

### **Tonight's Game Preview**

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Walsh University Cavaliers in an American Mideast Conference battle today in the Callan Athletic Center as part of Alumni Weekend.

Cedarville enters the contest with a record of 10-9 and 5-3 in the AMC. The Jackets dropped a 99-93 overtime decision versus Point Park last Saturday afternoon in Pennsylvania. Walsh brings a perfect 18-0 record (8-0 AMC) and a #1-ranking in NAIA Division II into tonight's matchup. The Cavs most recent action was also a week ago when they clipped visiting Mount Vernon Nazarene 89-66.

The Yellow Jackets lineup continues to feature four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive attack is senior guard Matt Harner - averaging 18.9 points per game with a team-high 69 three-point field goals - which ranks second in NAIA Division II. Harner also tops the squad with a .448 mark from behind the arc.



Sophomore forward Brian Hecker contributes 13.6 ppg and is CU's second-leading rebounder at 5.4 rpg. He is fourth on the team with 24 three-pointers.

Senior point guard Derrick Hannon is hitting 11.5 points per contest and leads the Jackets and the AMC with 100 assists. He is the Jackets' fourthleading rebounder at 4.1 per game.

Sophomore guard Austin Foote is scoring 11.5 points per game and adds firepower from outside the three-point line.

Adam Riehle, a 6-3 senior forward, tops the Yellow Jacket rebounders at 6.5 per game. He adds

8.6 points per contest while pacing the squad with a .632 field goal percentage.

Cedarville is shooting .467 from the field including 171-of-497 attempts from the three-point line for a .344 mark. The team is slowly improving at the charity stripe with a 182-of-305 effort (.597).

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by a narrow +1.3 points per game (79.6 to 78.3). The Yellow Jackets are winning the rebounding battle by the slimmest of margins.

The talented Cavaliers - with six players in double figures - are led by AMC Player of the Week Lamar Skeeter. The 6-0 senior guard tops Walsh with 17.4 points per game and is the squad's third-leading rebounder at 5.9 rpg.

Jeremy Shardo, a 6-3 senior guard, adds 15.9 ppg and is ranked in the AMC's Top 10 in assists (74) and steals (35). He hits over 44 percent of his three-point attempts.

Eric Schiele, a 6-0 senior guard, comes off the bench and is a dangerous weapon from outside the three-point arc with 41 long-range baskets.

Walsh is scoring 95.6 points per game - secondhighest in NAIA II - and allowing 63.3 points per contest. The Cavaliers are hitting .515 (also second -



best in NAIA II) from the field and .397 from behind the arc with a .666 mark at the charity stripe.

The all-time series between the Yellow Jackets and the Cavaliers is tied at 40-40. Walsh buried CU by a 100-67 final earlier this season in North Canton, OH. The Jackets tripped up the #2-ranked Cavs 73-72 last season on Jan. 26, 2010 in Cedarville.

hio was sprinkled with a little snow earlier last week and our road game at Notre Dame (OH) on Tuesday was called off - presumably because of dangerous traveling conditions. We were actually never even given an explanation, just a text message from Coach Beschta telling us that instead of boarding a bus and visiting lovely South Euclid, we were expected to be ready for practice. The Lady Jackets were nowhere to be seen in the gymnasium because their kind and caring patron, Coach Martin, had decided to grant them a day to rest their bodies and souls. We were given no such thing and had to steel our hearts for another tough practice. To Coach Estepp's credit, however, we were actually granted a day off the very next day.

With a week of preparation behind us, we left Friday evening for Point Park University's gym, or more accurately, the community college gym they just . . . err... borrow? I'm not sure how their specific arrangement works but we've gotten used to traveling, not to Point Park in downtown Pittsburgh, but rather to the Community College of Allegheny County campus, which is far from the city. This is rather unfortunate because I wasn't able to see my brother, who is a freshman studying acting at Carnegie-Mellon University, just a few miles from Point Park's main campus. He also wasn't able to make it to the game because he was busy at the zoo observing the white-cheeked gibbon, a requirement for his "animal project" in his acting class. We knew that even though Point Park's top two scorers were out with injuries, the game would not be an easy match-up. In the second half, with less than two minutes to play, we were down by eight points. Matt "Mr. Buckets" Harner hit a big three. Then Derrick "Dougie" Hannon plucked a steal out of the point guard's pocket and finished on our end for a lay-up. We then found ourselves trailing by only three. After a missed three-point attempt from Daniel "The Mustache" Hickman, Caleb "To Da Max" Maxwell tore the crucial offensive rebound out of the air and away from the defense. Caleb passed the ball back out and it found itself in the capable hands Austin "Size 12" Foote who buried his seventh trey of the night with eight seconds left. Unfortunately, the Pioneers hit some tough shots and put us away in overtime. Harner scored a career-high 32 points and Foote managed to add

### **Last Time Out**



Cedarville stormed back late in regulation, but dropped a 99-93 overtime decision at Point Park in an American Mideast Conference contest last Saturday afternoon in West Mifflin, PA.



The Yellow Jackets trailed 83-75 with less than two minutes to play before closing with eight straight points. Matt Harner nailed a three-pointer, Derrick Hannon registered a steal and layup, and Austin Foote cashed in a triple with 8.2 Matt Harner

seconds left to knot the score.

The host Pioneers tallied first in the overtime, but Cedarville responded with a three from Harner for its only lead of the second half, 86-85, with 3:35 left. PPU quickly answered with a three-pointer of its own and never trailed again.

Harner hit seven of Cedarville's 17 three-pointers and finished with a career-high 32 points. Foote added seven treys and totaled 23 points.

The Yellow Jackets, 10-9 overall and 5-3 AMC, had their five-game conference winning streak snapped. Their 47 three-point attempts matched the school single-game record set twice previously.

Point Park improved to 9-4 and 3-2 AMC. The Pioneers pulled out the win despite missing the services of their top two scorers, who combine for 32.9 points per game, because of injury.

### **Looking Ahead**



The Yellow Jackets head to the state of New York next weekend for two American Mideast Conference games. On Friday, Jan. 28 CU will be at Houghton College for a 6:00 p.m. tipoff against the Highlanders. On Saturday, Jan. 29 the Yellow Jackets visit Daemen College in Amherst, NY for a 4:00 p.m. contest against the Wildcats.

Cedarville continues the AMC road trip with a game at Malone University on Tuesday, Feb. 1 beginning at 7:30 pm.

The Jackets return home on Thursday, Feb 3 against Point Park scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. start.

**Matt Harner** 6-3, 185, Senior, Guard/Forward Cedarville. Ohio

Matt Harner has established himself as one of the top shooters the Yellow Jackets have ever had.....became the 49th player in school history to surpass 1,000 career points and begins the campaign with 1,024.....career .425 shooter outside the three-point line.....started all 35

games as a junior and averaged 13.6 points....ranked fourth in the American Mideast Conference and 19th nationally with a .418 three-point accuracy.....voted to the All-NCCAA Midwest Region Second Team and All-AMC Second Team....scored in double figures 25 times.....pumped in a career-high 28 points in a 66-60 win over Huntington.....netted 27 to lead CU over Trevecca Nazarene, 78-73.....tallied a game-high 26 points in an 80-78 decision at Daemen in the AMC Tournament semifinals.....had a double-double of 12 points and 10 rebounds in a victory over Taylor.

2008-09 - Produced a notable sophomore season with the Yellow Jackets..... appeared in all 31 games with 30 starts.....led a balanced offensive attack by averaging a team-high 12.2 points per game.....voted to the All-AMC Second Team and All-NCCAA Midwest Region Second Team....reached double figures 22 times in scoring which included the last 11 games of the season.....pumped in a season-high 24 points in a win in the regular season finale at Roberts Wesleyan to help CU clinch a share of the AMC title.....tallied 21 points with eight rebounds during a victory at Northwestern Ohio.....produced a double-double of 10 points and 11 rebounds in a win versus Daemen.

2007-08 - Made an immediate contribution after transferring from Wright State University.....played in 25 games in a reserve role averaging 6.8 points per game.....shot a team-high .452 from outside the three-point line.....42 of his 62 field goals came from beyond the arc.....hit for double figures five times.....netted a season-high 15 points during an 86-74 win over Mount Vernon Nazarene.....scored 14 in a victory against Ohio State-Marion and added 13 in the AMC Tournament title game win at Malone.

**High School** - Graduated in 2006 as Cedarville High School's all-time leading scorer with 1,136 career points.....holds the school record for the most three-point field goals made in a career with 140.....averaged 22.4 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 3.2 assists as a senior while shooting 43 percent outside the arc.....named to the All-Ohio Division IV Second Team.....District IX All-Star and an All-Ohio Heritage Conference performer.....member of two district championship teams and one OHC title squad.....averaged 15.3 points as a junior and 12.2 points during sophomore season.





### No. 1 and No. 25 teams only ones to hold their spots from last week's poll

KANSAS CITY. Mo - For the fifth-consecutive time, No. 1 Walsh (Ohio) is the top-ranked team in the fifth regular-season edition of the NAIA Division II Men's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 poll, the NAIA announced Monday. The Cavs continue to roll with an 18-0 record. They are the only undefeated team in Division II and are No. 1 in the nation in scoring margin winning by more than 32 points.



up five spots this week.

No. 23 Dickinson State (N.D.) is nationally-ranked for the first time since Feb. 2, 2009 (No. 25). The Blue Hawks are 12-7 overall, No. 5 Northwood moved but have won seven of their last nine games.

Walsh finishes with 436 total points and all 16 first-place votes this week. With the top-ranking, Walsh now has tallied eight No. 1 spots since 2000. That output is sixth most in that time period. Off to their best start since the 1982-83 campaign, when they finished 30-0, the Cavs won for the 42nd-straight time at home with an 89-66 victory against Mount Vernon Nazarene (Ohio) on Jan. 15.

Sliding up one spot is No. 2 Oklahoma Wesleyan with 422 total points. After an 80-64 win on Jan. 15 against Central Christian (Kan.), the Eagles extended their winning streak to 17-straight games against NAIA competition. The only loss came against Dallas Christian on Jan. 8.

No. 3 Black Hills State (S.D.), who moves up three positions, is tied for the top spot in the Dakota Athletic Conference with a 5-0 record. Winners in 11 of their last 12 games, the Jackets boast their first topfive ranking this year.

No. 4 Briar Cliff (lowa) improves three spots as it holds an 18-3 overall record. With 373 total points in the poll, the Chargers are onehalf game back of Great Plains Athletic Conference leader and No. 21 Northwestern (lowa).

Fifth-ranked Northwood (Fla.) corrals 370 total points this week. With seven-straight wins, the Seahawks stand 15-2 and on top of The Sun Conference with a 6-0 record. The No. 5 spot is the highest this year and is five-positions better than last week.

Eleven conferences are represented this week, led by the four members from the Mid-Central College Conference (MCC) and Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC).

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences and independents. The sixth regular-season Top 25 will be announced on Jan. 24.




