

### Today's Match

The Cedarville University women's volleyball team hosts the West Virginia Wesleyan College Bobcats in a non-conference match today in the Callan Athletic Center.

The Lady Jackets, under the leadership of fifth-year Head Coach Doug Walters (102-77), enter today's action with an 20-4 record and a #8 ranking in this week's National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) Division I Poll

Cedarville had their six-match winning streak snapped on Tuesday at NAIA #17 Indiana East - losing 3-1 to the Red Wolves by finals of 25-13, 25-23, 24-26, 25-19.

West Virginia Wesleyan, an NCAA II member of the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIA), is 7-12 on the year after recording a come-from-behind five-set league win at Davis & Elkins on Wednesday night.

Outside hitter Hannah Wagner, a 6-2 sophomore, paces the Cedarville offensive efforts with 242 kills and 68 blocks. She is second on the squad with a .291 attack percentage.

Teammate Stephanie Rogers, a junior 5-11 middle hitter, joined the Lady Jacket 1,000 career kill club last Saturday, Sept. 29. Rogers leads CU with her .298 attack mark and is second to Wagner with 206 kills and 66 blocks.



Sophomore setter Maddie Anderson has a team- Hannah Wagner leading 514 assists and 48 service aces. Senior Erica Bartholomew has tallied 352 assists on the year while ranking fourth all-time at CU with 3.810.

Senior Heather Kirkpatrick enters today's contest needing just 10 digs to become the fifth Lady Jacket to ever reach 2,000 digs in a career.

West Virginia Wesleyan Head Coach Jackie Murphy is in her fourth year (52-56) with the Bobcats.

A pair of middle hitters pace the offense of West Virginia Wesleyan. Korin Wengryn, a 5-11 junior, has 167 kills and 51 blocks while Erin Bond, a 6-1 sophomore, also has 167 kills and 51 blocks.

Casey Pattyn directs the Bobcat attack with 516 assists. Renata Comparini leads with 21 service aces.

The two teams have previously met only one other time - a 3-1 setback at a tri-match with Wheeling Jesuit on Oct. 8, 2011 in Wheeling, West Virginia.

### **Meet Coach Doug Walters**



Doug Walters has been the head volleyball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the sixth head coach in the program's history and the first male to serve in the capacity.

The Lady Jackets have posted 82 victories during Walters' four-year tenure. CU finished with a 22-18 mark in 2011 during the school's NCAA Division II provisional year and was the No. 1 seed in the Ohio Independent Championship Tournament.

Walters' first season with the Lady Jackets was a memorable one as he guided the program to its third National Christian College Athletic Association title in four years. He was tabbed the 2008 NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Cedarville finished with a 27-12 record overall and tied for fourth place out of 15 teams in the American Mideast Conference with a 10-4 mark. The Lady Jackets qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Cedarville was 15-23 overall in 2009. However, the Lady Jackets were the #2 seed in the AMC Tournament after going 8-4 in the league. CU was 18-20 and 6-4 AMC in 2010 while advancing to the semifinals of the conference tournament.

Walters came to Cedarville after assembling a 128-73 record in nine years of high school coaching in southern Ohio. He spent his last two seasons at the prep level at Milford High School, a Division I program near Cincinnati.

Walters previously spent seven years building Eastern High School in Sardinia into one of the top Division III programs in Ohio. The Warriors, who were ranked in the state's Top 10 in three different seasons, won four conference titles, two sectional championships, and were the district runner-up once. He was a four-time conference Coach of the Year and saw eight players continue their careers at the collegiate level.

Walters is the founder and former director of the Greater Miami Volleyball Club. The GMVC was started in 2003 and is a Junior Olympic organization that has quickly built a reputation as one of the top regional clubs in Cincinnati.

Walters continues to be involved at the club level. He is the Elevation Volleyball Club 17's National Team Coach based out of Mason, Ohio.

Additionally, Walters is the volleyball chair of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. He serves as the G-MAC rep to the AVCA Division II Head Coaches Committee and is a member of the AVCA National Poll Committee.

Walters is a 1997 graduate of Northern Kentucky University and he earned his master's degree from the University of Dayton in 2003. Doug and his wife, Angela, reside in Hamersville, Ohio with their daughter Caitlyn, 10.


Hannah Wagner 6-2 · Sophomore · Outside Hitter Claremont, CA Upland Christian High School

Hannah Wagner is in her second season with the Cedarville University volleyball team....one

of three players to appear in all 40 matches and all 145 sets during a solid rookie campaign in 2011....recorded a second-best 383 kills, 2.64 kills per set and a .289 attack percentage.....added

a third-best 74 total blocks.....tallied a season-high 16 kills versus Grace in the National Christian College Athletic Associatioon (NCCAA) Midwest Regional.....hit for double figures in kills in 17 other matches.....hammered 15 kills and tallied a season-high six blocks against Notre Dame OH in the opening VILLE U round of the Ohio Independent Championship (OIC).....named to NCCAA Midwest Region Team....member of Ohio Independent Championship Team.



The Great Midwest Athletic Conference (G-MAC), which was approved by the NCAA Division II Membership Committee in February of 2012 as a member conference effective September 1, 2012, will be working through an educational assessment program with the goal of beginning competition as the 24th active NCAA Division II conference by 2013-14.

The G-MAC features active and reclassifying members from Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia. Charter members of the G-MAC include Cedarville University, Central State University, Kentucky Wesleyan College, Trevecca Nazarene University, Urbana University and Ursuline College. The G-MAC expanded with the inclusion of Alderson-Broaddus College, Davis & Elkins College, and Ohio Valley University as active DII members in 2012.

The University of Virginia's College at Wise was approved as a Full Member, while Georgetown College was added as a Provisional Member in 2012 as well.

The G-MAC, headquartered in the Indianapolis metro area, will sponsor 12 championships in 2012-13 as a NCAA Division II member conference.
