## Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Ohio Christian University Trailblazers tonight in the Callan Athletic Center in a non-conference game.

Cedarville is 8-5 on the year including this past Monday's 102-53 setback at Trevecca Nazarene in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference opener for both teams. The Lady Jackets are ranked #8 in the this week's NCCAA Division I National Poll.

Ohio Christian, an NCCAA Division II member, is 8-7 including an 81-63 victory Ohio University-Chillicothe on Tuesday night. The Trailblazers have won three straight contests.

The Lady Jackets are led in scoring by Kayla Jenerette - the only player hitting in double figures. The 5-foot-4 guard paces the team at 14.3 points per game including 27 field goals from behind the three-point arc. Jenerette is second in steals (14) and assists (39).

CU's second-leading scorer is Raegan Ryan. The 5-foot-5 sophomore guard is tossing in 9.5 points per game while hitting 22-for-25 from the free throw line for a team-best .880. Ryan also tops the squad in assists (52) and steals (16).

Kayla Linkous, a 5-11 rookie forward, is scoring 8.6 ppg with an impressive .580 mark from the field (40-for-69). Linkous is grabbing a third-best five rebounds per game.

Deborah Chandler, a 6-0 junior forward, is the Lady Jackets fourth-best scorer at 8.1 points per game while bringing down 3.8 boards a night.

Junior guard Becky Orchard has moved up the scoring charts with a 7.3 ppg average. She has a third-best 21 three-pointers and 29 assists.

Junior Danielle Spiliotis adds 4.6 points per contest and a second-best 5.5 rebounds per game. She has a team-best 10 blocked shots and a third-high 13 steals on the season.

Post player Lauryn Robinson, a 6-2 junior, is bringing down a team-high 8.2 rebounds per game while averaging 4.4 points per contest.

Sophomore Deborah Gordon has returned to the lineup after missing eight games due to illness. The 5-11 forward is averaging 4.6 ppg in five contests.

Cedarville is scoring 66.1 points per game while allowing opponents 62.9 points per game. The Lady Jackets hold a +5.2 edge in rebounding but are

averaging 5.3 more turnovers per game than opponents. CU is holding their opponents to a .251 mark (74-295) from behind the three-point line.

The Ohio Christian women's basketball program is led by sixthyear coach Mandy Wray. A former assistant coach at Ohio Dominican University, Wray has built Ohio Christian into one of the top NCCAA Division II programs.

The Trailblazers are paced by their all-time leading scorer Shelby Roe. The 5-8 senior guard poured in 27 points in Tuesday's win at Ohio-Chillicothe. Roe hit five consecutive three-pointers in the second half to help Ohio Christian pull away in a game that was tied at halftime.

The Trailblazers average 72.3 points per contest while giving up 65.5 points per night.

Tonight's contest is the first-ever women's basketball meeting between the schools.

### **Last Time Out**



Trevecca Nazarene turned Cedarville every which way but loose and crushed the Lady Jackets on Monday night, 102-53, in the first-ever Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest played by either team.



The host Trojans, 11-5 overall, shot 57 percent from the field in the first half including 9-for-15 from three-point land in racing to a 55-22 bulge. TNU forced 39 total turnovers in what was a dominating performance. "We were thoroughly outplayed by a very good



team," declared Head Coach Kirk Martin. "We came into the game 12th in Division II in defensive field goal percentage and could not stop them. The cred-





## Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he turns his attention to the school's first year in NCAA Division II

Martin's teams have averaged 26.6 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.



plished the feat 10 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets were the NCCAA runner-up after winning the Midwest Region banner and they also claimed the Ohio Independent Championship title.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a six-time Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, and their three children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Columbus, Ohio with his wife, Rachel.

The Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC), which was approved by the NCAA Division II Membership Committee in February of 2012 as a member conference effective September 1, 2012, will be working through an educational assessment program with the goal of beginning competition as the 24th active NCAA Division II conference by 2013-14.






