

LADY JACKET SOCCER BLOG

Oct. 14, 2014

I approach this blog asking myself, "When exactly were we in Ohio last week?" It's a valid question when you consider that it was a week of road trips to West Virginia for the Lady Jackets. We devoted part of Tuesday and all of Wednesday to visiting Davis & Elkins and spent Saturday at Alderson Broaddus. Both games were great, both for our record and, slightly more importantly, for this blog. For the former, we ended this week with a hard-fought tie and a big win. For the latter, we had very different traveling experiences for the two trips. D&E was an athletic bus/van combo and AB involved a Buckeye Charter bus.

Of course we get Chick-fil-A after the game - Charter Chicken time. These connections are no less irrational, but they are decidedly more positive.

Clearly, I have no future as a sports psychologist. You'd be hard-pressed to find anything that holds real weight in what I just wrote. That's because this is all in jest. Anything less is a failure in perspective...so I realized...on the charter bus. (juuuuust kidding!)

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University women's soccer team hosts the Salem International University Tigers in Great Midwest Athletic Conference action tonight at Yellow Jacket Field. The game was originally scheduled for tomorrow night at 6 p.m.

The Jackets, 7-4-1 (2-3-1), posted their fourth-consecutive shutout on Saturday - a 2-0 verdict at G-MAC foe Alderson Broaddus.

The Tigers are 0-7 (0-5) including a 6-0 league loss to visiting Kentucky Weslevan last Thursday.

Sophomore Grace Miorelli tops the Lady Jackets with a team-high six goals with four assists for 16 points.

Senior forward Kristie Wolff is CU's secondleading scorer with two goals and nine assists for 13 points.



The Lady Jackets third-leading scorer is senior Elise Hurley with four goals and three assists for 11 points.

Jacoby Ziegler, a junior forward who repeated as the G-MAC Offensive Player of the Year in 2013, has four tallies for eight points.

Carly Gregory, a junior, was the G-MAC Defensive Player of the Year. She and Ziegler were joined on the 2013 all-conference first team by Miorelli and junior defender Kaleigh Rowlands.

Junior Sara Rogers has a pair of goals including the game-winner on Saturday at Alderson Broaddus.

Sophomore keeper Hanna Harris has allowed 12 goals while making 47 saves en route to a 0.98 goals against average. Harris, with five shutouts this season, has 14 in her career which ranks second all-time at Cedarville. She trails Alysia Bennett who posted 16 whitewashes during her time at CU.

SIU is under the leadership of Head Coach Joe Hayes.


Jessica Guzman has a goal and an assist for three points to pace the Tigers. Leidy Sanchez has team's only other goal.

Sarah Jacques has played every minute in the nets for Salem allowing 47 goals while making 100 saves in seven contests.

Cedarville has won both of the previous two meetings with the Tigers - a 12-0 decision on October 20, 2011 in Cedarville equalling a school record for most goals in a single game. Last October 15, the Lady Jackets recorded a 1-0 decision at Salem International on a goal by Kait Stiles in the 35th minute.



HEAD COACH JOHN MCGILLIVRAY



John McGillivray is one of the most well-respected soccer coaches in the state of Ohio and has been coaching soccer at Cedarville University since 1974.

McGillivray has been the head coach of the Lady Jackets since 1998. He served as the Cedarville men's head coach from 1974 through 1997.

Coupled with the 137 wins with the women, McGillivray has 352 total soccer victories at CU. His 300th overall win came in a 5-0 decision over Grace on Aug. 28, 2008. He picked up his 100th

victory with the Lady Jackets in a 2-1 result at Point Park on Oct. 17, 2009.

McGillivray has enjoyed seven winning seasons with the Lady Jackets including a best-ever 15-7 mark in 2013. CU led the Great Midwest Athletic Conference with a 9-1 regular season mark and McGillivray was voted G-MAC Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished 13-8-2 in 2004, won NCCAA Midwest Region championship, and secured an automatic berth in the NCCAA National Tournament. The 2000 club had a 12-7-2 record and made the school's first-ever NCCAA championship appearance in women's soccer.

McGillivray and his teams have long been recognized for their sportsmanlike behavior. His Lady Jackets twice received the Fair Play Team Award from the American Mideast Conference for their exemplary conduct on the field. He was presented the first-ever Distinguished Merit Award in 1990 by the Ohio Collegiate Soccer Officials Association. The National Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Association honored him in 1992 with their National Merit Award.

The Springfield, Ohio native led his men's teams to eight Mid-Ohio Conference titles, five NCCAA District III banners, three NAIA District 22 championships, and one NAIA Area IV crown which carried with it a trip to the NAIA Nationals in 1974. He guided his squad to five NCCAA National

Tournament appearances, a pair of NCCAA National Runner-Up finishes and he was chosen NCCAA National Coach of the Year in 1981.

McGillivray served at all levels of NAIA soccer including president of the NAIA Soccer Coaches Association from 1983 through 1985. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1991 and the NAIA Hall of Fame in 1993.

McGillivray, who is an associate professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Allied Health, is a 1970 graduate of Cedarville College, and he earned his master's degree in 1976 from the University of Dayton. John and his wife, Bonnie, reside in Cedarville and have five children and 15 grandchildren.
