Today's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Notre Dame College Falcons today in the Callan Athletic Center in a non-conference matchup.

Cedarville is 9-7 on the year including a 92-55 win over visiting Miami-Middletown on Tuesday night.

The Falcons, an NCAA Division II program, enter today's game with a 4-10 record. NDC dropped a 96-82 decision at Central State on Thursday evening.

Senior Zimmy Nwogbo, a 6-foot-7 forward, leads the Yellow Jackets in scoring and rebounding. Nwogbo is putting in 17.6 ppg and bringing down 7.8 boards per game. He leads the squad with 19 blocked shots this season.

Senior guard Austin Foote is second on the team in scoring with a 12 ppg average. He leads the way at the charity stripe with a 21-24 (.875) effort as well as 27 three-point field goals. Foote is ninth all-time

at CU with 182 three-pointers and is five away from moving into the #8 slot.

Zach Brown, a 6-foot-3 senior point guard, is the third Yellow Jacket in double figures with an 11 ppg scoring average. He is the team leader with 66 assists and is second in three-point field goals with

Brian Grant has moved into the starting lineup in recent games and is averaging 7.6 points and a sec-

ond-best 5.6 rebounds per contest. Brian Hecker, a 6-foot-5 senior forward, is back in

Brown the lineup after missing six games due to a broken foot. Hecker is tossing in 6.7 points and grabbing 3.8 rebounds per game.

Senior guard Daniel Hickman is third on the Yellow Jackets from behind the three-point line. He is coming off the bench to put in 20 long distance field goals in 47 attempts for a .426 mark. Hickman is questionable again today due to a concussion.

Jason Cuffee, a 6-foot-4 sophomore guard, is CU's best marksman from behind the arc with a .436 performance (17-39). He may return to action today after concussion issues.

Sophomore forward Bryan Redic will miss several weeks due to a broken hand suffered in last Saturday's game at Urbana.

Notre Dame is under the direction of tenth-year head Coach Kevin Bille. Before joining the Falcons, he held coaching positions at Walsh University and Tiffin University. Bille is a former two-time all-conference performer at Walsh.

Senior Eric Dummermuth tops the Falcon offensive attack with 16.6 points per game and 9.6 boards per contest. He produced a double-double of 22 points and 12 boards in Thursday's loss at CSU. The 6-foot-6 forward, a two-time NAIA All-American, did not play last season due to injury.

Sophomore guard/forward Lawrence DeArmond is second on the Falcon scoring charts with a 14.3 points per game scoring mark.

Tyree Gaiter, a 5-foot-7 freshman, is in the midst of a solid rookie season. He is tossing in 13.5 ppg while pacing NDC in threepoint FG's (26), assists (57) and steals (30).

Jarvis Huntley adds 8.1 ppg and a team-best .818 FT mark.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Falcons by a convincing 9-0 margin. The Yellow Jackets posted wins over NDC last season on January 14, 2012 at Cedarville (84-69) and on February 4, 2012 in South Euclid, Ohio (70-57).



Last Time Out



Zimmy Nwogbo scored 23 points and Cedarville made its first home game in more than five weeks a dominant one by cruising to a 92-55 non-conference victory over Miami-Middletown on Tuesday night.

All ten Yellow Jackets in uniform played and scored. The contest was the first in a string of nine games of which eight will be played on the home hardwood.

Cedarville, 9-7 overall, shot 57 percent from the field in the first half while inching out to a 44-35 margin over the smaller ThunderHawks. The hosts then picked their

the smaller ThunderHawks. The hosts then picked their game up a notch in the second half.

The Jackets scored the first 13 points after the break. They hit 65.5 percent of their shots and outscored MU-M 48-20 over the final 20 minutes.

"I was very pleased with our focus and intensity in the second half," said Head Coach Pat Estepp. "We talked about it at halftime and I'm proud of how the guys responded."

Nwogbo needed just 24 minutes to go 11-for-12 from the field. He also grabbed eight rebounds and blocked four shots.

Austin Foote tallied 13 points and four assists, Brian Hecker had 10 points with five assists, and Brian Grant scored 10 markers. Marcus Reineke added nine points while Zach Brown and Mike Woods chipped in eight apiece.

Miami-Middletown is 16-6.

This Tuesday, January 22 the Yellow Jackets travel to Salem International University for a non-conference affair against the Tigers beginning at 7 p.m.







Head Coach Pat Estepp

Pat Estepp has been the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2008-09 campaign. He has guided his alma mater to an average of 24 victories per season and four consecutive national tournament appearances.

The Yellow Jackets are coming off of a 23-9 performance in what was their NCAA Division II provisional year. They won the school's first NCCAA Championship banner in convincing fashion after entering the 2012 tournament as the No. 1 seed and winning their three games by an average of 18 points. Estepp was tabbed NCCAA National Coach of the Year.



Cedarville finished strong again in 2010-11 by winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. The Jackets were ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll and finished at 20-13

Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009-10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Mideast Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were rated as high as 8th in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

Estepp's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as No. 1 in the country, finished in a tie for the No. 2 spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament.

The Jackets assembled a number of school records which included a 14-game winning streak. They also wiped out all of the previous marks for defense

Cedarville led the country in field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 37.9 percent. They also ranked second nationally by allowing a stingy 60 points per contest which was 10 points per game lower than the old school record.

Estepp's leadership did not go unnoticed. He was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.

Estepp took on his current position after serving as an assistant coach for eight years under former head coach Ray Slagle. He played a key role during Slagle's successful tenure with the Yellow Jackets from 2000 to 2008.

Cedarville won 177 games during that timespan, averaged 24.1 wins over the last seven seasons, won three American Mideast Conference titles, and two AMC Tournament championships.

The Yellow Jackets made five trips to the NAIA Division II National Tournament where they never lost in the first round. They advanced to the semifinals once, the quarterfinals twice, and to the second round twice.

This is the first head coaching position for Estepp. A 1997 graduate of Cedarville College with a degree in physical education, he was a student assistant at the school during his senior year and went on to acquire coaching experience at all levels of basketball.

Estepp was the 8th grade coach at Cedarville Junior High School in 1996-97. He spent the next year at Clark County Christian High School in Kentucky where he was the varsity assistant boys basketball coach and the head coach in golf and tennis.

Estepp spent the 1998-99 season as the junior varsity coach at Oak Hill (Ohio) High School. He held the same position in 1999-2000 at South Webster (Ohio) High School which is where he graduated from in 1993.

Estepp comes from a rich basketball coaching heritage. His father, Dale, spent 27 years in the profession at Fairfield Union and South Webster high schools.

Estepp also has a master's degree in education from Cedarville University that he earned in 2008. Pat and his wife, Melanie, reside in Cedarville with their three children: sons Isaiah, 11, and Grant, 8, as well as daughter, Merynn, 2.






