Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Central State University Marauders tonight in the Callan Athletic Center in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game as part of Alumni Weekend.

Cedarville is 11-6 (2-1 G-MAC) on the year including last Saturday's 77-65 non-league setback to the visiting Notre Dame College Falcons.

Central State is 12-5 (0-2 G-MAC) including their most recent action - an 86-74 victory against Wilberforce one week ago.

The Lady Jackets continue to be led in scoring by Kayla Jenerette - the only player hitting in double figures. The 5-foot-4 guard paces the team at 14.6 points per game including 33 field goals from behind the three-point arc. Jenerette is the leader in steals with 21 and is second with 54 assists.

Kayla Linkous, a 5-11 rookie forward, is scoring 8.7 ppg with an impressive .578 mark from the field (52-for-90). Linkous, who missed last Saturday's game with a knee injury, is grabbing a third-best 4.7 rebounds per game.

CU's third-leading scorer is Raegan Ryan. The 5-foot-5 sophomore guard is tossing in 8.6 points per game while hitting 25-for-30 from the free throw line for a solid .833. Ryan also tops the squad in assists with 83 while posting a second-best 29 three-pointers and 20 steals.

Deborah Chandler, a 6-0 junior forward, is the Lady Jackets fourth-best scorer at 8.2 points per game with 3.8 boards a night.

Junior guard Becky Orchard is adding 7 point per game, is 9-for-10 at the free throw line and has a third-best 24 three-point field goals and 40 assists.

Sophomore Deborah Gordon, a 5-11 forward, is scoring 6.1 points per contest while adding 3.2 rebounds per game.

Post player Lauryn Robinson, a 6-2 junior, is bringing down a team-high 8.5 rebounds per game while averaging 5.3 points per contest. Robinson is tied with Central State's Tanija Beasley for the top rebounding mark in the G-MAC.

Junior Danielle Spiliotis tosses in 5.1 points per contest and a second-best 5.4 rebounds per game. She has a team-best 17 blocked shots this year.

Cedarville is scoring 67.5 points per game while allowing opponents 62.6 points per game. The Lady Jackets hold a +6.6 edge in rebounding and a 269-200 lead in total assists. CU is holding their opponents to a .344 mark (363-1056) from the field - 21st best in NCAA II.

The Central State women's basketball program is led by former Marauder Sheba Harris.

The Marauders average 69.6 points per contest while giving up 64.1 points per game. Opponents are shooting just .249 from long-range against CSU - the 15th best mark in NCAA II.

Shakeira Lang, a 5-foot-5 sophomore, will set the offensive tone for CSU. She is scoring 10.3 ppg while pacing the squad in three-point field goals and steals.

Tanija Beasley, a 6-foot senior, adds 9.4 points per game and is the top rebounder at 8.5 rpg.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Marauders by a 19-16 margin. The Lady Jackets posted three wins over CSU during the 2011-12 campaign including a 75-67 decision in the semifinals of the OIC at CU.

Last Time Out 

Notre Dame placed five players in double figures and used a decisive second half performance to leave the Callan Athletic Center with a 77-65 victory over the Lady Jackets in a non-conference game last Saturday.

Cedarville took a 38-35 lead into the halftime locker room with a solid 53 percent showing from the field. The shooting went south and the Falcons took advantage by outscoring the hosts 42-27 in the final 20 minutes.

NDC, 6-11 overall, never relinquished the lead in the final 15 minutes even though the Lady Jackets made a charge a got to within 64-62 with 4:30 left. The Falcons scored the next four points and finished the game with a 13-3 run.

Kayla Jenerette scored 17 points with four assists to lead Cedarville, 11-6. Lauryn Robinson had a double-double of 11 points and 11 rebounds, Becky Orchard totaled 11 points with six assists, and Deborah Chandler added 11 points.

"I must give a phenomenal amount of credit to Notre Dame," said Head Coach Kirk Martin. "They played with energy, played hard, and played smart. They were better than us today. We just couldn't match their intensity."

Notre Dame's bench did most of the damage. The non-starters went 8-for-13 outside the arc and produced three double-figure scorers.

Looking Ahead 

One week from today, Saturday, Feb. 2, Cedarville hosts the Salem International University Tigers in non-conference action beginning at 2:00 p.m.

The squad makes a trip to Oakland City University on Tuesday, Feb. 6 for a non-conference affair slated for a 6:00 p.m. start.

Cedarville returns to the Callan Athletic Center for three consecutive Great Midwest Athletic Conference games against Trevecca Nazarene (Sat., Feb. 9), Urbana (Tues., Feb. 12) and (Sat., Feb. 16) Ursuline.

Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he turns his attention to the school's first year in NCAA Division II.



Martin's teams have averaged 26.6 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.

Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 10 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets were the NCCAA runner-up after winning the Midwest Region banner and they also claimed the Ohio Independent Championship title.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Midwest Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a six-time Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, and their three children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Fairborn, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their two children; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Columbus, Ohio with his wife, Rachel.

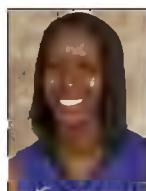

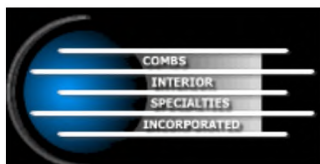
