Weekend Series

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Trevecca University Trojans in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference four-game series this weekend at Lady Jacket Field.

Cedarville enters the action with a record of 14-18 (5-3) after sweeping a G-MAC twinbill Wednesday afternoon with visiting Ursuline.

Trevecca brings a 23-13 (7-1) mark into the weekend including taking 3-of-4 games last weekend in Nashville against league opponent Davis & Elkins.

Cedarville's Brianne O'Dell, a sophomore infielder/outfielder, leads the team in hitting with a .388 mark including a team-high 40 base hits.

Sophomore first baseman Nikki Eigsti is CU's second-leading hitter with a .353 average while senior Nicole Davis ranks third with a .352 batting mark. Davis leads the Lady Jackets in runs (18), doubles (10), triples (2), RBI's (21) and total bases (51).

Ansley Brantley, a senior infielder, is one of the main offensive threats for TNU with a .406 batting average and team-bests in hits (39), HR's (7), runs (38), total bases (69) and slugging pct. (.719).

Senior hurler Haley Fagan has a 16-9 mark, a 3.04 ERA, 15 complete games and 138 K's in 157 innings.

Trevecca leads the all-time series with the Lady Jackets by a 15-1 margin. The Trojans swepts all five contests with CU during the 2015 campaign including the G-MAC final on May 2 at the Athletes in Action Complex in Xenia, Ohio.

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Morgan Arbogast and Brooke Farrer combined to limit Ursuline to eight total hits in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference softball sweep.

The Lady Jackets won by scores of 2-1 and 5-1 to improve to 14-18 overall and 5-3 G-MAC.

In the opener, Arbogast, 4-7, struck out a season-high eight batters to win her third straight game.

Freshman shortstop Hope Griffith had two of the team's seven hits including a double. Brianne O'Dell added a double.

Nicole Davis was 3-for-3 at the plate and scored two runs.

Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced an average of 27.3 victories per year including school-record 35-win efforts in 2012, 2014, and 2015. The Lady Jackets have produced five consecutive winning seasons for the first time in school his-

tory.



Cedarville was the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up during the league's first year in 2013 and again in 2015. Rowe guided Cedarville to its second straight NCCAA Midwest Region championship in 2012 and his team has made four national tournament appearances in all - 2011, 2012, 2014, and 2015.

Rowe has coached one NCCAA National Player of the Year, eight

NCCAA All-Americans, and 33 All-Region performers. A total of 16 of his players have been recognized as scholar-athletes.

Prior to coming to Cedarville, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.

Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. All four of their children have graduated from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009. The Rowes also have two grandchildren.


