TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) game tonight at Yellow Jacket Field. The game is part of the Annual Homecoming Weekend.

Cedarville is currently 4-4-1 overall (3-1-1 G-MAC) including a 4-1 G-MAC win over visiting Malone on Wednesday night in a game played at the Athletes in Action Complex.

The Fighting Scots are 7-3 (4-1 G-MAC) in 2016. Ohio Valley has won four consecutive games including a 1-0 victory at Mercyhurst on Wednesday.

The Yellow Jackets, under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach Brett Faro (46-15-9), return another solid nucleus from last year's G-MAC championship squad.

G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year and fifth-year forward Connor Gilmour is back for a final encore. Gilmour was an NCAA Division II All-American and an All-Midwest Region Team pick. He leads the Jackets with four goals for eight points and is fourth all-time at CU with 47.

Senior forward Jon Brown and sophomore midfielder Bryce Childers are tied for second on the squad with two goals and an assist for five points.

Other CU goal scorers this season include: Sebastian Duque, Aaron Plummer, Sean Reilly, John Schwien, Joel Twinem and Greg Williams.

Yellow Jacket senior keeper Paulo Pinto ranks second in CU's career goals against average list (0.89). Pinto has allowed 11

goals in seven games this year while making 25 saves.

Ohio Valley is led by Head Coach Luis Rincon who is in his second year with the Fighting Scots (16-11-1).

Sophomore forward Pedro Gonzalez tops the OVU scoring list with a goal and five assists for seven points. Five Ohio Valley players have scored two goals each,

Junior keeper Carlos Rubio is seeing most of the action in the nets. He has allowed 8 goals while registering 33 saves.

Cedarville holds a 6-0 lead in the all-time series with the Fighting Scots including an impressive 30-0 margin in goals scored.
