Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Indiana Wesleyan University Wildcats in non-conference action tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. The "Faculty-Staff Appreciation" contest is the second of a five-match homestand.

Cedarville, under the direction of ninth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (192-127), brings a 16-6 overall record into the match. The squad posted a 3-1 verdict over visiting Tiffin University on Tuesday night. The Lady Jackets are ranked #2 in this week's National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) Top 10.

Indiana Wesleyan, NAIA members of the Crossroads League, is 26-2 on the year. The Wildcats, ranked #1 in the latest NCCAA National Top 10 Rankings, defeated Grace College in league action on Wednesday.

Continuing to lead the 2016 Lady Jacket offensive attack is Gabby Olson. The 6-4 junior middle hitter and transfer from Clarion paces the squad with 238 kills and 83 blocks.

Outside hitter Abby Shelton is second on the team with 215 kills and second in digs with 209.

Senior libero Angela Becker leads the back row with 341 digs (4.4/set) and last Saturday became the sixth Lady Jacket to reach 2,000 career digs.

Junior setter Kristin Cardwell has recorded 749 assists (9.7/set) while junior Krissy Pratt tops the team with 35 service aces.

Indiana Wesleyan is led by Head Coach Candace Moats who is in her 15th year at the helm of the pro- Angela Becker gram (462-169).



Remy Bucknor, a 5-11 senior middle hitter, is a force on the front row with 214 kills while leading the way in attack pct. (.357) and blocks (109).

Senior outside hitter Bianca Cifaldi paces the Wildcats with 255 kills. Senior Lindsay Rogan and iunior Katie Elson direct the IWU 6-2 offense.

CU leads the all-time series with Indiana Wesleyan by a narrow 19-18 advantage. The teams last met on Nov. 20, 2010 at the NCCAA Midwest Regional hosted by Cedarville - a 3-0 win for the Wildcats.
