#### **Today's Game Preview**

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Trevecca Nazarene University Trojans today in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville brings a 3-7 record (0-1 G-MAC) into today's action and is on a five-game losing streak. CU dropped an 82-74 league decision to pre-season G-MAC favorite Kentucky Wesleyan on Thursday night on the home floor.

Trevecca Nazarene is 6-6 in 2013-14 with a 3-0 league mark. The Trojans posted a 76-65 G-MAC win at Central State on Thursday evening to snap a three-game skid.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 316-93 (.773). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 71.5 points per game with four players hitting in double figures. The team is giving up 77.6 ppg while allowing opponents to shoot .443 from the field.

Senior guard Kayla Jenerette leads Cedarville with a 14 ppg scoring average after 10 games. Jenerette, with a third-best career .806 mark at the free throw line, is 41-of-50 this year for an .820 effort. She paces the team with 15 three-point field goals and ranks sixth all-time with 207 long-range shots.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's second-leading scorer at 11 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (44) and steals (18). Ryan has hit 13 field goals from behind the arc.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is third in scoring at 10.9 ppg. She is adding 4.9 rebounds per game with a second-best .561 field goal percentage.

The fourth Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 7.3 boards per contest.

Trevecca Nazarene is under the leadership of ninth-year Head Coach Gary Van Atta. He has produced a record of 177-91 (.660).

TNU is scoring 78.1 points per game while allowing opponents 73.6 points per contest after 12 games this season. Trevecca has three players hitting in double figures.

Junior Britt Bell leads the offensive effort with a 11.9 ppg scoring average and 5.7 boards per game. The 5-11 forward led TNU with 19 points in the win over Central State on Thursday.

Senior forward Anna Mitchell is the second-leading scorer (10.7 ppg) and rebounder (4.4 rpg).

Christina Curtner, a 5-7 junior guard, is the third-leading scorer at 10.5 points per game while leading the Trojans with 51 assists.

The top deep threat for the Trojans is 5-8 junior guard Haley Felker with 18 three-pointers in 35 attempts for an impressive .514 mark. She leads TNU in overall field goal percentage as well with a .552 mark.

Trevecca has won the previous two meetings with the Lady Jackets - a 102-53 win on Jan. 7, 2013 in Nashville, Tennessee and a 78-40 victory on Feb. 9, 2013 in Cedarville.







#### Last Time Out

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Kentucky Wesleyan made all 13 of its free throws in the final two minutes and pulled away for an 82-74 win at Cedarville in the Lady Jackets' Great Midwest Athletic Conference opener on Thursday evening.



The final score was the largest lead either team had in the contest.

CU enjoyed the upper hand, 68-67, on Raegan Ryan's three-ball with 2:10 to go. The Panthers regained the lead at the 1:51 mark from the charity

stripe and then zeroed in to go 13-for-13 at the line down the stretch to come away winners.

"Our kids played hard and I'm very pleased and satisfied despite the result," said Head Coach Kirk Martin. "We've struggled defensively and I'm proud we held this team to under 40 percent shooting.

"Our goals are to win the league and the conference tournament, and we're making steps in the right direction. That can be tough to believe when we've lost five in a row that we're making progress, but we are."

Kayla Jenerette paced four players in double figures with 17 points and 7 assists for Cedarville, 3-7 overall. Kaysie Brittenham hit four three-pointers and tallied a career-high 14 points, Danielle Spiliotis netted 12, and Ryan finished with 11.

Kentucky Wesleyan upped its record to 8-4 and 3-0 G-MAC.

#### Looking Ahead

This coming Thursday, January 9, CU will travel to Ursuline College for a Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest with the Arrows beginning at 6 PM. The game will be played at John Carroll University in University Heights, Ohio.

Cedarville then returns to the Callan Athletic Center for a threegame homestand beginning on Saturday, January 11 with a non-conference affair against the Wilberforce University Bulldogs. Tip-off is at 2 PM.



#### Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.



Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runnerup finishes, and six conference championships. Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had

won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.

Emma Ricketts has been named the G-MAC Women's

Basketball Athlete of the Week for the second-straight week and third time this season. As the conference closes out the 2013 calendar year, Ursuline went 1-2 on the week, despite a solid performances in the weekend West Virginia State University Toys for Tots Tournament.

In total, she averaged 12.7 points and 6.7 rebounds over three games, while shooting 41.7 percent (15-36) from the field. In the two games at the Toys for Tots Tournament, she averaged 18 points and 7.5 rebounds in two games and posted her second double-double of the season on Saturday against West Virginia State University with 20 points and 10 boards.

For her efforts, she was named to the All-Tournament Team. Ricketts continues to lead the conference in scoring with 14.8 points per game and is 14th in rebounding with 5.6 boards a game. She also ranks second in shooting with a 52.8 shooting percentage from the floor.
