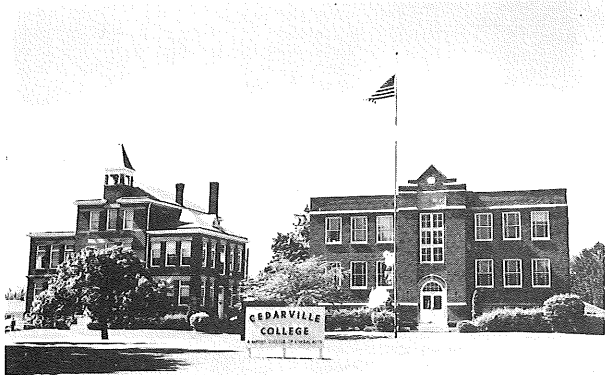

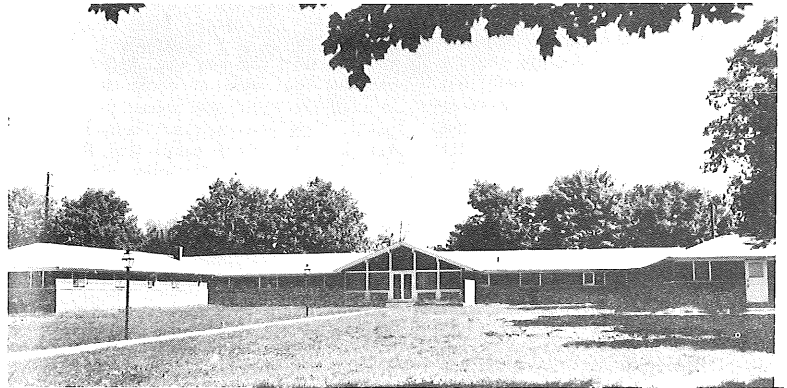

**IMPRESSIONS OF CEDARVILLE**

"I do not see how anyone could be less than enthusiastic about Cedarville." After spending a week of ministry on the campus, these words have become very much a part of my own testimony. As I came to Cedarville, there were a number of questions on my mind about the need for such a school, the stand which Cedarville was taking. I came away with the assurance that God has blessed this Baptist testimony to the glory of His name and that it ought to be supported and encouraged by our Baptist churches everywhere.

A number of things about the school impressed me in a special way.

1. The warm family atmosphere of the campus is felt by even the most casual observer. At Cedarville, students are not members of a student body; they are members of a family of students and faculty members who share concern and fellowship with each other. That relationship is noticed immediately as you visit on the campus. It is also impressive to note the spirit of unity which prevails among the faculty and students.

2. I also felt the healthy spiritual atmosphere of the campus life and activities. It is encouraging to note that this is given special emphasis in every area of school life and is one of the first concerns of the school. The last night of the special meetings closed with an expression of desire on the part of each student and faculty member to maintain in his necessary spiritual relationship for the continued blessing of God.

3. The school is a forward-looking school with plans and programs which maintain both historic Baptist principles and the assurance of the continued growth and progress of the school. The school is growing. Although it does not profess to have reached perfection, it has come a long way and merits our confidence. It is meeting a need which is not met in any of our other schools.

For my own schooling, I had taken training in an inter-denominational school. The training of those years was effective, but it lacked grounding in those things which we as Baptists hold dear. Cedarville is an opportunity for young people desiring college to study in a college where their convictions will be established rather than shaken.

As our Bible schools and seminaries have their place in our GARBC work, so God has raised up this school as a Baptist liberal arts college to train our young people who desire a college education.

waiting is difficult but the Lord uses the time to train and teach us in preparation for that particular place where we may serve Him. Miss Barbara Ferry waited — doors were opened. Now she works as a secretary at Baptist Mid - Missions, Cleveland, Ohio.

"Upon returning to my old job at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, Ohio, one of the men whom I had known when I previously worked there (I shall call him Col. A) said: 'I thought you were supposed to "go into all the world and preach the gospel?"' This man was not born again but had somewhere heard that Scripture. Frankly, I hardly knew what to say,

"Then came a year and a half of waiting and indeed a time of trying patiently to wait upon the Lord. How the doubts build up at such a time. I would ask myself many questions, such as: 'Why doesn't the Lord show me my place of Christian service? Were those three years at Cedarville College a mistake, done in my own strength?'"

"Then the Lord opened the door for me to work in the office of Baptist Mid-Missions. A letter to Baptist Mid-Missions regarding a possible application under our board will first be placed on my desk to be opened, stamped, then given to Mr. Osburn. Rev. Denzel L. Osburn is the Candidate Secretary of Baptist Mid-Missions and I am his secretary. He also acts in two other capacities, that of Home Missions Director and as Chairman of the Children's Home committee. I will have a small part in any matters pertaining to these three phases of the work. Occasionally we write to some of our foreign missionaries.

"It is a blessing to remember those three years at Cedarville College I met so many fine Christians there, both teachers and students, and become close friends with some. I know those years had much to do with shaping my life as a person and as a Christian. I already had my office training, but I learned many valuable things there for my present job.

"How thrilled I was to be able to go back to Col. A the day I left Wright-Patterson for the second time and say, 'Col. A, remember when you said that you thought I was supposed to "go into all the world and preach the gospel?"' Well, Sir, this is my way of doing it.' How thankful and happy I am to be in the service of my Lord and to know that each day is another day to serve Him."
