The Blog, "A tradition unlike any other."

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Trevecca University Trojans in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) tangle tonight at Yellow Jacket Field. The game is also a fundraiser for "Lace Up for Pediatric Cancer".

Cedarville, picked to four-peat as G-MAC Champions, are currently 1-1-1 overall (0-0-1 G-MAC) after a hard-fought 1-1 double-overtime contest against visiting Trevecca on Thursday night. Senior Connor Gilmour tallied the lone Yellow Jacket goal.

The Panthers, selected to finish fifth in the Coaches Pre-Season Poll, are 0-3 (0-1 G-MAC) in the opening days of the 2016 season. KWC lost a 3-0 contest at Ohio Valley on Thursday in Vienna, West Virginia.

The Yellow Jackets, under the direction of fourth-year Head Coach Brett Faro (43-12-9), return another solid nucleus from last year's G-MAC championship squad.

G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year and fifth-year forward Connor Gilmour is back for a final encore. Gilmour was an NCAA Division II All-American and an All-Midwest Region Team pick. He led the league in points (37) and goals (17) and tied for seventh in assists (3). Gilmour rates #5 all-time at CU in goals (43) and points (97).

The Yellow Jackets are in good shape behind net with Paulo Pinto who set the conference single-season record in goals against average and posted a total of eight shutouts in 2015. Pinto also tops CU's career goals against average list (0.75).

KWC is led by Head Coach John Fusco who is in his 5th year with the Panther's program (13-52-6).

Two all-conference performers return to the pitch with seniors Kurtis Roberts and Blake Cobb. Roberts is a playmaker in the open field while ranking among the conference's all-time best in assists. Roberts (10 points) and Cobb (9 points) were the team's top two point scorers in 2015.

Junior keeper Grant Allen will seek to help fortify the KWC defensive efforts.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Panthers by a 7-0 margin including 25-2 in goals scored. The Yellow Jackets posted a pair of 4-0 wins last season - one on September 26 in Cedarville and another on October 15 in Owensboro.


