# Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Miami-Middletown ThunderHawks tonight in the Callan Athletic Center in the first home game for the Jackets since December 8, 2012.

Cedarville is 8-7 on the year including a 1-1 record in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC). The Yellow Jackets posted a 78-61 league win at Urbana University on Saturday afternoon.

The ThunderHawks enter tonight's game with a 16-5 record and a perfect 11-0 mark in the Ohio Regional Campus Conference. Miami-Middletown has won three straight games including a victory over visiting Ohio University-Eastern on Saturday.

Senior Jimmy Nwogbo, a 6-foot-7 forward, leads the Yellow Jackets in scoring and rebounding. Nwogbo, coming off a career-high 30 points at Urbana, is putting in 17.2 ppg and bringing down 7.8 boards per game. He leads the squad with 15 blocked shots this season.

Senior guard Austin Foote is second on the team in scoring with a 11.9 ppg average. He leads the way at the charity stripe with a 21-24 (.875) effort as well as 24 three-point field goals.

Zach Brown, a 6-foot-3 senior point guard, is the third Yellow Jacket in double figures with an 11.2 ppg scoring average. He is tied with Foote for the team lead in three-pointers.

Brian Grant has moved into the starting lineup in recent games and is averaging 7.4 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest.

Brian Hecker, a 6-foot-5 senior forward, is back in the lineup after missing six games due to a broken

foot. Hecker is tossing in 6.3 points and grabbing 3.9 rebounds per game since his return.

Senior guard Daniel Hickman is second on the Yellow Jackets from behind the three-point line. He is coming off the bench to put in 20 long distance field goals in 47 attempts for a .426 mark. Hickman is questionable today due to a concussion.

Jason Cuffee, a 6-foot-4 sophomore guard, is CU's best marksman from behind the arc with a .436 performance (17-39). He may return to action today after concussion issues.

Sophomore forward Bryan Redic will miss upcoming action due to a broken hand suffered in Saturday's game at Urbana.

Miami-Middletown is under the direction of eighth-year head Coach Bob Nocton. Before joining the ThunderHawks, he was head coach at Middletown High School for seven years.

Sophomore guard Max Zukowitz tops the ThunderHawks scoring charts with a 16.6 points per game scoring mark. He is also the team leader in three-point field goals (54), assists (68) and steals (61). Zukowitz is draining 50 percent of his attempts from the field (135-270).

Eric Hill, a 6-foot 2 freshman, is a solid overall performer as well for Miami-Middletown. He is tossing in 8.3 ppg to go with 4.4 boards per contest. Hill is impressive in the shooting stats with a .531 field goal pct.

Cedarville has won the three previous meetings with the ThunderHawks including last year's 80-64 verdict at CU on Jan. 17, 2012 as Brian Grant and Jimmy Nwogbo combined for 36 points and 17 rebounds. The first-ever meeting between the teams occurred in the 2006-07 campaign - a 104-80 Yellow Jacket victory.

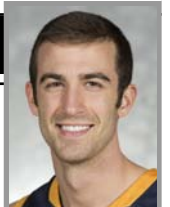

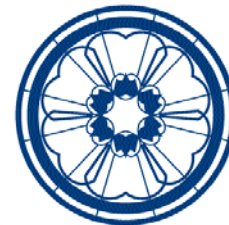

**Last Time Out** 

Zimmy Nwogbo coupled a career-high 30 points with 11 rebounds as the Yellow Jackets notched their first Great Midwest Athletic Conference win, 78-61, at Urbana on Saturday afternoon.

Cedarville, 8-7 and 1-1 G-MAC, never trailed upon scoring nine of the game's first 11 points. The halftime lead was just 26-17 despite the Blue Knights going 5-for-28 from the field including 0-for-12 from outside the arc.

Both teams picked up the offense in the second half with the hosts getting as close as five points early in the frame. However, CU shot 68 percent in the final 20 minutes and converted 20-of-22 free throws to seal the outcome.

"I thought we made it very tough on Urbana defensively," remarked Head Coach Pat Estepp. "And, Zimmy was outstanding on both ends of the court. This is a difficult place to play so we're thrilled to get a W."

Nwogbo scored 21 of his 30 points in the second half. Austin Foote tallied 14 points while Zach Brown racked up 12 points, 11 rebounds, and six assists.

The contest wrapped up a 10-game swing in which the Yellow Jackets played nine on the road.

Urbana is 7-10 and 0-1 G-MAC.

**Looking Ahead** 

Cedarville continues their stretch of eight of the next nine games in the Callan Athletic Center with a contest this Saturday, Jan. 19. The Yellow Jackets host the Notre Dame College OH Falcons in a non-conference game beginning at 4 p.m.

One week from tonight, Tuesday, Jan. 22, CU will travel to Salem International University for a non-conference affair against the Tigers beginning at 7 p.m.

The Jackets end the month on Saturday, Jan. 26 with an important G-MAC battle with the Marauders of Central State University. The game is part of the annual Alumni Weekend is slated for a 7:30 p.m. tip off.

## Head Coach Pat Estep

Pat Estep has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 24 victories per season and four consecutive national tournament appearances.



The Yellow Jackets are coming off of a 23-9 performance in what was their NCAA Division II provisional year. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estep was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13.

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estep's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estep's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estep took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Midwest Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estep. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estep was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estep spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estep comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estep also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 11, and Grant, 8, as well as daughter, Merynn, 2.

The G-MAC, headquartered in the Indianapolis metro area, will sponsor 12 championships in 2012-13 as a NCAA Division II member conference.
