

# Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the University of Southern Indiana Screaming Eagles tonight in nonconfererence action in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, under the direction of eighth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (164-114), enters tonight's match with a 6-8 record and a four-match home winning streak.

Southern Indiana, an NCAA II member of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), is 10-2 on the season having won eight of their last nine contests. The Screaming Eagels captured a pair of league wins this past weekend over visiting opponents Quincy and Truman State.

Four juniors continue to pace the Lady Jackets after 14 matches of the 2015 season. Outside hitter Abby Shelton leads the offensive attack with 192 kills and 3.84 kills per set. Rachel Krikke, a 6-1 middle hitter, tops the squad with a .337 attack pct.

Sophomore Krissy Pratt is second with 133 kills while posting a second-best 20 aces in the aggres-



sive CU serving attack. Abby Shelton Libero Angela Becker, paces the back row with 197 digs while setter Kristin Cardwell has handed out 358 assists and tops the

squad with 21 service aces. Head Coach Leah Mercer is in her 11th season (194-128) at USI having led the Screaming Eagles to the NCAA Tournament in 2010, 2011 and 2013.

Abbey Winter, a 6-2 senior middle hitter, tops the USI attack with a .373 attack percentage and 60 total blocks. Sophomore outside hitter Shelbi Morris adds a team-high 140 kills while senior Erica Oberbroeckling is another threat on the outside.

Southern Indiana owns a 3-0 lead in the all-time series with the Lady Jackets. The teams last met on October 14, 2014 with USI posting a 25-17, 28-30, 25-15, 25-17 verdict in Evansville, Indiana.

### Last Time on the Court - 9/26/15

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Krissy Pratt pounded 15 kills and the Lady Jackets swept aside Davis & Elkins in a G-MAC contest at the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, 6-8 overall and 2-0 G-MAC, won it's fourth straight by scores of 25-17, 25-21, 25-14.

Pratt also contributed two service aces and three blocks. Abby Shelton totaled 10 kills

Kristin Cardwell came through with 26 assists and four aces.

Angela Becker finished with 20 digs. Rachel Krikke turned down five blocks and Alyssa Barkley had four.

# Head Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history.

The Lady Jackets have posted 157 victories during Walters' seven-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as three consecutive Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012, 2013, and 2014.

During the school's first active season in NCAA

Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Then, in 2014, CU made it a three-peat after rolling through the league schedule with a 10-1 regular season mark. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament as the #1 seed and locked down their third straight title to finish 20-13.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets gualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Despite going 15-23 overall in 2009, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters was founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003, was a Junior Olympic organization, and was recognized as one of the top regional clubs in the Cincinnati area.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He is also the chair of the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Midwest Regional Advisory Committee and serves on the Division II Women's Volleyball National Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 13.


