

Tonight's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the Ursuline College Arrows tonight in an important Great Midwest Athletic Conference contest in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the final match of a season-long eight-match home stand.

Cedarville, under the direction of eighth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (166-114), enters tonight's G-MAC encounter with a 9-8 record (4-0 G-MAC) and an unblemished mark at home during the 2015 campaign. CU posted victories over league opponents Kentucky Wesleyan and Trevecca this past weekend.

Ursuline is 6-12 this season with a 2-2 mark in the G-MAC. The Arrows split a pair of home conference matches this past weekend - losing to Trevecca 3-2 before posting a 3-0 win over KWC.

Four juniors continue to pace the Lady Jackets after 17 matches of the 2015 season. Outside hitter Abby Shelton leads the offensive attack with 237 kills and 3.89 kills per set. Rachel Krikke, a 6-1 middle hitter and the current G-MAC Volleyball Athlete of the Week, tops the squad with a .377 attack percentage and 52 blocks.

Sophomore Krissy Pratt is second with 166 kills and a teamhigh 24 service aces.

Head Coach Jayme Plummer is in his first season at Ursuline after previously serving as an assistant at the University of Akron.

Abbie Fabo, a 5-10 senior outside hitter, tops the Arrows attack with 188 kills and 2.72 kills per set. Rookie setter Katelyn Selleny directs the offense while posting 567 assists. Senior Sabrina Kinney paces the back row with 255 digs.



CU owns a 12-0 lead in the all-time series with the Arrows including a 22-25, 25-20, 25-23, 19-25, 15-10 victory last Oct. 31 in Pepper Pike, Ohio.

Last Time on the Court - 10/3/15

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Cedarville dropped the first set, but recovered to take the next three against Trevecca in a G-MAC Homecoming contest at the Callan Athletic Center.

The Lady Jackets won by scores of 22-25, 25-14, 25-23, 25-19 to get over the .500 mark for the first time this season at 9-8 overall and 4-0 G-MAC.

After dropping the first set and breezing in the second, the third set turned the match around for the home team.

Trevecca opened up leads of 21-15 and 22-17 before Cedarville rallied. The Jackets scored eight of the last nine points to steal the set.

Abby Shelton buried 22 kills to lead the attack. Rachel Krikke totaled 13 kills and five blocks.

Alyssa Barkley and Taylor Wilkerson turned aside seven blocks apiece. Krissy Pratt came up with 20 digs, Angela Becker had 14, and Kristin Cardwell racked up 46 assists.

Numbers Game:

Head Coach Doug Walters



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history.

The Lady Jackets have posted 157 victories during Walters' seven-year tenure. The list of honors includes the 2008 NCCAA championship as well as three consecutive Great Midwest Athletic Conference crowns in 2012, 2013, and 2014.

During the school's first active season in NCAA

Division II in 2012, his squad rolled to a 32-6 overall mark and was a perfect 8-0 in the G-MAC. Cedarville went on to win the inaugural G-MAC Tournament and Walters was ultimately voted the league's Coach of the Year.

The Jackets, who finished 23-14 overall in 2013, repeated the feat after sharing the league's best regular season record at 12-2. They went on the road to claim their second straight G-MAC Tournament trophy.

Then, in 2014, CU made it a three-peat after rolling through the league schedule with a 10-1 regular season mark. The Jackets hosted the G-MAC Tournament as the #1 seed and locked down their third straight title to finish 20-13.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets in 2008 was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall that season and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Despite going 15-23 overall in 2009, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. The Jackets were 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Cedarville finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters was founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003, was a Junior Olympic organization, and was recognized as one of the top regional clubs in the Cincinnati area.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is a National Team Coach for the Elevation Volleyball Club based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He is also the chair of the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Midwest Regional Advisory Committee and serves on the Division II Women's Volleyball National Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Morrow, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 13.


