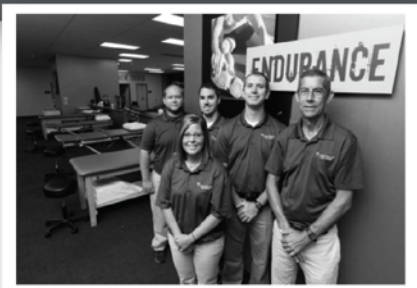

Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Northern Michigan University Wildcats in a non-conference contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, under the direction of seventh-year Head Coach Doug Walters (141-99), enters tonight's action with a 4-6 record.

The Lady Jackets have dropped four of their last five contests including a 25-20, 25-17, 28-26 to visiting Bellarmine on Tuesday night.

Northern Michigan, an NCAA II member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), is 2-4 on the year. The Wildcats have posted two straight league wins including a 25-21, 25-13, 25-15 decision at Lake Superior State last Saturday.

Senior outside hitter Hannah Wagner leads a balanced offensive attack for Cedarville with 89 kills, 2.54 kills per set and is third with a .226 attack percentage.

Rookie Krissy Pratt, a 5-11 outside hitter, is second with 79 kills and is for fourth in digs with 58.

Sophomore Angela Becker leads the way with 12 service aces, 161 digs and a .969 serving percentage.

Senior Amanda Bell became the 20th member of the Lady Jacket 1,000 Kill Club when she posted seven kills versus Bellarmine.

Setters senior Maddie (Anderson) Ledbetter and sophomore Kristin Cardwell direct CU's offense. Ledbetter is the all-time Lady Jacket leader with 241 service aces and ranks sixth with 2,642 career assists. Cardwell has 158 assists, nine service aces and 57 digs in 2014.

Northern Michigan is led by Head Coach Dominic Yoder who is beginning his eighth year at the helm of the program (141-83). He guided the Wildcats to three straight NCAA appearances from 2008-11.

Junior outside hitter Lisa Studnicka leads Northern Michigan with 78 kills in 24 sets for a 3.39 kills per set mark.

Sophomore Alex Larsen is second with 55 kills while classmate Kayla Chosa tops the Wildcats with 22 total blocks.

Setter Meghan Seymour, a 5-8 freshman, has handed out 142 assists and tops the squad with nine service aces.

Tonight's match is the first-ever meeting between the two schools on the volleyball court. Northern Michigan will play league matches at Lake Erie tomorrow and at Ashland on Saturday.

In his role at Cedarville, Dr. Wood provides strategic vision, direction, and leadership for the student development, outreach ministries, and student services. Dr. Wood also teaches courses in the School of Biblical and Theological Studies. He and his wife, Ellen, have three children, Jackson, Olivia, and Parker.

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 137 victories during Walters' six-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012 and 2013.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Midwest Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

CU was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 12.

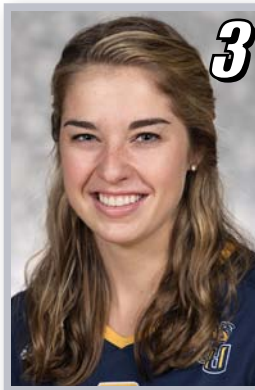

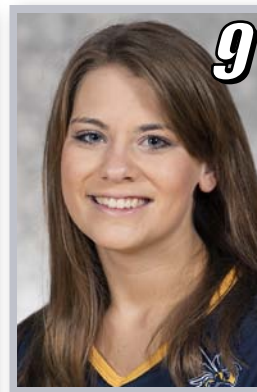

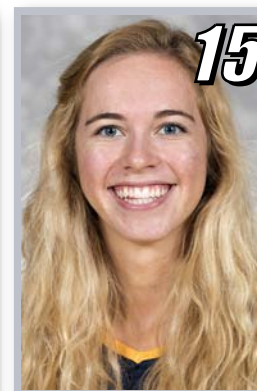
