Christina Kirkpatrick's Softball Blog

"What is defeat? Nothing but education; nothing but the first steps to something better." - Wendell Phillips

These insightful words resound loudly with the Lady Jacket softball team this week. To say that this week was comparable to a hectic up-and-down ride on a roller coaster would be an understatement. We experienced some of the highest successes our team has



ever seen, and then promptly experienced major setbacks days later. However, I speak confidently for the entire team when I say that the success and adversity we experienced over the past few days will only serve to grow us stronger as a team.

At the beginning of this past week, we found out that because of our notable success during our Florida trip we were ranked 24th in the nation for NCAA D II teams. Obviously, our team was (and still is) ecstatic to hear this exciting news. Not only was this the first time our softball squad has ever been ranked nationally, but this was the first time any women's team at Cedarville has received this honor in NCAA Division II. Of course, with such attention comes high expectations and we definitely felt the weight of this new attention on Saturday.

On Saturday, we were pleasantly surprised to see our bleachers packed and fans lined up and down the field to watch our first home games. Unfortunately, the ranking may have served as a burden to us this past weekend and we played some of the worst softball we have all year. All aspects of our game suffered, and we frankly didn't play like the Lady Jacket softball team our fans in Florida came to know and expect. We lost both games in our doubleheader to Ashland (a quality program, no doubt) and were tempted to leave the field feeling discouraged and disheartened.

Today's Games

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Urbana University Blue Knights in a non-conference doubleheader today at Lady Jacket

Cedarville, with a record of 12-5, is ranked #24 in the latest NFCA NCAA II National Poll. The Lady Jackets suffered two losses to visiting Ashland University on Saturday, March 15 by scores of 7-3 and 9-2.

Urbana, an NCAA II former member of the G-MAC, is now playing in the Mountain East Conference (MEC). UU is 7-3 on the season having just returned from their spring break trip to Clermont, Florida. The Blue Knights have won four straight including victories over Mercy (6-0) and Alderson Broaddus (7-3) this past Saturday.

Cedarville's Nikki Eigsti, a freshman first baseman, leads the team in hitting with a .395 mark (15-for-38).

Junior Nicole Davis has produced a second-best .367 batting effort and leads Cedarville in hits (22), runs (15) and triples (2). She is second with 30 total bases.

Rookie Christina Kirkpatrick is CU's third-leading hitter with a .360 average and a second-best four stolen bases.

Kelsey Chapman, a senior catcher/pitcher, leads Cedarville in doubles (6), homeruns (2), RBI's (19), total bases (32) and slugging percentage (.582). Chapman,



batting .327 at the plate, is also 3-0 in the circle and has not allowed an earned run in 27 innings of work.

Carlyn Hanzel is CU's fifth-leading hitter with a .300 batting average and a third-best 23 total bases.

Junior Rachel Bull, ranked third all-time in stolen bases with 80, has a team-high 18 swipes in the first 17 contests of 2014.

Junior hurler Courtnie Spain has a 5-3 record and a 2.31 ERA with a staff-best 36 K's in 42 1/3 innings of action. Classmate Cecelia DeBartolo is 4-1 on the year with a 3.93 earned run average.

Caitlyn Everhart, a rookie infielder, is the leading hitter for Urbana with a .464 batting average. She also leads the squad in hits (13), doubles (2), homeruns (1) and stolen bases (3).

Ashley Skinner, a senior catcher, is the leading run producer for Urbana with 10 RBI's.

Courtney Stewart has a team-high 11 runs scored, five triples and 23 total bases.

The Blue Knight pitching staff has only allowed 22 earned runs in 67 innings this season for an impressive 2.30 earned run average.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Blue Knights by a 47-35 margin. The squads met five times during the 2013-14 season with CU winning three contests including two games at the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Tournament in Nashville last May 2-3.

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - It wasn't an enjoyable home opener for NFCA #24 Cedarville. Ashland came into town and promptly swept a non-conference doubleheader from the Lady Jackets on Saturday, March 15.

The Eagles cruised to a 7-3 win in the first game and then used a seven-run inning to claim the nightcap, 9-2.

In the opener, both teams combined to leave 23 runners on base, but Ashland made the most of nine hits and nine walks. The Eagles led 4-0 before CU got on the board with two runs in the fourth on Kelsey Chapman's 14th career home run.

The visitors added three more runs in the sixth to get some breathing room. Jessica Palm was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded in the bottom of the seventh. However, the Jackets left the bags full when the contest ended.

Cedarville took a 2-0 lead in the second inning of the second game. Breanna Hughes singled in a run and Carol Anne Rice scored on a passed ball.

The advantage didn't last long. Ashland sent 12 batters to the plate in the third and plated seven runs to take command. The Lady Jacket offense consisted of singles from seven different players.

Cedarville drops to 12-5 while Ashland upped its record to 10-5.



Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced an average of 24.7 victories per year including a school-record 35 wins in 2012. The Lady Jackets have produced three consecutive winning seasons for the first time in school history.



Rowe guided Cedarville to its second straight NCCAA Midwest Region championship in 2012 and their eighth national tournament appearance. His team was the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up during the league's first year in 2013.

Rowe has coached one NCCAA National Player of the Year, six NCCAA All-Americans, and 25 All-Region performers. Ten of his play-

ers have been recognized as scholar-athletes.

Prior to coming to Cedarville, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.

Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. All four of their children have graduated from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009.


