Today's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Alderson Broaddus University Battlers today in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, with a 6-8 record (2-2 G-MAC), had their threegame winning streak snapped on Thursday with a 76-75 setback to visiting Davis & Elkins in a G-MAC battle.

Alderson Broaddus, 2-12 overall with a 2-4 mark in the G-MAC, produced a last-second 58-57 victory at Central State on Thursday night. Rookie Korie Maryo hit a three-point field goal with less than 10 seconds left to secure the league win.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 319-94 (.772). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 74.6 points per game while allowing opponents 74.5 points per outing. The Lady Jackets are the top free-throw shooting squad in the G-MAC with a .745 performance.

Senior Kayla Jenerette is one of three players hitting in double-digits for CU. The 5-4 guard continues to lead Cedarville with a 15 ppg scoring average after 14 games. Jenerette, with a thirdbest career .806 mark at the free throw line, is 48-of-59 this year for an .814 effort. She paces the team with 28 three-point field goals and ranks fifth all-time with 220 long-range shots. Jenerette ranks #11 all-time on the CU scoring charts with 1,607 points.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is Cedarville's second-leading scorer at 11 ppg and rebounder at 5.4 boards per game.

The third Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.6 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 7.3 boards per contest. Gordon recorded her second double-double (13 pts, 12 rbs) in Thursday's game versus Davis & Elkins.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's fourth-leading scorer at 9.9 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (59) and steals (20). Ryan has hit a third-best 16 field goals from behind the arc.

Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-9 sophomore guard, is averaging 7.6 points per game while hitting a second-best 21 three-point field goals (21-of-48, .438). She is scoring 11.8 points per outing in her last five games

Alderson Broaddus is under the direction of ninth-year Head Coach Josh Allen. The former Battler was a three-time All-West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference selection and was MVP of the 2004 WVIAC Tournament

AB is scoring a league-low 59.1 points per game while allowing opponents 72.5 points per contest after 14 games this season. The Battlers are hitting .365 from the field including a .350 effort from behind the arc.

The balanced offense of Alderson Broaddus is paced by Sydney Shaffer with 9.8 points per game. She lead AB with 18 points on Thursday at CSU. Natalie Smith leads with 39 assists and 27 three-point baskets.

Today's game is the first-ever meeting between the two schools in women's basketball. The squads will meet again on February 8 in Phillipi, West Virginia.

Last Time Out

Davis & Elkins scored with nine seconds remaining and escaped a potential game-winning shot by Cedarville to pull out a 76-75 Great Midwest Athletic Conference victory in the Callan Athletic Center on Thursday night.



Deborah Gordon converted a three-point play with 20 seconds left to give the hosts a 75-74 edge. The Senators were fouled on what was the game-winner and missed the free throw, but the Lady Jackets misfired on a three-pointer at the buzzer.

CU held the lead for the majority of the contest, yet, the home team had to rally from a four-point deficit in the waning moments. Kaysie Brittenham drilled a three-pointer with 27 seconds to go to bring the Jackets within one before Gordon made her big play.

Brittenham totaled a career-high 16 points to go along with 4 assists and 4 steals for CU. Kayla Jenerette contributed 13 points and 6 assists.

Gordon was good for a double-double of 11 points and 11 rebounds while Kayla Linkous chipped in 10 points.

The contest featured nine lead changes and 15 ties. Davis & Elkins held the lead only briefly in the first half, but got it tied by the break, 31-31.

Cedarville had a seven-point lead on five occasions - the last of which was 47-40 with 13:45 to play.

Next week, the Lady Jackets travel to Ohio Valley University in Vienna, WV on Thursday, January 23. The G-MAC game is slated for 5:30 PM. On Saturday, January 25, CU will be in Salem, WV for a 2:00 PM G-MAC contest at Salem International University.

Saturday, February 1 is Li'l Sibs and Alumni Weekend. CU will host Central State in a G-MAC encounter beginning at 5:30 PM.





Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.



Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runnerup finishes, and six conference championships.

Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

G-MAC Player of the Week

Karly Rhoads has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this sea-

son, but is the third different Lady Panther to be selected this season. Rhoads scored a conference season-high 32 points in a win over Davis & Elkins. She averaged 21 points per game last week in two conference wins as KWC remained a perfect 6-0 in G-MAC play.

Rhoads combined to shoot 71.4% from the floor on the week, converting on 15 of 21 shot attempts. She was also 7-7 from the free throw line, all coming against D&E, and was on the mark no matter where she shot from, shooting the same 71.4% (5-7) from long range.

Defensively, Rhoads recorded four steals, again all coming against D&E in the victory. She led (or tied for the lead) in games played last week with ten field goals made, 32 points, five 3-pointers made, and 83.3% shooting from long range (5-6), all against D&E.

With her scoring effort last week, Rhoads improved her season average to 13.7 points per game and moved up the list to fourth in the conference in scoring. She is one of two players to have over 200 points scored this season. She also increased her shooting percentage to 53.8% (fifth best in conference), her free throw percentage to 88.2% (best in conference), and her three-point percentage to 48.8% (second best in conference).




