The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Davis & Elkins College Senators in Great Midwest Athletic Conference action tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville is 3-11 (1-1 G-MAC) after posting their second-consecutive win last Saturday - a 94-74 verdict over visiting Wilberforce.


Davis & Elkins is 9-6 (2-2 G-MAC) after dropping Trevecca Nazarene 76-66 last Saturday in Nashville, Tennessee.

The Yellow Jackets are under the leadership of 6th-year head coach Pat Estepp (121-55, .688). He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

Four players are hitting in double-figures for Cedarville after the first 14 games of the 2013-14 season.

Topping the scoring list is junior guard Marcus Reineke who is tossing in 17 points per game. He also leads the team with 36 three-point field goals and a .783 effort at the charity stripe (18of-23).

Junior guard Jason Cuffee is averaging 10.9 points per game and his tied for the team lead in rebounding at 5.4 boards per contest. Cuffee paces the Jackets with 47 assists.



Senior center Brian Grant is adding 10.5 points to the CU offense. He is tied for the team lead the team in blocked shots (14) and rebounding (5.4 rpg). Grant is just three points away from becoming the 51st member of the Yellow Jacket 1,000 Point Club. He ranks sixth all-time at CU with a .592 field goal percentage (427-of-721). Grant is one of 37 Yellow Jackets to grab 500+ career rebounds.

Two other rookies are making significant contributions. Austin Pickett, a 6-1 guard, is second in assists with 45 while adding 5.9 ppg. Easton Bazzoli, a 6-6 forward, is scoring 6.9 points per game with a second-best 4.4 rebounds per contest.

The Senators are led by Head Coach Chris Cottrell who is in his first season at D&E.


Davis & Elkins has two players scoring in double figures this season. Pacing the attack is senior guard Devin Miller who is the G-MAC's second-leading scorer at 18.5 points per game. Miller also leads the Senators with an .835 mark at the free-throw line which is second-best in the G-MAC. He paces the D&E defense with 26 steals and is second on the squad in rebounding (5.8 rpg).

Juwan Strothers, a 6-0 freshman guard, contributes 11.8 ppg and is connecting at .561 from the field.

Alexsandar Vasiljevic, a 6-6 sophomore, tops the Senators in rebounding at 6.9 boards per outing.

Senior Bruce Komakech, a 6-9 center, is hitting at .683 (41-of-60) from the floor with a team-high 20 blocked shots.

Tonight's game is the first-ever meeting between the two schools in men's basketball. The teams will meet up again on February 6 in Elkins, West Virginia.

Last Time Out



The Yellow Jackets won back-to-back games for the first time this season with a convincing 94-74 nonconference decision over Wilberforce in the Callan Athletic Center last Saturday afternoon.

An explosive first half got Cedarville well on its way. The Jackets shot 59 percent from the field and made six three-pointers to take a 52-27 lead into the locker room.

Marcus Reineke led the scoring jamboree with 19 points which included four three-pointers. Austin Pickett came off the bench

J.C. Faubion and Lane Vander Hulst netted 13 points each, Easton Bazzoli produced a double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds, and Leighton Smith chipped in 10 points.

Cedarville dished out 21 assists as a team. Faubion was credited with six and Reineke had five.

Coach Estepp summarized the game, ""I thought we did a really good job, especially in the first half. We defended pretty well and we moved the ball offensively. We got a little sloppy in the second half, especially on defense. That was my main concern in that we were a little careless."



Head Coach Pat Estepp

Pat Estepp has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of nearly 24 victories per season and five consecutive national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets' first active season in NCAA Division II resulted in a 22-9 mark in 2012-13. Estepp was voted the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as his team claimed the G-MAC regular season title, the G-MAC Tournament trophy, and placed third in the NCCAA Championship.



Cedarville was 23-9 performance during their NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estepp was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Mideast Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament

Estepp's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense.

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estepp's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estepp took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Mideast Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estepp. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estepp was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estepp spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estepp comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estepp also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 12, and Grant, 9, as well as daughter, Merynn, 3.

Adam Kline has been named the G-MAC Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week after helping guide his team to a pair of

conference wins on the road at Trevecca Nazarene and Kentucky Wesleyan to take over first place atop the G-MAC standings. Kline averaged 20.5 points and a conference-high 13.0 rebounds per game.

In the team's first game of the week, a 20-point win over the Trojans, Kline scored a game-high 23 points on an impressive 11-12 shooting. He added a game-high 15 rebounds, two assists, and three blocked shots. In conference play, Kline leads the conference in rebounding and shooting percentage.

The weekend conference road trip concluded with a win over previously unbeaten Kentucky Wesleyan, where Kline scored 18 points and grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds. He again shot a high percentage from the floor, going 8-10. He added an assist, a steal, and two blocks.

In the two games, he combined to score 41 points on 19-22 shooting (86.3%). He also added a conference best 26 rebounds. The two double-doubles over the weekend give Kline a conference best nine on the season - more than double the total of any other individual in the G-MAC. In each of the four conference games he has recorded a double-double.
