Hello Everyone!

It's hard to believe, but we have wrapped up another full week of practices and games and are headed into the next. We faced off with Alderson Broaddus and Davis & Elkins and this could be wrapped up into a phrase, or perhaps a title - A Tale of Two Games.

Alderson Broaddus: After a challenging Monday practice followed by a "we're beat up" Tuesday practice followed by a "we're finally getting our legs back" Wednesday practice, we were quite excited for our game on Thursday. TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University women's soccer team hosts the Trevecca University Trojans in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference encounter tonight at Yellow Jacket Field. Cedarville was picked to finish third and Trevecca was the second-place choice in the G-MAC Coaches Preseason Poll.

The Lady Jackets are 4-2 (2-1 G-MAC) on the year after a disappointing 2-1 league loss to visiting D&E last Saturday.

The Trojans enter tonight's contest with a 2-3-1 mark including a 2-2 record in the G-MAC. Trevecca's most recent action was a 10-0 G-MAC win over visiting Salem International last Saturday.

Head Coach John McGillivray is in his 43rd season coaching soccer at CU - 18th with the women (151-151-28).

The Lady Jackets are led on offense by junior midfielder Grace Miorelli with four goals and a team-high eight assists for 16 points. She paces the G-MAC in scoring and assists.

Senior forward Jacoby Ziegler is CU's second-leading scorer with five goals and three assists for 13 points. Ziegler ranks fourth in the NCAA II active career goals scored list with 45.

Senior forward Kaitlyn Stiles is CU's third-leading scorer with five goals and an assist for 11 points but is doubtful for action tonight due to a leg injury suffered on Saturday.

Senior defender Kaleigh Rowlands and freshman midfielder Creslyn Van Dyck are tied with Ziegler with a second-best three assists.

Junior keeper Hanna Harris is the all-time leader in career shutouts at Cedarville with 17. Harris hopes to return to the pitch tonight after sitting out two contests due to injury.

Trevecca is under the direction of third-year Head Coach Mark Foster (20-17-4). He previously served two seasons as an assistant with the program.

Senior midfielder Anna Hoffman, a three-time all-conference performer, leads the Trojans with five goals and two assists for 12 points.

Sophomore Diana Corzine has three goals and a pair of assists for eight points. Classmate Liz Denton has a 1.65 gaa in the nets for TU.

Trevecca leads the all-time series with the Lady Jackets by a 4-1 margin including a pair of wins during the 2014 campaign.

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Davis & Elkins used a penalty kick midway through the second half to pull off a 2-1 win at Cedarville in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest.

The PK broke a 1-1 tie in the 62nd minute and was the Senators' only shot on goal in the second half.

The Lady Jackets, 4-2 overall and 2-1 G-MAC, got on the board first. Carly Gregory one-timed a corner kick from Kaleigh Rowlands in the 7th minute for her second goal of the season.

D&E, 4-2 and 3-1 G-MAC, equalized in the 25th before being the beneficiary of a hand ball whistled at the top corner of the penalty area.

CU outshot the visitors 13-7 for the match including a 9-2 margin during the final period.

HEAD COACH JOHN MCGILLIVRAY



John McGillivray is one of the most well-respected soccer coaches in the state of Ohio and has been coaching soccer at Cedarville University since 1974.

McGillivray has been the head coach of the Lady Jackets since 1998. He served as the Cedarville men's head coach from 1974 through 1997.

Coupled with the 147 wins with the women, McGillivray has 362 total soccer victories at CU. His 300th overall win came in a 5-0 decision over Grace on Aug. 28, 2008. He picked up his 100th victory with the Lady Jackets in a 2-1 result at Point Park on Oct. 17, 2009.

McGillivray has enjoyed eight winning seasons with the Lady Jackets including a best-ever 15-7 mark in 2013. CU led the Great Midwest Athletic Conference with a 9-1 regular season mark and McGillivray was voted G-MAC Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished 13-8-2 in 2004, won NCCAA Midwest Region championship, and secured an automatic berth in the NCCAA National Tournament. The 2000 club had a 12-7-2 record and made the school's first-ever NCCAA championship appearance in women's soccer.

McGillivray and his teams have long been recognized for their sportsmanlike behavior. His Lady Jackets twice received the Fair Play Team Award from the American Midwest Conference for their exemplary conduct on the field.

He was presented the first-ever Distinguished Merit Award in 1990 by the Ohio Collegiate Soccer Officials Association. The National Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Association honored him in 1992 with their National Merit Award.

The Springfield, Ohio native led his men's teams to eight Mid-Ohio Conference titles, five NCCAA District III banners, three NAIA District 22 championships, and one NAIA Area IV crown which carried with it a trip to the NAIA Nationals in 1974. He guided his squad to five NCCAA National Tournament appearances, a pair of NCCAA National Runner-Up finishes and he was chosen NCCAA National Coach of the Year in 1981.

McGillivray served at all levels of NAIA soccer including president of the NAIA Soccer Coaches Association from 1983 through 1985. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1991 and the NAIA Hall of Fame in 1993.

McGillivray, who is an associate professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Allied Health, is a 1970 graduate of Cedarville College, and he earned his master's degree in 1976 from the University of Dayton. John and his wife, Bonnie, reside in Cedarville and have five children and 16 grandchildren.




