Last Time Out

Kayla Linkous erupted for career-highs of 34 points and 13 rebounds to lead Cedarville to a 78-73 verdict over Kentucky Wesleyan in a key Great Midwest Athletic Conference game played in the Callan Athletic Center on Thursday night.

The Lady Jackets, 14-2 overall and 5-0 G-MAC, remain as the only unbeaten team in the league. KWC falls to 8-6 and 4-1.

Cedarville broke a 19-19 tie with 13 straight points to take a lead it would never relinquish. It was 34-29 at halftime.



Kayla Linkous

Linkous made one-of-two free throws at the 15:14 mark for the Lady Jackets' largest margin of the night, 49-34. Once KWC clawed back to within three midway through the second half, the junior forward scored 16 of the team's next 19 points to inch the difference out to nine.

Linkous finished 9-for-12 from the field, made her only three-point attempt, and was 15-for-16 at the stripe. She also contributed three assists.

Raegan Ryan contributed 18 points, four assists, and four steals. Freshmen Regina Hochstetler and Breanne Watterworth chipped in nine points each.

Numbers Game:

- In the second half alone, Linkous tallied 29 points and 7 rebounds. She was 7-for-8 from the field, banked in her only three-point attempt, and made 14-of-15 free throws.
- In her last three games, Linkous is averaging 24 points and 10.3 rebounds while shooting .622 (23-for-37) from the field and .889 (24-for-27) at the line.
- The crowd of 732 was a season high.





The Lady Jackets host Great Midwest Athletic Conference foe Ohio Valley University on Thursday, Jan. 22 for a 5:30 p.m. tip-off against the Fighting Scots. Cedarville will visit Salem International one week from today, Saturday, Jan. 24 for a 2 p.m. league encounter with the Tigers.

Player of the Week (Jan. 5-11, 2015)

Kayla Linkous Cedarville • Junior • New Madison, OH

Kayla Linkous has been named the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this year and continues to add to Cedarville's dominance on the award this season. Linkous helped Cedarville to a pair of G-

MAC victory, helping them remain undefeated in conference and in a fourway tie atop the standings.

Kayla Linkous has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this season, but is now the third Lady Jacket to earn the honor and grabbed the fifth Athlete of the Week honor in eight weeks for Cedarville this season.

Linkous helped guide the Lady Jackets to another perfect week in which they improved to 13-2 and 4-0 in conference play with wins over Davis and Elkins and Alderson Broaddus on the road. On the week she averaged 19 points and 9.5 rebounds over the two wins.

Against Davis & Elkins she scored a game-high 20 points and also led the way with nine rebounds. She then recorded a double-double a few nights later, scoring 18 and grabbing 10 boards against the Battlers. The Lady Jackets won the two games by an average of 38 points.

On the season, Linkous is now scoring 10.7 points per game, ranking her 16th in the league and second on her team. She came into the week averaging only 3.6 rebounds and her 19 rebounds quickly raised it to 4.9 a game.



Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 25.5 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.

Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville posted an 18-10 record last winter and was 13-3 in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. The women were among the G-MAC leaders the entire season and advanced to the league tournament semifinals.

The Lady Jackets ended up 20-10 in their first active NCAA season in 2012-13 and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. CU captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, was the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship title.

Cedarville made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and a pair of second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating



from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a six-time Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three children, who are all Cedarville graduates: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Worthington, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, and their three children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, lives in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their two children; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, resides in Springfield, Ohio.





Jackets Succeed in Classroom



CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Cedarville University student-athletes continue to be just as impressive in the classroom as they are in the field of competition.

The Yellow Jackets remain among the best in Division II according to the recently released NCAA Academic Success Rate data.

CU tied for 12th nationally among 313 Division II schools in Federal Graduation Rate at 78 percent. The FGR computes the percentage of student-athletes, who earned their degree in the six-year window from the 2007-08 academic year through 2012-13.

The Academic Success Rate (ASR) calculates how studentathletes are making satisfactory progress toward a degree. Cedarville, at 91 percent, tied for 21st in the country in that category.

Fran Campbell, Assistant Academic Vice President for Student Success & University Registrar, proclaimed, "We are pleased to confirm that the academic success and graduation rates for our student-athletes remain very strong, and even improved in comparison with last year's commendable percentages.

"Although the graduation rate for our overall student body decreased slightly to 70% for this reporting cycle, this rate for our student-athletes increased to 78%. This is a notable comparison which reflects very positively on the quality and achievements of our student-athletes!"

According to the NCAA report, the FGR for all Division II student-athletes across the country is 55 percent, an improvement of one percent over last year, while the rate for the overall student body remained the same at 48 percent. The DII national ASR average is 71 percent.

Athletic Director Dr. Alan Geist added, "This is a great achievement. God continually blesses Cedarville University with tremendous student-athletes who take all aspects of their education seriously.

"As always, I want to say thanks to our coaching staff and to each member of our faculty, staff, and administration for all they have done to help our student-athletes be successful in the classroom."
