Today's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Notre Dame College Falcons today in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the second of a three-game homestand for CU.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 8-6 after dropping an 89-69 decision to visiting NCAA II #15 Ashland on Tuesday night.

Notre Dame, also former AMC members and in transition to a full NCAA II program, is 7-9 on the season with their most recent contest an 80-73 setback at Urbana University last Saturday.

The Lady Jacket roster features two players hitting in double figures. Kayla Jenerette, a 5-foot-5 sophomore guard, leads the team at 18.1 points per game including an 89-159 effort from the field for a team-best .560 mark.

Deborah Gordon, a 5-foot-11 rookie forward, is adding a second-best 11.8 points per contest while pacing CU with 7.4 rebounds per game. Gordon is shooting a second-best .547 from the field.

CU's third-leading scorer is Raegan Ryan. The 5-foot-5 freshman guard is tossing in 9.2 points per game while leading the squad with 52 assists, 28 steals and an .862 (25-for-29) accuracy mark at the charity stripe.

Sophomore guard Becky Orchard adds 5.9 points per game while handing out a second-best 49 assists. Orchard is the third-leading Lady Jacket rebounder at 4.3 boards a game.

Post player Lauryn Robinson, a 6-foot-2 sophomore transfer from Wayne State, is contributing 5.7 points and 3.5 boards a game.

Senior Kara Cayton is adding 5.4 points per contest while recording a third-best 45 assists. The long-range specialist is second on the team with 19 three-pointers.

Sophomore forward Deborah Chandler returned to the lineup over the Christmas break after missing six games with a broken hand. Chandler is scoring 5.1 points per game with a team-high .882 from the free-throw line.

Danielle Spiliotis, a 6-foot-1 center, is CU's second-leading rebounder at 4.5 boards per contest.

The Falcon program is directed by first-year Head Coach Katie Hine. She previously served two years in the same role at Wheeling Jesuit University.

The Falcon roster contains just one senior and features two players scoring in double digits. Martha Nagbe, a 5-foot-7 rookie guard, is averaging a team-leading 13.5 points per game, 5.5 rebounds per game, 44 steals and 38 assists.

The second-leading scorer for NDC is 5-foot-4 junior guard Lauren Macer. She is tossing in 10.4 ppg while hitting a second-best 23 three-pointers.

The top deep-threat for the Falcons is Danielle Ledrich. The second-year guard is hitting .462 from behind the arc on a 30-of-65 shooting effort.

Alex Dackin, a 5-foot-9 senior guard from Lima, Ohio, averages 6 ppg and 4.1 rpg.

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with Notre Dame by a 9-2 margin. The teams battled to a pair of two-point games during the 2010-11 campaign with each squad winning on the opponent's floor - a 57-55 CU win on Feb. 10, 2011 and a 61-59 NDC victory in the final regular season game on Feb. 19, 2011.

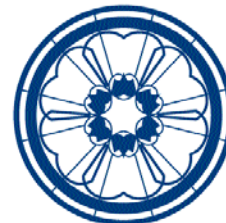

NCAA Division II No. 15 Ashland scored the first 13 points of the game and rolled to an 89-69 victory over the Lady Jackets in the Callan Athletic Center on Tuesday night.

The Eagles hit their first five shots and six of their first seven in taking immediate control. Cedarville finally got on the board three minutes into the contest when Becky Orchard buried a three-pointer.

Despite Ashland's quick start, the Jackets shaved a 16-point deficit down to 41-32 with 4:10 left in the half. The Eagles finished with a flurry for a 54-35 lead at the intermission.

The first 20 minutes were impressive for AU. The visitors shot 61 percent from the field, knocked down 8-of-14 three-pointers, and converted all six of their free throws.

Cedarville inched back to within 64-51 with 11:30 to play. However, 11 straight points by the Eagles delivered the knockout punch.

Kara Cayton hit four three-pointers for 12 points to lead the Lady Jackets, 8-6 overall, who were playing just their third home game of the season. Kayla Jenerette flipped in 10 points.

Ashland, 12-1, won for the 12th consecutive time.

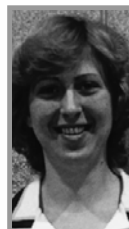

Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season and built the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country. His teams have averaged 27 wins per season during his tenure.

Martin's team made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. CU knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

The Jackets won the school's fifth American Midwest Conference championship in 2009-10 and finished 27-6 overall and 17-2 AMC. The Jackets were ranked No. 5 in the final NAIA Division II poll and ultimately advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

It was the second straight NAIA appearance for the CU women. They also earned an automatic berth in 2009 by finishing second in the demanding AMC.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin guided CU to five straight NAIA Division II national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets sport a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned the American Midwest Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2003 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Cedarville was rated No. 5 in the final 2006-07 NAIA Division II national poll en route to a 27-7 record. They held down the No. 1 position in 2005-06 which was the second straight year that the Lady Jackets accomplished the feat. They rolled to a 29-4 record overall which included a 19-game winning streak.

The Lady Jackets nearly met their ultimate goal of a national title in 2004-05 while posting a 35-2 record. Other highlights that season included an NAIA No. 1 ranking for the final six weeks of the season, a 22-game winning streak, and a second straight 18-0 run through the AMC South Division.

Martin's 2003-04 ball club produced a memorable campaign while being ranked as high as No. 2 in NAIA Division II. Among the team's many achievements were setting a school record for the most wins in a season with a 35-3 record, rolling to a perfect 18-0 league mark, and assembling a school-record 23-game winning streak.

Cedarville had a 31-3 overall record in the 2002-03 season, posted a 21-game winning streak, claimed the AMC South Division with a 17-1 mark, and won the inaugural AMC championship game. The Jackets were ranked as high as No. 3 in the country and qualified for the NAIA Division II national tournament for the first time in school history where the team advanced to the second round.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish 4th in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25. Cedarville qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, along with their two children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Dayton with his wife, Rachel.

DII to consider major changes to recruiting regulations

When Division II delegates adjourn their business session Sat., January 14, they may have significantly new approaches on the books for recruiting and conference membership.

The Division II legislative docket for the 2012 Convention is not large – only 16 proposals, all from the Presidents Council – but the matters under consideration pack a punch.

The potential changes to recruiting would permit all forms of electronic contact – everything from telephone calls to text messages to faxes – on an unlimited basis after June 15 before the prospect's junior year.

If the measure passes, it will be a landmark shift in philosophy for Division II recruiting, which has featured restrictions on phone calls and other forms of communication since NCAA rules were federated in 1997-98.

The traditional reason for the restrictions has been to protect prospective student-athletes from unwanted intrusions on their privacy and time. However, in discussing ways to ease administrative burden, the Division II Management Council concluded at its summer 2011 meeting that the restrictions likely made prospective student-athletes less informed about their college choices than their non-athlete peers.

The Division II Presidents Council subsequently agreed, and the result is Proposal Nos. 2012-11, 12 and 13. The combined effect would be to establish the beginning contact date of June 15 before the prospect's junior year and to eliminate restrictions on the number of in-person and electronic contacts during permissible recruiting periods.

Division II's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee has sought detailed feedback from student-athletes across the nation and now supports the proposals. However, the SAAC also had concerns about coaches potentially abusing the new opportunity and developed a list of best practices to address that concern if the legislation passes.

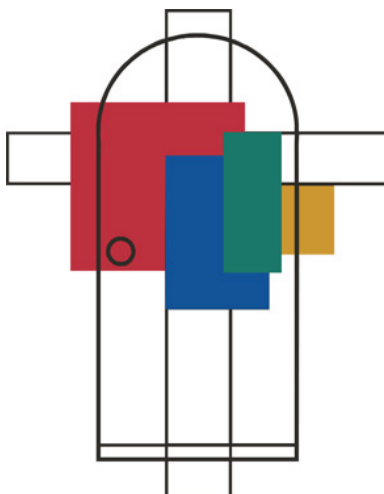
