Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Bellarmine University Knights in a non-conference contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, under the direction of seventh-year Head Coach Doug Walters (141-98), enters tonight's action with a 4-5 record.

CU participated in the California University PA Invitational this past weekend in California, Pennsylvania and came away with just one victory in four contests. Cedarville posted a win over Caldwell while dropping matches to Fairmont State, Clarion and the host Vulcans.

Bellarmine, an NCAA II member of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), is 3-2 on the year. The Knights posted a 25-15, 25-20, 25-14 league win over visiting William Jewell on Sunday in their most recent action.

Senior outside hitter Hannah Wagner leads a balanced offensive attack for Cedarville with 82 kills, 2.56 kills per set and is third with a .246 attack percentage.

Rookie Krissy Pratt, a 5-11 outside hitter, is second with 72 kills and is for fourth in digs with 56.

Sophomore Angela Becker, who earned a spot on the California PA All-Tournament team, leads the way with 12 service aces and 151 digs.

Setters senior Maddie (Anderson) Ledbetter and sophomore Kristin Cardwell direct CU's offense. Ledbetter is the all-time Lady Jacket leader with 239 service aces and ranks sixth with 2,624 career assists. Cardwell has 142 digs, eight service aces and 54 digs in 2014.

Bellarmine is led by Head Coach Jenni Grzebin who is beginning her second year at the helm of the program. She played collegiately at Xavier University and has served as an assistant at the University of Toledo and the University of Buffalo.

Sophomore outside hitter Emily McDaniel leads Bellarmine with 66 kills in 16 sets for a 4.12 kills per set

Rookie middle hitter Margaret Horihan is second with 37 kills while leading the Knights with 13 total blocks.

Setter Allie Muha, a 5-9 freshman, has handed out 181 assists while adding 40 digs.

Hayden Daily tops the squad with six service aces.

The Knights won the only other previous meeting Emily McDaniel between the two schools with a 25-20, 25-22, 25-22 victory at the GLIAC/GLVC Crossover on Oct. 16, 2010 in Aurora, Illinois.



Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 137 victories during Walters' six-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012 and 2013.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

CU was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a fourtime conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 12.


