this game going. Unfortunately, you can't change the score after it's over and now it's time to go back to work this week and wipe away all of our frustrations with that game.



### Today's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Malone University Pioneers in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) match today in the Callan Athletic Center. It is also the Lady Jacket Make-A-Wish Fundraiser!

Cedarville, under the direction of ninth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (188-125), entered last night's action with a 12-4 (2-1 G-MAC) record. The squad posted a 3-0 win over visiting G-MAC opponent Ohio Valley on Tuesday night.

Malone entered Friday's action 3-16 overall with an 0-3 G-MAC record. The Pioneers played at league foe Ohio Valley last night.

Continuing to lead the 2016 Lady Jacket offensive attack is Gabby Olson. The 6-4 junior middle hitter and transfer from Clarion paces the squad with 176 kills and a second-best 54

Outside hitter Abby Shelton, the 2015 G-MAC Co-Player of the Year, is second on the team with 151 kills and third in digs with 146.

Senior middle hitter Rachel Kriste tops CU with 56 blocks including a career-high eight vs Ohio Valley on Tuesday.

Senior libero Angela Becker leads the back row with 270 digs (4.8/set) and is sixth all-time at CU with 1,959 digs.

Junior setter Kristin Cardwell has recorded 553 assists (9.9/set) and is tied with a third-best 14 service aces.

Malone is led by Head Coach Tonya Hockman who is in her 18th year at the helm of the program (417-270)\* as of 10/6/16.

Mallory Adams, a 6-0 sophomore middle/outside hitter, entered last night's match at OVU with a team-high 195 kills and a third-best 52 blocks.

Senior middle hitter Haley Kool has 125 kills and a team-high 61 blocks.

Sophomore setter Cathryn Miller has registered 518 assists, 101 digs, 16 aces and 32 blocks.

CU leads the all-time series with Malone by a 30- Mallory Adams 20 advantage. The Pioneers dealt Cedarville a 3-1 setback last September 15 in Canton.
