Dear Alumnus:

More and more the necessity of academic recognition is becoming apparent to the administration, faculty, and student body of Cedarville College. It is the hope of all concerned that in the not too distant future this recognition may be granted to our college.

Accreditation, however, will never be obtained on the basis of sheer desire, although this is one important commodity. It will require a great deal of time, study, effort and, of course, the ever-present financial means.

One important segment of the academic life of any college is its library. Although the library of our college has continuously been strengthened over the past several years, it is as yet well under the median for numbers of volumes in libraries of other colleges of comparative size. Therefore, a concerted effort has been proposed for the period of the next three years to raise the number of volumes above the median.

The Alumni Association has undertaken an ambitious program of raising, by the end of May, \$6,000 which is to be applied to the purchase of approximately 1000 volumes for the library. To realize this goal, it will necessitate a determination on the part of every Alumnus to do his part. To date only a relative few have responded. For those we are grateful. Have you done your part? If you, as an Alumnus, will take it upon yourself to contribute or raise \$25, our goal will be met readily.

Your college needs your support. Let's rally to this cause collectively and express our support of our college in this tangible way. May we hear from you today? If not, make it yesterday!
