

Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Ursuline College Arrows in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC) contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center.

The Lady Jackets, under the leadership of fifth-year Head Coach Doug Walters, enter tonight's action with a 14-3 (1-0 G-MAC) record and a #8 ranking in the latest National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) Division I Poll.

CU participated in the Wheeling Jesuit Invitational this past weekend and came away with two wins in four matches. Cedarville posted victories over Glenville State and Ohio Valley while suffering setbacks to Alderson-Broaddus and the host Cardinals who were ranked #16 in last week's NCAA II National Poll.

Sophomore outside hitter Hannah Wagner continues to lead the front row attack for Cedarville with 174 kills and 2.81 kills per set.

Junior middle hitter Stephanie Rogers, 2011 NCCAA All-American, is second with 2.46 kills per set while pacing the squad with a continually improving attack percentage of .284. Rogers needs just 17 kills to become the 18th Lady Jacket to reach 1,000 career kills.



Setters senior Erica Bartholomew and sophomore Maddie Anderson direct CU's offense. Anderson leads the team with 369 assists and 32 aces. Bartholomew has handed out 257 assists and ranks fourth all-time at CU with Stephanie Rogers

Senior Heather Kirkpatrick tops the defensive stats with 290 digs (4.68/set). She is closing in on the impressive 2,000 career digs mark.

Rookie Lori Inkrott is making contributions as an all-around performer with a fourth-best 120 kills and a third-best 146 digs.

Ursuline, in their provisional year of NCAA II transition, is led by seventh-year head coach Donna Day (72-144).

Junior outside hitter Alex Leister is the main offensive threat for the Ursuline attack with 186 kills and a .123 attack percentage.

Setter Ashley Reinhart, a 5-9 junior, tops Ursuline with 305 assists. Kelly Stenger, a 5-4 sophomore, leads the defensive efforts with 277 digs (5.04/set).



The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with Ursuline by a 6-0 mark. The two teams met twice last year - a 25-

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 82 victories during Walters' four-year tenure. CU finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA Division II provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the 2008 NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Cedarville was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. CU was 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a fourtime conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is the Elevation Volleyball Club 17's National Team Coach based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Hamersville, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 10.

The Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC), which was approved by the NCAA Division II Membership Committee in February of 2012 as a member conference effective September 1, 2012, will be working through an educational assessment program with the goal of beginning competition as the 24th active NCAA Division II conference by 2013-14.

The G-MAC features active and reclassifying members from Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia. Charter members of the G-MAC include Cedarville University, Central State University, Kentucky Wesleyan College, Trevecca Nazarene University, Urbana University and Ursuline College. The G-MAC expanded with the inclusion of Alderson-Broaddus College, Davis & Elkins College, and Ohio Valley University as active DII members in 2012.

The University of Virginia's College at Wise was approved as a Full Member, while Georgetown College was added as a Provisional Member in 2012 as well.

The G-MAC, headquartered in the Indianapolis metro area, will sponsor 12 championships in 2012-13 as a NCAA Division II member conference.


