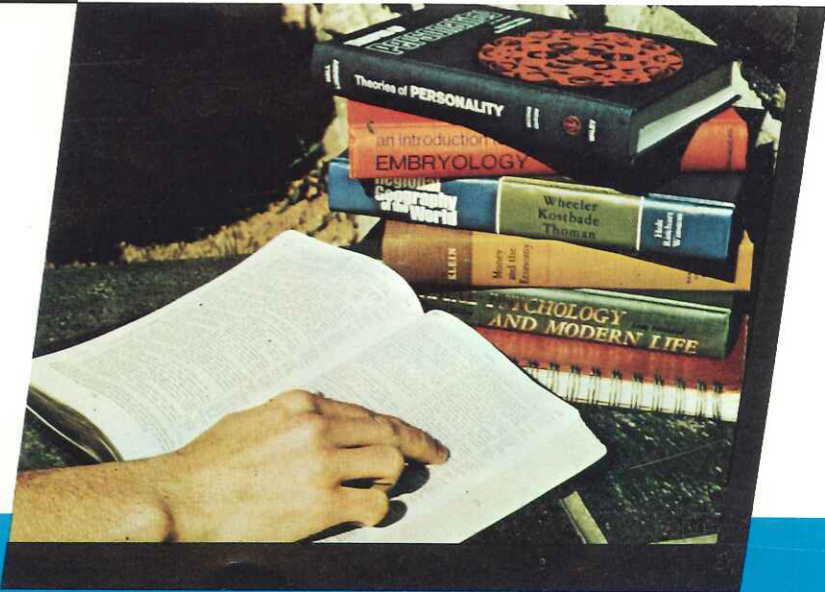

The campus plan reveals the present and the future network of facilities on the 105 acre campus.

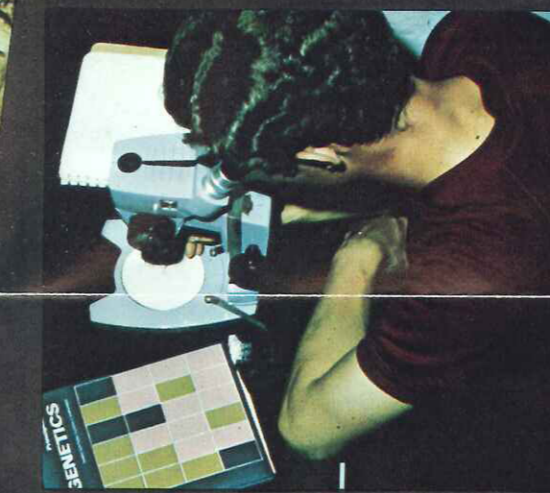
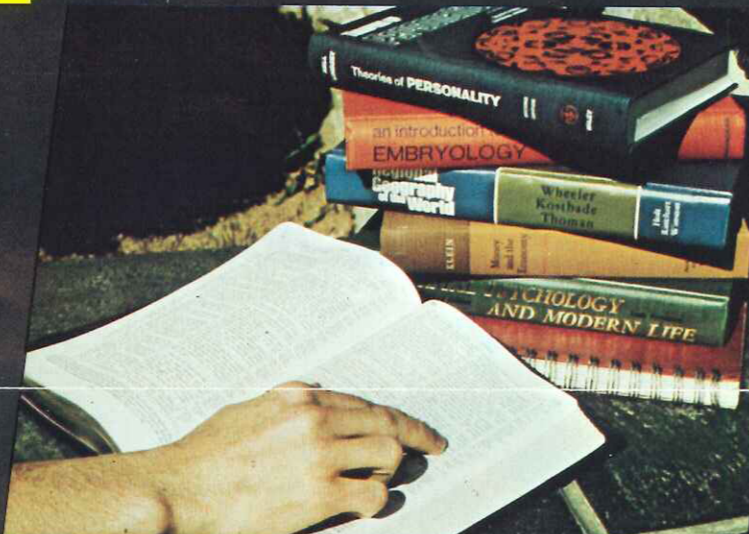
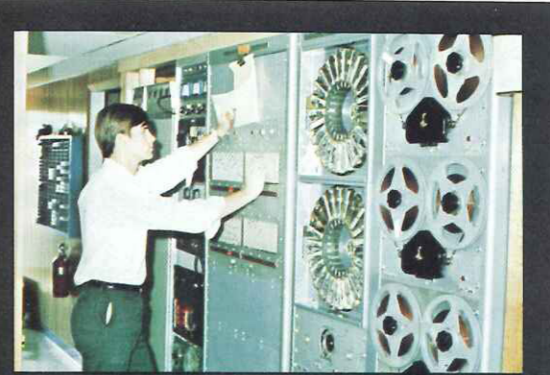
Present building projects will include the construction of a Science Center, Student Union, and dormitory unit.
