## FACULTY HOLDS SELF-STUDY SESSIONS

December 18 marked this academic year's mass exodus of the student body for the Christmas holidays. For the faculty, this was just the keynote for the following two days which were spent in discussions involving the College self-study program.

As was reported in the November issue of the NEWS, the self-study was begun over a year ago. The investigation has been divided among committees of the faculty as follows: alumni, administration, curriculum, faculty preparation, finance, library, physical plant, testing, and student affairs committee. During the course of the two day sessions, all committees reported preliminary findings. The consensus of opinion was that the sessions were helpful and enlightening, while at the same time quite revealing.

This by no means marked the end of the self-study, but rather gave the impetus to continue. The problems to be faced prior to becoming accredited seem at times almost insurmountable, but with the help of the Lord these shall be overcome. Optimism was expressed concerning the points of progress made evident through the reports.

The response of the Alumni to the questionnaire pertaining to the self-study, has been gratifying, but not as yet adequate. At this writing, 96 of 261 graduates (37%) have responded. It is of considerable importance that many more Alumni respond. If you have not as yet returned your questionnaire, please do so immediately. We're all interested in having an accredited college. Your attention to this will aid the attaining of this goal.

A report of the Alumni Committee will eventually be sent to the Alumni.
