Tonight's Game Preview

Kayla Jenerette's Weekly Blog

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Davis & Elkins College Senators tonight in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, with a 6-7 record (2-1 G-MAC), has won three consecutive games including last Saturday's 87-57 decision over visiting Wilberforce.

Davis & Elkins is 4-11 overall with a 3-2 mark in the G-MAC. The Senators have dropped two straight contests - league setbacks at Kentucky Wesleyan (112-75) last Thursday and at Trevecca Nazarene (74-66) last Saturdav.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 319-93 (.774). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 74.5 points per game with four players hitting in double figures. The team is giving up 74.4 ppg and has held opponents to 37 percent field goal shooting in the last five games. The Lady Jackets are shooting .531 from the field and averaging 21.3 assists in the last five contests.

Senior guard Kayla Jenerette continues to lead Cedarville with a 15.2 ppg scoring average after 13 games. Jenerette, with a third-best career .805 mark at the free throw line, is 47-of-58 this year for an .810 effort. She paces the team with 26 three-point field goals and ranks fifth all-time with 218 long-range shots. Jenerette ranks #11 all-time on the CU scoring charts with 1,594 points and is just 49 points from the #10 slot.



Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is Cedarville's second-leading scorer at 11.1 ppg and rebounder at 5.6 boards per game. Linkous registered her second double-double of the year against Wilberforce - 14 points and 12 rebounds.

The third Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.6 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with seven boards per contest.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's fourth-leading scorer at 10.3 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (55) and steals (19). Ryan has hit a third-best 15 field goals from



Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-9 sophomore quard, is averaging 6.9 points per game while hitting a second-best 17 three-point field goals (17-of-42, .405).

Davis & Elkins is under the direction of sixth-year Head Coach Jason Asbell (57-97, .370).

D&E is scoring 75.9 points per game while allowing opponents 82.3 points per contest after 15 games this season. The Senators are hitting .357 from the field including a .256 effort from behind the arc. The squad is grabbing an impressive 48.3 rebounds per

Davis & Elkins has three players hitting in double figures led by senior Jorden Lykes with 11.3 points per game. The 5-10 forward also tops the Senators with 7.1 rebounds per contest.

Rookie guard Stephanie Wooten adds 11 ppg and a team-best 38 assists. Sharmaine Baker, a 5-11 junior forward, is tossing in 10.5 ppg.

Cedarville won the only other previous meeting with the Senators - a 75-70 victory to open the 1997-98 season on Nov. 14 in Elkins, West Virginia.

Last Time Out



A balanced offense and a pesky defense propelled the Lady Jackets as they strolled to their third consecutive victory with an 87-57 non-conference result over visiting Wilberforce on Saturday. January 11.

After giving up the first basket of the game, Cedarville clamped down and never trailed again. The hosts used a ten-point spurt late in the half to lead 39-24 and held Wilberforce to just 28 percent shooting over the first 20 minutes.

The Lady Jackets, 6-7 overall, shot a blistering 63 percent (17for-27) in the second period and methodically pulled away. The final score was the largest margin of the contest.

Kayla Jenerette guided four players in double figures with 16 points and six assists. Kayla Linkous came off the bench with a double-double of 14 points and 12 rebounds.

Taylor Vander Plas totaled 12 points with six assists. Lauryn Robinson netted a season-high 12 points with six boards.

Coach Martin commented about the win, "It was hard work. Wilberforce always plays hard. That's a wonderful, friendly rivalry we have with them and I have great respect for (Head Coach) lesha (Gray)."

Wilberforce falls to 4-13 and was held to a 33 percent accuracy from the field.



Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.



Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.

G-MAC Player of the Week

(Jan. 5-11)

Karly Rhoads Kentucky Wesleyan · Sr. · Slippery Rock, PA

Karly Rhoads has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this sea-

son, but is the third different Lady Panther to be selected this season. Rhoads scored a conference season-high 32 points in a win over Davis & Elkins. She averaged 21 points per game last week in two conference wins as KWC remained a perfect 6-0 in G-MAC play.

Rhoads combined to shoot 71.4% from the floor on the week, converting on 15 of 21 shot attempts. She was also 7-7 from the free throw line, all coming against D&E, and was on the mark no matter where she shot from, shooting the same 71.4% (5-7) from long range.

Defensively, Rhoads recorded four steals, again all coming against D&E in the victory. She led (or tied for the lead) in games played last week with ten field goals made, 32 points, five 3-pointers made, and 83.3% shooting from long range (5-6), all against D&E.

With her scoring effort last week, Rhoads improved her season average to 13.7 points per game and moved up the list to fourth in the conference in scoring. She is one of two players to have over 200 points scored this season. She also increased her shooting percentage to 53.8% (fifth best in conference), her free throw percentage to 88.2% (best in conference), and her three-point percentage to 48.8% (second best in conference).


