Series Preview

The Cedarville University baseball team hosts the Davis & Elkins College Senators in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference four-game weekend series at Yellow Jacket Field. The teams will meet in a 9/7 inning doubleheader on Friday and a 7/9 inning twinbill on Saturday.

Cedarville is 17-12 (4-4 G-MAC) on the year including a 15-6 win at Kentucky State on Wednesday afternoon - the 200th win of Head Coach Mike Manes' career at CU.

Davis & Elkins brings a 9-16 (1-7 G-MAC) record into the weekend. The Senators posted an 8-3 victory at West Virginia Tech on Thursday.

Junior shortstop Sam Summerlin is hitting a team-leading .402 while also pacing the Jackets in hits (43), doubles (7) and total bases (54). Summerlin ranks sixth all-time at CU with a career batting average of .369

Cedarville's David Lenhardt, a sophomore catcher/DH, is second on the squad in hitting with a .344 mark. Lenhardt has produced team-best numbers in doubles (7), home runs (3), RBI's (24), slugging percentage (.544) and walks (27).

Freshmen Jaden Cleland and Nathan Bancroft have made significant contributions to the squad in recent games. Cleland is batting .328 with a fourth-best 19 RBI's. Bancroft has a .319 hitting mark.

Senior Cam McWilliams leads the Yellow Jackets in runs scored (30) and stolen bases (8). The outfielder has brought his batting average to the .306 level. Williams ranks fifth all-time at CU with 125 runs and is eighth all-time with 151 hits.

Rookie third sacker Drew Johnson has a .303 batting average with a second-best 53 total bases. Johnson is tied with Summerlin and Lenhardt for the team lead in doubles (7) while pacing CU with five three-baggers.

Junior Jordan Ammon tops the Jacket pitching corps with four wins, 39 innings pitched and 35 strikeouts. The righthander suffered an elbow injury last week and will not pitch the rest of the season.

Sophomore Tyler Hurt has registered four saves on the mound while rookie reliever Connor Hamilton leads the staff with 13 appearances.

The top hitter for the Senators is junior outfielder Lance Vannoy with a .325 batting mark. He also leads the squad with 26 hits and 32 total bases. Senior Treavor Dubiel is the second-leading hitter with a .316 batting mark. He paces D&E with 17 runs batted in.

Freshman hurler Tyler Honeycutt is 4-1 on the year with a team-best 2.63 ERA in 37 2/3 innings of action. The righthander tops the staff with 19 strikeouts and a pair of complete games.

Last Time Up

FRANKFORT, Ky. - Head Coach Mike Manes notched his 200th victory at Cedarville as the Yellow Jackets rolled to a 15-6 non-conference decision at Kentucky State on Wednesday afternoon

It took Manes six-plus seasons to reach 200 wins. No other coach in CU baseball history has more than 100.

The Yellow Jackets, 17-12, trailed 3-1 early and then ramped up the offense. They took the lead for good with three runs in the fourth inning and then inflated the bulge to 10-3 with six more tallies in the fourth.

Five players had at least two hits as part of CU's 12-hit attack. Five scored at least two runs and five recorded two or more RBI's.

Cam McWilliams went 3-for-4 with a double and scored three times. Marshall Johnson added two hits with a double, three runs, and two RBI's while Drew Johnson had two hits including a triple with three RBI's.

Sam Summerlin had two hits and drove in four runs. David Bancroft totaled two hits and two RBI's, David Lenhardt scored twice with two runs driven in, and Dan Larkin tallied two runs.

Starting pitcher Scott Kneeland picked up his first collegiate victory with five innings of work. Four relievers followed with one inning apiece.

Head Coach Mike Manes



Mike Manes (pronounced MAN-us) has been the head baseball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He has guided the Yellow Jackets to the six winningest seasons in school history and five trips to the NCCAA National Tournament.

Manes has won more games than any previous baseball coach that CU has ever had. The Jackets, who are coming off of a 29-19 campaign while winning their third straight NCCAA Midwest Region banner, have enjoyed five consecutive winning seasons - the longest streak in the modern era of Cedarville's 100-plus year baseball history.

CU set the school record for the most victories in a season in 2012 with a 38-13 record. The Yellow Jackets won their third NCCAA Midwest Region banner in the past four years and advanced to the national tournament as the No. 1 seed.

Cedarville was 33-18-2 in 2011 and had a best-ever five NCCAA All-Americans on the roster. The Jackets copped the NCCAA Midwest Region banner for the second time in three years and returned to the NCCAA National Tournament. Manes was named the Region Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 28-27 record in 2010. The Jackets were also the NCCAA Midwest Region runner-up.

Manes was named the 2009 NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year after leading Cedarville to the region title. The Yellow Jackets won over 30 games for the first time in school history with their 32-28 record and split four games at the NCCAA Nationals.

Cedarville was the Midwest Region runner-up in Manes' first season in 2008. The Jackets set a then school record for the most victories in season with 23. They also won eight games in the tough American Midwest Conference which equaled their league win total from the previous three seasons combined.

Manes came to the Yellow Jackets following a four-year stay as head coach at Trinity International University near Chicago. He was able to turn the TIU program around after inheriting a team that won just four games in his first season in 2004 and the school had never qualified for the conference tournament.

Manes then guided the Trojans to 85 victories over the next three seasons by winning 25, 28, and 32 games, respectively, which set school records for the most victories in a season each time. The 2006 squad put together TIU's first-ever winning season and the 2007 team finished 32-22.

In his short tenure, Manes guided the Trojans to their first-ever conference tournament appearance, two NCCAA North Central Region championships, and TIU played in the NCCAA National Tournament in each of his last three seasons. He was tabbed the 2005 NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Nebraska native previously founded and coached the Lincoln Crusaders which is an American Legion baseball club. In his 11 years at the helm, the team made nine trips to the state tournament winning one championship and finishing as the runner-up on two other occasions.

Manes is actively involved in baseball administration. He is currently the NCCAA baseball chair as well as the chair of the new Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

Manes is a 1989 graduate of Liberty University and he earned a master's degree in 2005 from Alameda University. Mike and his wife, Connie, reside in Springfield and have four married children and seven grandchildren.
