Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Ursuline College Arrows in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) match tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. It is also Beach Night!

Cedarville, under the direction of ninth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (188-125), enters tonight's action with a 12-4 (2-1 G-MAC) record. The squad posted a 3-0 win over visiting G-MAC opponent Ohio Valley on Tuesday night.

Ursuline brings a 10-6 overall record including 2-1 in the G-MAC into tonight's contest versus Cedarville. The Arrows defeated Malone on Tuesday in a five-set marathon played in Canton.

Continuing to lead the 2016 Lady Jacket offensive attack is Gabby Olson. The 6-4 junior middle hitter and transfer from Clarion paces the squad with 176 kills and a second-best 54 blocks.



Outside hitter Abby Shelton, the 2015 G-MAC Co-Player of the Year, is second on the team with 151 kills and third in digs with 146.

Senior middle hitter Rachel Krikke tops CU with Gabby Olson 56 blocks including a career-high eight vs Ohio Valley on

Tuesday. Senior libero Angela Becker leads the back row with 270 digs (4.8/set) and is sixth all-time at CU with 1,959 digs.

Junior setter Kristin Cardwell has recorded 553 assists (9.9/set) and is tied with a third-best 14 service aces.

Ursuline is led by Head Coach Jayme Plummer who is in his second year at the helm of the program (18-30).

Emily Adkinson, a 6-1 senior middle hitter, is one of several offensive threats on the Ursuline front row. She has 167 kills, a .272 attack percentage and a team-high 44 blocks.



Rookie outside hitter Victoria Henderson paces UC with 172 kills and 21 service aces.

Sophomore setter Katelyn Selleny has registered 516 assists, 166 digs, 13 service aces and 19 Emily Adkinson blocks.

CU leads the all-time series with Ursuline by a 14-0 advantage.
