TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Malone University Pioneers in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) game tonight at Yellow Jacket Field.

Cedarville is currently 3-4-1 overall (2-1-1 G-MAC) including a 2-1 non-league overtime loss to Lee University on Saturday evening.

The Pioneers, first-year members of the G-MAC, are 1-6-1 (0-4-1 G-MAC) in 2016. Malone dropped a 1-0 verdict at Ohio Valley on Saturday in their most recent action.

The Yellow Jackets, under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach Brett Faro (45-15-9), return another solid nucleus from last year's G-MAC championship squad.

G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year and fifth-year forward Connor Gilmour is back for a final encore. Gilmour was an NCAA Division II All-American and an All-Midwest Region Team pick. He leads the Jackets with three goals for six points.

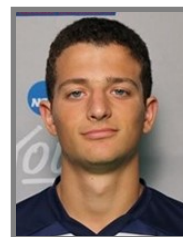
Fellow senior Joel Twinem is second on the squad with a goal and an assist for three points.

Other CU goal scorers this season include: Jon Brown, Bryce Childers, Sebastian Duque, Aaron Plummer, Sean Reilly and Greg Williams.

Yellow Jacket senior keeper Paulo Pinto ranks second in CU's career goals against average list (0.89). Pinto has allowed 11 goals in seven games this year while making 25 saves.

Malone is led by Head Coach Brian Stock who is in his fifth year with the Pioneers (17-50-5).

Freshman midfielder Gino Finelli tops the Pioneer scoring list with two goals including the game-winner in Malone's season-opening 1-0 verdict against Slippery Rock.

Junior Robert Nemes and senior Nick Astalos are the only other two players to find the back of the net in 2016.

Sophomore keeper Cody Hilty is seeing most of the action in the nets. He has allowed 14 goals while registering 34 saves.

Cedarville holds a 34-13-5 lead in the all-time series with the Pioneers including a 132-56 margin in goals scored. The teams first met in 1966 - a 3-0 Yellow Jacket victory.

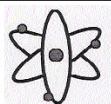

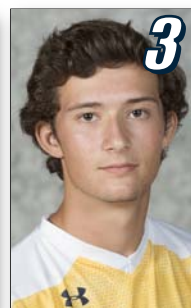
