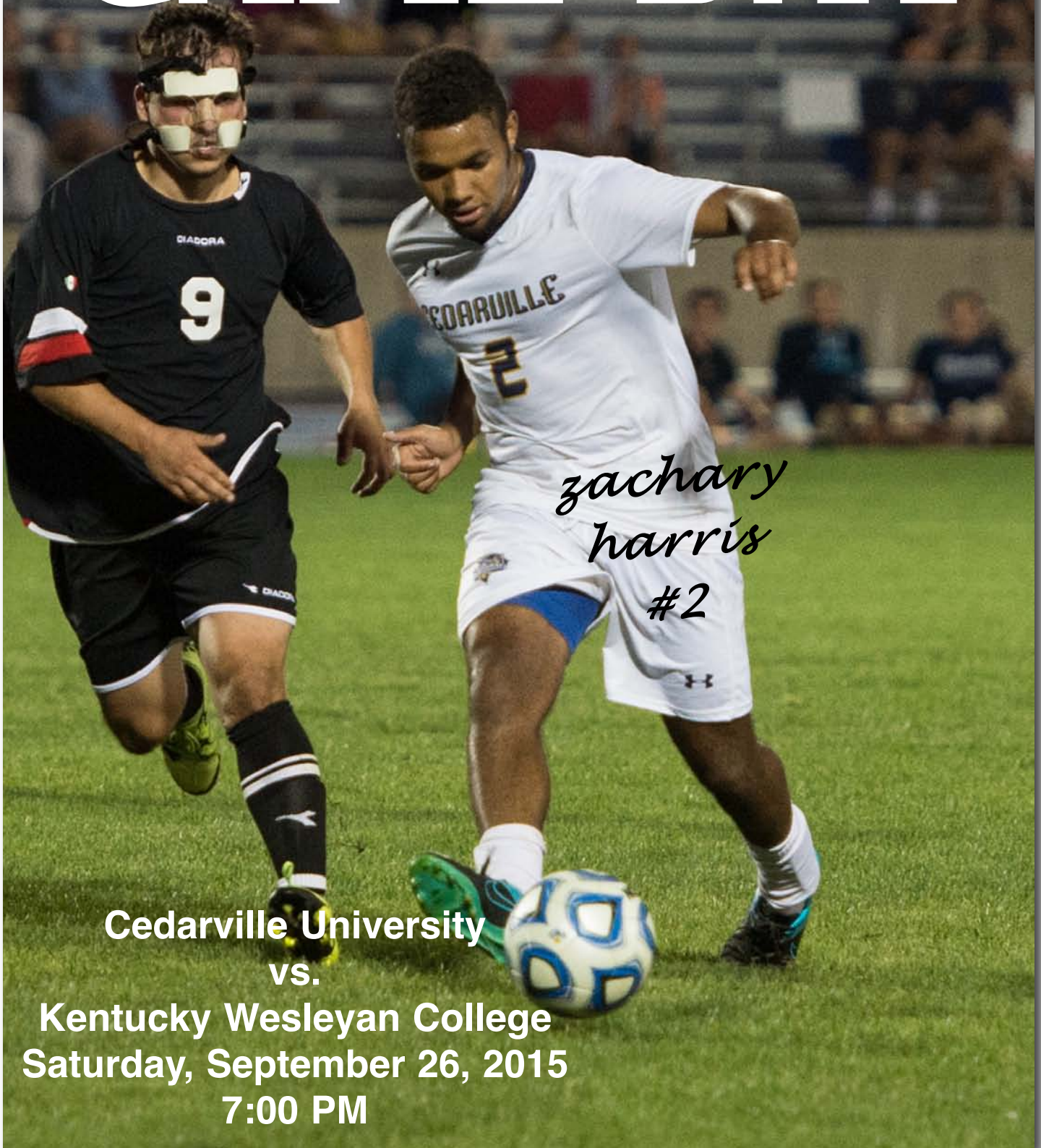

Another week gone and the Yellow Jacket men's soccer team is a tie and a win farther into their season.

It was a relatively peaceful week for us in contrast with the last one. We had two home games, which meant we were able to actually attend our Tuesday/Thursday classes just in time to remind our professors who we are before the first round of exams and assignments hits us.

Our first game of the week was Tuesday the 15th against Tiffin. Leading up to the game, they were ranked second in our region, which meant it was a game with some real tournament implications. Also notably, this was our last week of coaching the Cedarville Little Dribblers. We had a game Thursday at the halftime of our women's team's game where the Orange Dinosaurs put forth a valiant showing to pull out a victory over the Green Goobers despite some questionable coaching tactics by our very own John "I'm-Never-Happy-With-Anything" Schwien. Our last game was the morning of the D&E game and it was an excellent final game day for our Little Dribblers and coaches alike. The matches were thrillers and the cookies and sweets the coaches received for their efforts was the little glimpse of heaven that all home-cooking is to a hungry college athlete.

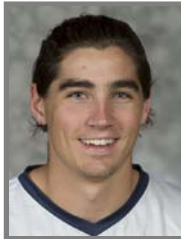
TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University men's soccer team hosts the Kentucky Wesleyan College Panthers in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game tonight at Yellow Jacket Field.

The Jackets are currently 6-1-1 overall (4-0 G-MAC) and are picked to three-peat as champions of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. CU recorded a 4-2 league win over visiting Trevecca on Wednesday night.

The Panthers are 1-5-1 with an 0-3-1 mark in the G-MAC. KWC snapped a three-game losing skid with a 2-1 non-conference win over Brescia on Tuesday night.

The Yellow Jackets, under the direction of third-year Head Coach Brett Faro (33-8-7), return a solid nucleus from last year's G-MAC championship squad. Headlining the returnees is G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year Connor Gilmour who finished with 14 goals and 4 assists for 32 points.

Also back on the offensive side are Joel Twinem (5-2-12) and Zachary Harris (3-1-7). Defenders Paul Messerly and Jared Newman anchor the back line. Paulo Pinto returns between the pipes where he set a school record last fall with a 0.51 goals against average.

Gilmour has totaled nine goals and an assist for 19 points to lead the offense in 2015. He is 7th all-time at CU with 35 goals scored in three seasons. Sophomore Jon Brown leads the squad with four assists.

KWC is led by Head Coach John Fusco who is in his fourth year with the Panthers (12-40-6).

Kentucky Wesleyan's Kurtis Roberts, a junior midfielder, has a team-best three goals for six points. Classmate Isaiah Hagan tops the Panthers with three assists. Another junior, Blake Cobb, has a goal and an assist.

Sophomores Grant Allen and Tret Hill are both seeing action in the nets for KWC. Allen has a 1.67 gaa while Hill has posted a 1.90 gaa.

Cedarville owns the all-time series with the Panthers by a 5-0-0 margin - including 17-2 in goals scored. CU posted a 1-0 win in Cedarville and a 3-0 verdict in Owensboro last season.

LAST TIME ON THE PITCH - 9/23/15

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Cedarville jumped to a three-goal lead and then had to hold off Trevecca for a 4-2 Great Midwest Athletic Conference victory.

The match started out like it would be an easy one for the home side. Connor Gilmour, who leads the league in scoring, finished off a pass from Jon Brown in the 8th minute.

The senior forward netted his 9th goal of the season on a turnover by the Trojan back line three minutes later.

Brown set up freshman Derek Braak for his first collegiate goal in the 20th minute and CU enjoyed a 3-0 bulge.

Trevecca, 3-5 and 2-3 G-MAC, took advantage of a Yellow Jacket giveaway in the box for its first goal in the 26th minute. Then, the visitors made it interesting by heading in a corner kick in the 61st to cut the deficit to one.

The contest remained dicey until Braak split the TNU defense at the top of the penalty area, swerved around the keeper, and tucked home an open net goal with 11:11 to play..

Numbers Game:

- Gilmour notched his third two-goal game of the season and the 11th multi-goal effort of his career.
- Gilmour moved up to 7th place on the school's all-time goal scoring list with 35.
- Braak is the first 'true' freshman to score two goals in a game since Christian Alexander did it in a 5-0 result at Georgetown on 10/6/12.
- The Jackets had the edge in shots overall (24-12) and on goal (14-3).
- Trevecca saved two shots off the line. Each team hit the crossbar once.
- CU leads the all-time series at 7-0-1.

HEAD COACH BRETT FARO



Brett Faro has been the head men's soccer coach at Cedarville University since the 2013 season after serving as the program's top assistant for two years. He's guided the Yellow Jackets to back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference championships.

CU finished 14-4-2 overall and 7-0-1 during the 2014 campaign. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament and defeated Davis & Elkins, 1-0, in the title match.

Faro was named the program's interim head coach in July, 2013 and later had the interim tag removed in November just before the G-MAC Tournament. Cedarville played host and #1 seed D&E to a 0-0 draw in the final and then claimed the trophy on penalty kicks. The Jackets ended up 13-3-4 overall and 6-1-1 G-MAC.

CU has gone 58-17-10 since Faro's arrival including a school-record 17 victories in 2012. The Jackets won the 2011 NCCAA Midwest Region banner and placed third at the national tournament.

Faro came to Cedarville after serving as an assistant coach at the United States Naval Academy during the 2010 campaign. He helped guide the Midshipmen to a 7-5-4 record.

Faro has been involved in multiple levels of soccer in coaching and administration. He coached the U17 Maryland Nike Rush '93 in 2010-11 and helped lead the NCSL Division I squad to three tournament championships.

Faro was team manager of Sky Blue FC of Women's

Professional Soccer in 2010. He also coached and trained players in the Hershey Youth Soccer Club in 2007 and 2008.

Faro was a four-year standout during his playing career at perennial NCAA Division III powerhouse Messiah College from 2005-09. He was a member of four national championship teams, was a two-time team captain, and tied the school record for the most games played in a career with 99.

Faro is a 2009 graduate of Messiah with a degree in sports management. He was a Dean's List student at the school and was recognized as an NSCAA Academic All-Region Scholar-Athlete.

Faro earned a master's degree in coaching and athletic administration from Concordia University Irvine (Calif.) in 2014. He also possesses an NSCAA national diploma.

Brett and his wife, Shelley, were married on May 31, 2014. They reside in Xenia.
