



## Honorary Assistant Coach



**Teresa Clark** currently serves as an Associate Professor of Kinesiology at Cedarville University. She also serves as Assistant Chair for the Department of Kinesiology and Allied Health, and she serves as the Faculty Athletic Representative for the Athletic Department! She was the Head Coach of the volleyball program for 10 seasons. She had a record of 322-130 in that time, and helped guide the team to the 2005 NCCAA National Championship.

## Today's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Trevecca University Trojans today in an important Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest in the Callan Athletic Center as part of Homecoming Weekend.

Cedarville, under the direction of eighth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (165-114), entered last night's match against KWC with a 7-8 record (2-0 G-MAC) and a five-match home winning streak including a 3-1 victory over visiting Southern Indiana on Tuesday.

Trevecca was 7-6 before heading to Ursuline last night to open the G-MAC portion of their schedule. The Trojans posted a 3-1 win on Sept. 24 at King University.

Four juniors continue to pace the Lady Jackets after 15 matches of the 2015 season. Outside hitter Abby Shelton leads the offensive attack with 205 kills and 3.80 kills per set. Rachel

Krikke, a 6-1 middle hitter coming off a career-high 15 kills versus USI, tops the squad with a .361 attack pct.

Sophomore Krissy Pratt is second with 147 kills and tied for a team-high 21 aces in the aggressive CU serving attack.

Libero Angela Becker, paces the back row with 212 digs while setter Kristin Cardwell has handed out 405 assists and is tied with Pratt in serving aces.

Head Coach Jayme Crowley is in her eighth season at TNU with a record of 146-110 going into Friday's match at Ursuline.

Katelyn Atkinson, a 5-11 junior outside/middle hitter, leads the Trojans with 166 kills, 3.77 kills per set and 141 digs. Senior setter Loren Bennett directs the Trevecca offense while rookie Alex Reuter is the top blocker.



CU owns a 6-2 lead in the all-time series with the Trojans. The teams split their 2014 matches - each school winning on their home floor.

## Head Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history.

The Lady Jackets have posted 157 victories during Walters' seven-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as three consecutive Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012, 2013, and 2014.

During the school's first active season in NCAA

Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Then, in 2014, CU made it a three-peat after rolling through the league schedule with a 10-1 regular season mark. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament as the #1 seed and locked down their third straight title to finish 20-13.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Despite going 15-23 overall in 2009, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters was founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003, was a Junior Olympic organization, and was recognized as one of the top regional clubs in the Cincinnati area.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He is also the chair of the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Midwest Regional Advisory Committee and serves on the Division II Women's Volleyball National Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 13.




