YELLOW JACKET SOCCER BLOG

October 20, 2015

The Blog, "A tradition unlike any other."

It was another week to remember for your Yellow Jacket men's soccer team. It saw us in four states, at three different schools (including the land of the free and the home of the Jackets), missing two much-loved freshmen and with one shiny new ACL.

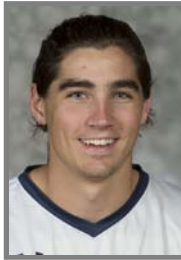
TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Salem International University Tigers in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game tonight at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Jackets are currently 11-3-1 overall (8-2 G-MAC) and are ranked #4 in the first NCAA II Midwest Regional Rankings of 2015. The Yellow Jackets most recent contest was a 3-1 league win at Trevecca on Saturday in Nashville, Tennessee.

The Tigers are 8-5-1 in 2015 with a 6-4 conference record. Their most recent contest was a 1-0 G-MAC win over visiting Davis & Elkins on Saturday.

The Yellow Jackets, under the direction of third-year Head Coach Brett Faro (38-10-7), have won three straight G-MAC contests and are led on the offensive side by senior forward Connor Gilmour with 14 goals and an assist for 29 points. Gilmour is tied for sixth all-time at CU with 40 goals scored in three seasons.

Senior midfielder Zachary Harris is the second-leading scorer with four goals and an assist for nine points. Junior Jon Brown and sophomore John Schwiens are tied for the team lead with six assists each.

Junior keeper Paulo Pinto is seeing the majority of action in the nets for the Jackets. He has posted five shutouts and is allowing 0.85 goals per game.

Florin Marton began his second stint at SIU in December of 2010 - he enters his fifth season as head coach and 12th overall in 2015.

The Tigers are led by Javier Ruiz, a senior midfielder, with nine goals and an assist for 19 points. Samir Anzil, a junior midfielder, is SIU's second-leading scorer with four goals and five assists for 13 points. Sophomore forward Mohamed Ali Khalaf has added four goals and an assist to the Tiger attack.

Sophomore forward/keeper Dom Gillespie is the reigning G-MAC Men's Soccer Athlete of the Week. He has filled in following an injury to starting keeper Elliot Cook and has made four starts with a 0.87 goals against average.

The Yellow Jackets lead the all-time series with SIU by a 3-0-1 margin including a 5-1 win on September 12 in Salem, West Virginia. Connor Gilmour tallied two goals in the victory while Michael Auld, Paul Messerly and Joe Davison also scored.

LAST TIME ON THE PITCH - 10/17/15

NASHVILLE, Tenn. - Cedarville wrapped up the road portion of the 2015 schedule with an important 3-1 result at Trevecca in G-MAC action.

The two-time defending champion Yellow Jackets, 11-3-1 overall and 8-2 G-MAC, own a five-point lead in the standings with two league contests to play - both at home.

CU struck first when Joe Davison cleaned up a loose ball in the box in the 16th minute.

Connor Gilmour made it 2-0 in the 30th when his 25-yard strike fooled the keeper for his 14th tally of the campaign.

The Trojans made it interesting in the 80th minute when they won a scramble in tight for their lone goal.

However, Joel Twinem answered just 42 seconds later when he tracked down a through ball and finished off a breakaway to account for the final.

Numbers Game:

- Gilmour scored for the first time in four games. He became the 7th player in CU history to register 40 career goals.
- Davison scored the game's first goal for the second straight time.
- Pinto has not allowed a goal in his last three appearances and has gone 258 consecutive scoreless minutes covering his last four outings.
- Cedarville has put more shots on goal than its last 13 opponents.
- Jackets are 8-0-1 all-time vs. Trevecca.

HEAD COACH BRETT FARO



Brett Faro has been the head men's soccer coach at Cedarville University since the 2013 season after serving as the program's top assistant for two years. He's guided the Yellow Jackets to back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference championships.

CU finished 14-4-2 overall and 7-0-1 during the 2014 campaign. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament and defeated Davis & Elkins, 1-0, in the title match.

Faro was named the program's interim head coach in July, 2013 and later had the interim tag removed in November just before the G-MAC Tournament. Cedarville played host and #1 seed D&E to a 0-0 draw in the final and then claimed the trophy on penalty kicks. The Jackets ended up 13-3-4 overall and 6-1-1 G-MAC.

CU has gone 58-17-10 since Faro's arrival including a school-record 17 victories in 2012. The Jackets won the 2011 NCCAA Midwest Region banner and placed third at the national tournament.

Faro came to Cedarville after serving as an assistant coach at the United States Naval Academy during the 2010 campaign. He helped guide the Midshipmen to a 7-5-4 record.

Faro has been involved in multiple levels of soccer in coaching and administration. He coached the U17 Maryland Nike Rush '93 in 2010-11 and helped lead the NCSL Division I squad to three tournament championships.

Faro was team manager of Sky Blue FC of Women's

Professional Soccer in 2010. He also coached and trained players in the Hershey Youth Soccer Club in 2007 and 2008.

Faro was a four-year standout during his playing career at perennial NCAA Division III powerhouse Messiah College from 2005-09. He was a member of four national championship teams, was a two-time team captain, and tied the school record for the most games played in a career with 99.

Faro is a 2009 graduate of Messiah with a degree in sports management. He was a Dean's List student at the school and was recognized as an NSCAA Academic All-Region Scholar-Athlete.

Faro earned a master's degree in coaching and athletic administration from Concordia University Irvine (Calif.) in 2014. He also possesses an NSCAA national diploma.

Brett and his wife, Shelley, were married on May 31, 2014. They reside in Xenia.

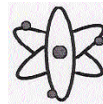

Both games were at home in Salem as Gillespie flexed his muscle and emerged as the unlikely hero following an injury that has sidelined starting keeper Elliot Cook for the past four games.

Gillespie, listed as a forward on the active roster, has filled in admirably, shutting down the Battlers for the duration with six saves on 11 shots faced.

His Tiger teammates delivered the game-ending goal with 14 seconds to spare before a draw could be declared. Gillespie delivered another win tending net, this time in shutout fashion against D&E.

Shots were hard to come by for both teams, but Gillespie was credited with two saves to preserve an early goal in the eighth minute of regulation.

The Tigers head back out on the road after wrapping up their four-game homestand. Cedarville is next up on Thursday - the Yellow Jackets prevailed 5-1 in their first meeting of the fall.

Recently, Malone University has announced it will be joining the G-MAC in 2016-17 as a full member, and then the University of Findlay, Hillsdale College, Lake Erie College, Ohio Dominican University, and Walsh University will join in 2017-18.
