 1-1. The Lakers took the first meeting 2-0 on Oct. 27, 2014 in Erie, PA. CU notched a 2-1 win on Sept. 30, 2015 in Cedarville.
