Today's Game Preview

Kayla Jenerette's Weekly Blog

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Wilberforce University Bulldogs today in a non-conference contest in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville brings a 5-7 record into today's action including a 90-78 league victory over Ursuline on Thursday night in University Heights, Ohio.

Wilberforce, an NAIA II independent program, is 4-12 this year. The Bulldogs last action was a 75-56 loss at Taylor University on Tuesday, Dec. 17 in Upland, Indiana.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 318-93 (.774). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 73.5 points per game with four players hitting in double figures. The team is giving up 75.8 ppg and has held opponents to under .400 field goal shooting in each of the last three games. The Lady Jackets are shooting .515 from the field, .464 from three-point and .774 at the line in the last three contests.

Senior guard Kayla Jenerette leads Cedarville with a 15.1 ppg scoring average after 12 games. Jenerette, with a third-best career .805 mark at the free throw line, is 46-of-57 this year for an .807 effort. She paces the team with 23 three-point field goals and ranks fifth all-time with 215 long-range shots. Jenerette, who drilled a season-high 26 points against Ursuline, moved up to #11 all-time on the CU scoring charts with 1,578 points.

The second Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.8 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 7.3 boards per contest. Gordon tossed in a season-high 17 points while grabbing eight rebounds versus Ursuline on Thursday.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is tied with Gordon in scoring at 10.8 ppg. She is bringing in second-best 5.1 rebounds per game with a team-leading .575 field goal percentage.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's fourth-leading scorer at 10.3 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (55) and steals (19). Ryan has hit a third-best 15 field goals from behind the arc.

Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-9 sophomore guard, is averaging 6.8 points per game while hitting a second-best 17 three-point field goals. She has a team-leading .436 effort from long range.

Wilberforce is under the leadership of sixth-year Head Coach lesha Gray.

WU is scoring 70.8 points per game while allowing opponents 80.3 points per contest after 16 games this season. Wilberforce has three players hitting in double figures.

Senior Danisha Brown leads the offensive effort with a 15.3 ppg scoring average and 5.7 boards per game. The 5-8 guard is the main weapon from long distance for the Bulldogs connecting on 49-of-112 from behind the arc.

Dominique Fischer adds 13.9 points with an .833 mark from the free throw line on 55-of-66 shooting. Kendra Moss, a 6-3 center, contributes 10.9 ppg and a team-leading 8.9 rebounds per game.

Cedarville holds a 36-2 advantage in the all-time series with their long-time Greene County rival Bulldogs. The squads last met on Nov. 17, 2012 in Cedarville - a 74-52 Lady Jacket win. Kayla Jenerette tallied 14 points with four assists to pace CU.

This year, not only were we craving for a win, but we wanted revenge. I can't adequately describe the feeling of beating them. We were all smiles in the locker room and it felt good knowing our hard work "statistically" paid off. Our game this past Thursday against Kentucky Wesleyan (picked to win our conference), although a loss, was a great confidence booster and I'm encouraged by our play against them. Shout out to my roommate, Kaysie Brittenham (aka Doc) for getting Subway Athlete of the Week and playing two great games. It was very well-deserved! Please continue to pray for Ki's health. She is feeling better but still has those days where she's feeling up and down.

Last Time Out



UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, Ohio - Kayla Jenerette fired in 26 points and dished out seven assists to guide Cedarville to a 90-78 Great Midwest Athletic Conference victory at Ursuline on Thursday night.

The 26 points was a season-high for Jenerette, a senior guard from Greenville, S.C. She upped her career point total to 1,578 to move up to 11th on the Lady Jackets' all-time scoring list.

Deborah Gordon totaled a season-high 17 points to go along with eight rebounds. Danielle Spiliotis contributed nine boards and Raegan Ryan was good for eight assists.

Cedarville, 5-7 overall and 2-1 G-MAC, used a 30-14 run to build as much as a 17-point spread in the first half. It was 43-28 at the intermission.

Ursuline closed to within nine points in the last three minutes. However, the Jackets made 67 percent of their shots in the final period and converted 8-of-11 free throws.

Coach Martin noted, "We played a really good first half and we kept our defensive field goal percentage under 40 percent for the third straight game. Ursuline is very improved and it was nice to get a big win on the road."

The host Arrows fall to 5-7 and 1-2. The game was played at John Carroll University due to Ursuline's gymnasium sustaining damage in the fall from a tornado.



Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runnerup finishes, and six conference championships.



Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.


