### Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) match tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. It is also the Annual White Out Night!

Cedarville, under the direction of ninth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (187-125), enters tonight's action with an 11-4 (1-1 G-MAC) record. The squad posted a 3-0 win at Kentucky Wesleyan on Friday night and dropped a 3-0 decision at Trevecca on Saturday afternoon.

Ohio Valley brings a 4-15 overall record including 0-2 in the G-MAC into tonight's contest versus Cedarville. The Fighting Scots dropped their league-openers at Trevecca and Kentucky Wesleyan this past weekend.

Leading the 2016 Lady Jacket offensive attack is Gabby Olson. The 6-4 junior middle hitter and transfer from Clarion paces the squad with 163 kills and 51 blocks.



Outside hitter Abby Shelton, the 2015 G-MAC Co-Player of the Year, is second on the team with 145 kills and third in digs with 135.

Senior libero Angela Becker leads the back row Gabby Olson

with 260 digs (4.9/set) and is sixth all-time at CU with 1,949 digs. Junior setter Kristin Cardwell has recorded 519 assists (9.8/set) and is tied with a third-best 14 service aces.

Ohio Valley is led by Head Coach Paul Jacoby who is in his 21st year at the helm of the program.

Alyx Henry, a 5-5 senior outside hitter, leads the team with 283

kills and 18 service aces. The 2015 G-MAC First Teamer also has 141 digs and 16 blocks.

Senior setter Emily Ohrn has handed out 555 assists while posting a second-best 159 digs. Rookie middle hitter Allie Bailey leads the team with eight solo blocks and 21 total blocks.



CU leads the all-time series between the two

schools with a 9-1 advantage. Ohio Valley won the only meeting last year - a 3-1 verdict on October 24 in Vienna, West Virginia.
