## TWO ALUMNI RESIGN POSITIONS

It is with regret that we announce the resignations of two faculty members, both of whom are Alumni.

Dr. John Brumbaugh ('58) has resigned to accept the position of Assistant Professor of Zoology at the University of Nebraska, Lincoln, Nebraska. Dr. Brumbaugh taught one year ('59-60) before leaving to pursue graduate study toward the Ph. D. which he received in May, 1963, from Iowa State University. He returned to Cedarville shortly thereafter and has been engaged in teaching this year. His resignation comes primarily due to a problem of health in the family.

Mr. Lane Moody ('58) has submitted his resignation after having been associated with the Department of Health and Physical Education for the last two years. Mr. Moody in his first year with the College coached the baseball team to its first Mid-Ohio Championship and has a good opportunity to repeat this year. He is resigning for personal reasons and plans for the future are incomplete.
