Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Malone University Pioneers in a non-conference contest tonight in the Callan Athletic Center for the annual "White Out Night".

Cedarville, under the direction of seventh-year Head Coach Doug Walters (145-99), enters tonight's action with an 8-6 record.

The Lady Jackets, pre-season favorites to three-peat in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC), opened league play with a pair of road wins at Alderson Broaddus and Davis & Elkins on Friday and Saturday.

Malone, an NCAA II member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC), is 5-8 on the year. The Pioneers took two-of-three matches over the past weekend in Canton, Ohio with league wins over Wayne State and Saginaw Valley State and a 3-0 non-conference setback to NCAA II #6 Wheeling Jesuit.

Senior outside hitter Hannah Wagner continues to lead a balanced offensive attack for Cedarville with 124 kills, a second-best 2.43 kills per set and 34 total blocks.

Senior Amanda Bell, who is the most recent member of the Lady Jacket 1,000 Kill Club, adds a second-best 109 kills and a team-high 2.48 kills per set.

Sophomore Abby Shelton has 101 kills and 97 digs while classmate Angela Becker leads the way with 22 service aces, 226 digs (4.43/set) and a .966 serving pct.

Setters senior Maddie (Anderson) Ledbetter and sophomore Kristin Cardwell direct CU's offense. Ledbetter is the all-time Lady Jacket leader with 246 service aces and ranks sixth with 2,731 career assists. Cardwell has 239 assists, 73 digs and is second with 19 service aces this season.

Malone is led by Head Coach Tanya Hockman who is in her 16th year at the helm of the program (393-225).

Senior outside hitter Taylor Slauterbeck tops the Pioneer offensive attack with 109 kills and 2.27 kills per set.

Jordan Sollars, a sophomore setter, has 221 assists (4.9/set) and leads Malone with 21 service aces.

Junior Elizabeth Maczuzak leads the front line with 15 solo blocks and a team-high .235 attack percentage.

Katie Hasebein paces the Pioneers defense with 240 digs.

Cedarville holds a 29-19 advantage in the all-time series with the Pioneers - who are former long-time rivals of CU from the NIAA's American Midwest Conference.

Meet Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 137 victories during Walters' six-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as back-to-back Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012 and 2013.

During the school's first active season in NCAA Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Midwest Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

CU was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 12.

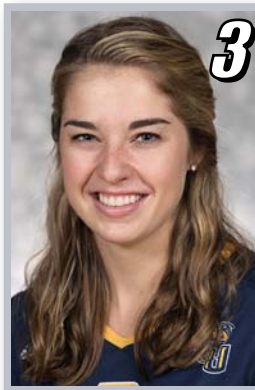

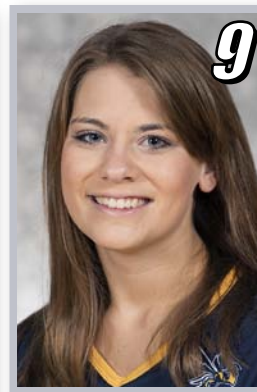

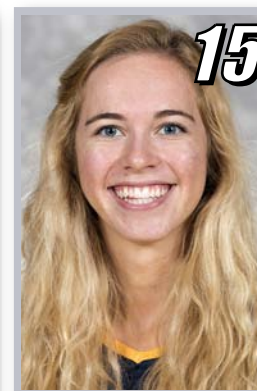
