## Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Ursuline College Arrows tonight in the Callan Athletic Center in the final contest of a three-game homestand for CU.

Cedarville enters the game with a record of 9-6 after posting an 83-70 decision over visiting Notre Dame College OH on Saturday afternoon.

Ursuline is in transition to a full NCAA II program and has joined with CU as charter members of the recently formed Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC). The Arrows are 6-9 on the season with their most recent action a 64-52 setback to visiting Malone this past Saturday.

The Lady Jacket roster features two players hitting in double figures. Kayla Jenerette, a 5-foot-5 sophomore guard, leads the team at 18.5 points per game including a 98-175 effort from the field for a team-best .560 mark.

Deborah Gordon, a 5-foot-11 rookie forward, is adding a second-best 11.6 points per contest while pacing CU with 7.1 rebounds per game. Gordon is shooting a second-best .544 from the field.

CU's third-leading scorer is Raegan Ryan. The 5-foot-5 freshman guard is tossing in 9.1 points per game while leading the squad with 55 assists, 29 steals and an .871 (27-for-31) accuracy mark at the charity stripe.

Senior Kara Cayton has slowly inched up the scoring ranks with some solid play. The 5-foot-4 long-range specialist, averaging 6.1 ppg, is second on the team with 22 three-pointers. Cayton is also second on the squad with 54 assists.

Sophomore guard Becky Orchard adds 6 points per game while handing out a third-best 53 assists. Orchard is the second-leading Lady Jacket rebounder at 4.3 boards a game.

Post player Lauryn Robinson, a 6-foot-2 sophomore transfer from Wayne State, is contributing 5.9 points and 3.5 boards a game.

Sophomore forward Deborah Chandler returned to the lineup over the Christmas break after missing six games with a broken hand. Chandler is scoring 4.8 points per game with a team-high .882 from the free-throw line.

Danielle Spiliotis, a 6-foot-1 center, is tied with Orchard as CU's second-leading rebounder at 4.3 boards per contest.

The Arrows lineup features several talented offensive players. Katie Cappello, a 5-foot-8 sophomore guard, is averaging 14.8 points per game and 6.1 boards per contest.

Laura Campbell, a 5-foot-9 junior forward, adds 10.3 points per game for Ursuline. She is the leader at the free throw line with an .844 effort (27-for-32).

The top deep-threat for the Arrows is Brooke Trauthwein. The freshman guard from Dayton, Ohio is hitting .337 from behind the arc on a 33-of-98 shooting effort.

Brianna Woods, a 5-foot-5 rookie guard, directs the Arrows offense with a team-leading 77 assists. She adds 4.8 points per game to the Ursuline offense.

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with Ursuline by a 9-0 margin. Cedarville double-up the Arrows on Dec. 4, 2010 by a 98-49 final in the Callan Athletic Center. Ursuline gave CU a tussle on Feb. 8, 2011 in Pepper Pike, Ohio before falling to the Lady Jackets by a score of 64-57.

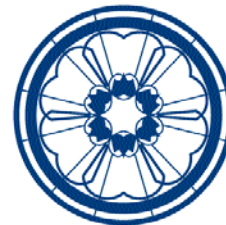

## Last Time Out

Kayla Jenerette scored 24 points and Kara Cayton added 17 to lead the Lady Jackets to an 83-70 win against Notre Dame (Ohio) in the Callan Athletic Center on Saturday afternoon.

Jenerette had the hot hand for Cedarville in the opening half. She knocked down 15 points to guide the home team to a 43-39 lead.

The contest remained tight with CU hanging on to a 57-56 edge with 12:10 remaining. The Jackets took command with a 14-2 spurt and built the margin to as much as 75-61 at the 3:30 mark.

Jenerette hit 9-of-16 shots from the field including a trio of three-pointers for Cedarville, 9-6 overall. Cayton also drilled three treys, dished out a career-high nine assists, and came away with four steals.

The Yellow Jackets shot 54 percent from the field and hit 9-of-20 attempts outside the arc. NDC falls to 7-10.

## Looking Ahead

After a rare Saturday with no game this weekend, Cedarville will make the short trip to Wilberforce, Ohio on Tuesday, January 24 for a 7 p.m. tipoff versus the Marauders of Central State University.

On Saturday, January 28, the Lady Jackets host the Urbana University Blue Knights as part of the annual Alumni Weekend. The contest is slated for a 5:30 p.m. tipoff.

On Wednesday, Feb. 1, the CU will host Salem International in a 5:30 p.m. contest against the Tigers.

## Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season and built the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country. His teams have averaged 27 wins per season during his tenure.

Martin's team made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. CU knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

The Jackets won the school's fifth American Midwest Conference championship in 2009-10 and finished 27-6 overall and 17-2 AMC. The Jackets were ranked No. 5 in the final NAIA Division II poll and ultimately advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

It was the second straight NAIA appearance for the CU women. They also earned an automatic berth in 2009 by finishing second in the demanding AMC.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin guided CU to five straight NAIA Division II national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets sport a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned the American Midwest Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2003 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Cedarville was rated No. 5 in the final 2006-07 NAIA Division II national poll en route to a 27-7 record. They held down the No. 1 position in 2005-06 which was the second straight year that the Lady Jackets accomplished the feat. They rolled to a 29-4 record overall which included a 19-game winning streak.

The Lady Jackets nearly met their ultimate goal of a national title in 2004-05 while posting a 35-2 record. Other highlights that season included a NAIA No. 1 ranking for the final six weeks of the season, a 22-game winning streak, and a second straight 18-0 run through the AMC South Division.

Martin's 2003-04 ball club produced a memorable campaign while being ranked as high as No. 2 in NAIA Division II. Among the team's many achievements were setting a school record for the most wins in a season with a 35-3 record, rolling to a perfect 18-0 league mark, and assembling a school-record 23-game winning streak.

Cedarville had a 31-3 overall record in the 2002-03 season, posted a 21-game winning streak, claimed the AMC South Division with a 17-1 mark, and won the inaugural AMC championship game. The Jackets were ranked as high as No. 3 in the country and qualified for the NAIA Division II national tournament for the first time in school history where the team advanced to the second round.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish 4th in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25. Cedarville qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, along with their two children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Dayton with his wife, Rachel.

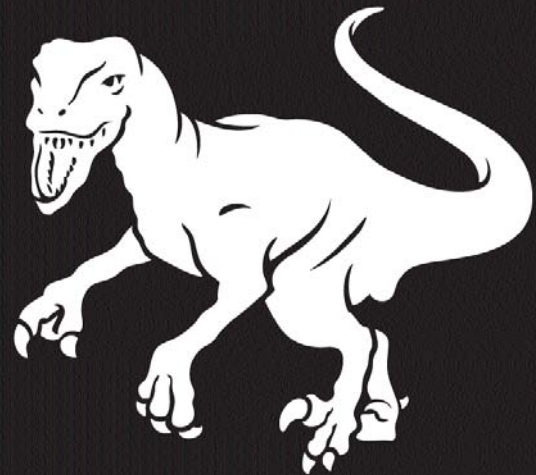

## DII liberalizes recruiting legislation

The Division II membership demonstrated its flexibility for new ways of doing business during its Convention business session held Saturday, January 14 – and it did so without a twist.

Delegates approved 16 legislative proposals, all sponsored by the Division II Presidents Council, by large margins and with a minimum of debate.

Though there was little controversy at the end, that shouldn't diminish the importance of the primary changes. As a result of the Convention's actions, regulations affecting recruiting were changed in ways that will affect Division II for years to come.

The new recruiting provisions (Nos. 2012-11, 12 and 13) will provide a common start date for all in-person, telephonic and electronic forms of contact – June 15 before a prospect's junior year of high school. In addition, there will be no restrictions on the number of contacts, other than in cases where contact is prohibited by Division II recruiting calendars.

Proponents noted that the legislation will provide more opportunities for legitimate conversations between coaches and prospects, would put Division II in a better position to react to future technological changes and would bring the athletics recruiting process more in line with traditional students' experiences. In addition, the reduced oversight will reduce the burden currently placed on Division II compliance administrators.

Acknowledging concerns that the more open approach could be misapplied, Cal State Monterey Bay President Dianne Harrison cited the high ground upon which most programs and coaches operate and added, "I don't think we should be deterred by the possibility of abuse."

She noted that Division II presidents may make guidelines available not only for coaches (the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee will distribute a best-practices document soon) but also for prospects and their parents. She also said the presidents might consider a reporting mechanism for parents or prospects who believe the rule is being abused.

There was hallway talk at the Convention that some constituents favored the earlier date but not the unlimited-contact aspect, and vice versa. However, nobody spoke in opposition to any of the three proposals, and they passed by votes of 250-35-2, 260-29-0 and 267-18-0.

Bogner attributed the decisive outcome to openness and communication.

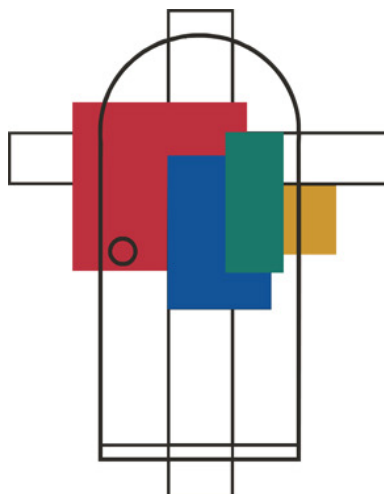

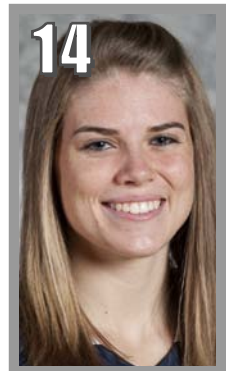

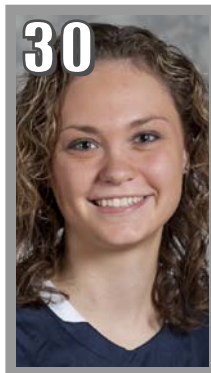
