

Today's Games

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Alderson Broaddus University Battlers in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference doubleheader at Lady Jacket Field. The games are rescheduled from March 19 when the contests were postponed due to weather.

Cedarville enters the action with a record of 14-22 (5-7) after dropping a four-game series against visiting Trevecca this past weekend.

Alderson Broaddus brings a 10-20 (4-8) mark including taking just one of three games against league-foe Ursuline this past weekend in WV.

Cedarville's Brianne O'Dell, a sophomore infielder/outfielder, leads the team in hitting with a .357 mark including a team-high 41 base hits. She ranks second in doubles (9), total bases (50) and slugging (.435).

Senior third baseman Nicole Davis ranks second with a .336 batting mark while pacing the Lady Jackets in runs (18), doubles (10), triples (2), RBI's (21), total bases (53) and slugging (.457). Sophomore first baseman Nikki Eigsti is CU's third-leading hitter with a .312 average.

Sophomore outfielder/catcher Alexxi Timmons is one of the main offensive threats for AB with a .309 batting average and team-bests in hits (30), doubles (6), triples (2) and total bases (43). Brianna Burger, freshman first baseman, leads with 17 RBI's and a .655 slugging percentage.

Shortstop Samantha Turner, the 2015 G-MAC Freshman of the Year, tops the Battlers with 18 runs scored and 17 RBI's.

Freshman hurler Emily Davis has a 3-11 mark, a 3.86 ERA and 13 complete games in 107 innings of work.

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with AB by a 9-3 margin including sweeping a pair of games on March 18 by scores of 8-5 (9) and 9-4 in Cedarville.








Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced an average of 27.3 victories per year including school-record 35-win efforts in 2012, 2014, and 2015. The Lady Jackets have produced five consecutive winning seasons for the first time in school his-



Cedarville was the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up during the league's first year in 2013 and again in 2015. Rowe guided Cedarville to its second straight NCCAA Midwest Region championship in 2012 and his team has made four national tournament appearances in all - 2011, 2012, 2014. and 2015.

Rowe has coached one NCCAA National Player of the Year, eight

NCCAA All-Americans, and 33 All-Region performers. A total of 16 of his players have been recognized as scholar-athletes.

Prior to coming to Cedarville, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.

Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife. Ann. reside in Cedarville. All four of their children have graduated from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009. The Rowes also have two grandchildren.




