### **Tonight's Game Preview**



he Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Urbana University Blue Knights tonight in a non-conference game in the Callan Athletic Center.

Cedarville, ranked #11 in the most recent NAIA II Top 25 Poll, enters the contest with a record of 12-3 and 4-0 in the American Mideast Conference. The Lady Jackets have won 10 straight contests including a 78-50 AMC decision over visiting Mount Vernon Nazarene on Tuesday. The Blue Knights, an NCAA II independent, are 3-7 on the year including three consecutive setbacks. Urbana dropped thier most recent contest - an 84-59 verdict at Edinboro PA.

The Lady Jacket lineup features four players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive arsenal is senior post player Aubrey Siemon - averaging 14.8 ppg and 12.4 rebounds per game. She is 26 boards away from CU's all-time career mark. Siemon also tops the squad in free throw shooting with an .875 mark. Her .558 field goal percentage paces CU and is one of the best in the AMC.

Senior guard Rachel Hurley adds 13.1 points per

game while leading the team with 45 assists. Hurley also has a team-best 35 three-point field goals. She has joined teammates Siemon and Lydia Miller with 1,000 career points.

Rookie Kayla Jenerette, a 5-5 guard, is the third Lady Jacket with a double-digit scoring average at

12.9 points per game. She leads CU with 31 steals Rachel Hurley and an impressive .566 mark from long-range which is the best in NAIA II. Jenerette has a fourth-best 39 assists and is grabbing 2.6 rebounds per game.

Senior guard Lydia Miller is the final CU player in double-figures averaging 10.1 points per contest. She is tied for second on the team with 44 assists and has a third-best 4.6 rpg.


Kara Cayton, the lone junior on the 2010-11 roster, adds 8.1 points per game to the offensive attack. The 5-4 guard is second on the team with 24 steals and has 29 three-point field goals.

Senior forward Caitlyn Brooks adds 5.5 ppg, 4.3 rpg to go with 21 assists and 15 steals.

Cedarville is shooting .463 from the field including 138-of-310 attempts from the three-point line for a .445 mark. CU has four deadly long-range bombers in Jenerette (566), Hurley (443), Cayton (.439) and Miller (.415).

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by 18.1 points per game while holding them to .361 shooting from the floor. The Lady Jackets are controlling the boards with a +9.2 margin.

The Blue Knight offense will be led by senior Unique Lane. The 5-10 forward, returning from an injury, leads the team in scoring (11.7 ppg), rebounding (6.6 rpg) and field goal percentage (.500).



- also back from injury. The 6-0 senior guard averages 11.2 points per game and leads the Blue Knights with 18 steals.

Unique Lane

Urban is scoring just 60.5 points per game and allowing 71.6 points per contest. The Blue Knights are hitting .389 from the field and .337 from long-range with a .696 mark at the charity stripe.

CU leads the all-time series with UU by a 33-24 margin. The Blue Knights bested the Lady Jackets earlier this season by a 79-74 score on Nov. 20, 2010 at Urbana.

### Last Time Out

The NAIA Division II #11 Lady Jackets ramped up their game in the second half to bury Mount Vernon Nazarene, 78-50, in an American Mideast Conference contest played in the Callan Athletic Center on Tuesday evening.



Cedarville ran its winning streak to 10 in a row, but it took some work over the final 20 minutes to get the job done. Leading 32-26 following an unimpressive opening half, the hosts shot 69 percent from the field in the second period while holding MVNU to eight field goals and a 26 percent accuracy.

The Lady Jackets, 12-3 overall and 4-0 AMC, won the battle of the boards, 44-33, and knocked down 11-of-23 three-pointers. They also held the Cougars to 30 points under their scoring average.

Kayla Jenerette came off the bench to score a game-high 17 points. Lydia Miller finished with 14 points, nine rebounds, and four assists while Rachel Hurley chipped in 10 points. Aubrey Siemon hauled in a game-high 12 rebounds.

Mount Vernon Nazarene drops to 10-4 and 2-2 AMC.

Next week, the Lady Jackets travel to northern Ohio and Pennsylvania for American Mideast Conference encounters. Cedarville tangles with Notre Dame College in South Euclid on Tuesday, Jan. 11 in a 5:30 pm tipoff. The Lady Jackets visit Pittsburgh on Saturday, Jan. 15 for a 1:00 pm matchup with Point Park University.

CU returns home on Tuesday, Jan. 18 against NCAA Division II Hillsdale MI for a non-conference game beginning at 5:30 pm. The Lady Jackets close the week with two AMC home games - Friday, Jan. 21 versus Carlow starting at 7 pm followed by a Saturday, Jan. 22 matchup with Walsh at 5:30 pm as part of Alumni Weekend.

Rachel Hurley returns to the Lady Jackets for her final season in the program.....appeared in all 33 games with 32 starts.....squad's fourth-leading scorer at 8.8 points per game.....led team at the free throw line with a .930 mark on 40-of-43.....added 73 assists and 43

steals.....recorded a third-best 44 field goals from long range.....double figure scorer in 15 games including six of the last seven.....hit for a season-high 16 points on two occasions – at Roberts Wesleyan and versus Taylor at NAIA national tournament.....tied a career-high seven assists in an early-season win at Grace.....tied for fifth all-time with 154 three-point FG's made.....tied for ninth all-time at CU in three-point FG percentage with .350.....NCCAA Midwest Region Second Team performer..... earned American Mideast Conference honorable mention..... NAIA, NCCAA and AMC Scholar-Athlete.



Jumps to No. 4 with 387 points and rounding out the top-five is Cornerstone (Mich.) with 374 points.

Despite having just one game on its slate, Northwestern (12-0, 5-0 Great Plains Athletic Conference) had its hands full with Morningside on Dec. 8. The Red Raiders came away with an 82-72 win over the Mustangs for sole possession of first place in the GPAC. Becca Hurley led the way with 25 points, six assists and four rebounds. Kendra De Jong also contributed 23 points and a game-high 17 rebounds in the win.

No. 2 Davenport is coming off of two lopsided wins over Siena Heights (Mich.) and Concordia (Mich.). The Panthers 104-38 win against Siena Heights set a new program record for largest margin of victory at home on Dec. 8. Davenport's defense managed to force 32 turnovers and held the Saints to a DU Student Center record 38 points. The second-ranked Panthers followed that up with a 22-point win over a Concordia squad that is receiving votes in the third edition of the Top 25 poll.

After losing its first game, a 82-72 setback to top-ranked Northwestern, No. 3 Morningside rebounded with an impressive 72-44 victory over No. 17 Mount Marty (S.D.). The Mustangs had three players in double-figures. Tanaeya Worden led the way with 17 points, followed by Chelsie Trask and Shelby Beaudette with 16 and 13 points, respectively. Up next for Morningside is the Hoop'N/Surf Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii, where it will take on NAIA Division I opponents MidAmerica Nazarene (Kan.) and Olivet Nazarene (III.) on Dec. 18-20.

No. 4 Sioux Falls, whose only setback was a 62-61 loss to the third-ranked Mustangs on Dec. 1, moved to 10-1, 4-1 GPAC with a 72-53 win over Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.) on Dec. 8. The Panthers, who lead the NAIA in 3-point field goals made per game (11.25), racked up 14 buckets from behind-the-arc on 14-of-30 shooting.

Cornerstone traveled to Aquinas (Mich.) and Goshen (Ind.) for a pair of road matches last week. The Golden Eagles recorded a 72-58 win over Aquinas on Dec. 8, followed by a 73-47 victory over the Maple Leafs on Dec. 11. Cornerstone's Brooke Carter was 8-of-16 from the field with 20 points and nine rebounds.

Eleven conferences are represented on the Top 25 poll, led by the American Mideast Conference and Great Plains Athletic Conference with four teams each. The American Mideast is represented by No. 11 Cedarville (Ohio), No. 14 Daemen (N.Y.), No. 18 Walsh (Ohio) and No. 25 Notre Dame (Ohio). Ranked teams within the GPAC include Northwestern, Morningside, Sioux Falls and Mount Marty.

Making the most significant jump in the poll is Walsh, moving up five spots from No. 23 to 18. After falling seven spots to No. 25 in last week's poll, Dordt (lowa) continues its slide, falling out of the Top 25.

New teams entering the Top 25 for the first time this season include: No. 21 Cardinal Stritch (Wis.), No. 23 Valley City State (N.D.), No. 24 Union (Ky.) and Notre Dame. Southwestern (Kan.) re-enters the rankings at No. 22 after slipping out in the Dec. 6 poll.

The poll was voted upon by a panel of head coaches representing each of the conferences. The next poll will be announced on Jan. 10.


