## Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Wittenberg University Tigers tonight in a non-conference game in the Callan Athletic Center. It is the last of a four-game homestand for the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville, ranked #15 in this week's NAIA II Top 25 Poll, enters the game 15-5 overall and 6-1 in the American Mideast Conference. The Lady Jackets lost a 70-53 AMC decision to #16 Walsh on Saturday. The Tigers, NCAA III members of the North Coast Athletic Conference, are 9-8 on the year with a 4-3 league mark. In their most recent action, Wittenberg defeated Wooster 61-46 in a league contest this past Saturday.

The Lady Jacket lineup has three players scoring in double figures. Leading the way is senior post player Aubrey Siemon - averaging 13.5 ppg and 12 rebounds per game. She is CU's all-time leading rebounder with 1,188 in her career. Siemon also tops the squad and the AMC in free throw shooting with an .885 mark. Her .542 field goal percentage paces CU and is third-best in the AMC.

Senior guard Rachel Hurley adds 12.9 points per game while leading the team in assists with 68. Hurley is second on the team with 41 three-point field goals and ranks fifth all-time at CU in made three-pointers with 195.

Rookie Kayla Jenerette, a 5-5 guard, is the third Lady Jacket with a double-digit scoring average at 12.7 points per game. She leads CU with 44 steals Bachel Hurley and a .528 mark from long-range - best in NAIA II.



Senior guard Lydia Miller is tossing in 9.9 ppg, is second on the team in assists and leads the squad at .933 from the stripe.

Junior Kara Cayton, a 5-4 guard, adds 8.5 points per game to the offense. She has a team-best 43 three-pointers and is second on the team in steals with 28.

Starting forward Caitlyn Brooks, a 6-0 senior, adds 5.5 points and 3.8 rebounds.

Freshman Deborah Chandler comes off the bench to contribute 7.1 ppg and 4.3 rebounds per outing.

Cedarville shoots .448 from the field including 178-of-425 attempts from the three-point line for a .419 mark. The Lady Jackets are deadly at the free throw line with a .782 team pct. CU leads NAIA II in both three-point and free throw shooting.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by 16.4 points per game while holding them to .365 shooting from the floor. The Lady Jackets are controlling the boards with a +6.8 margin.

The Tigers are led in scoring by 6-0 junior post player Sarah Watson with 14.9 points per game.

Katherine Hueter, a 5-11 guard/forward, adds 12.7 ppg with team-highs in rebounding (9.1 rpg), assists (61) and three-point field goals (20). Hueter is coming off a career-best 16 rebound performance on Saturday at Wooster.



Wittenberg is scoring 63.8 points per game and allowing 61.6 points per contest. The team is .423 from the field and .305 from behind the three-point line. The Tigers struggle at the free throw line hitting 200-of-325 for a .615 mark.

The Lady Jackets lead the all-time series with Wittenberg by a 10-4 margin. CU won last season's meeting 75-63 on Nov. 28, 2009 in Springfield. The two teams first met in women's basketball during the 1968-69 season with the Tigers posting a 52-34



### **Last Time Out**



NAIA Division II #16 Walsh was most impressive in a convincing 70-53 win at #9 Cedarville in handing the Lady Jackets their first American Mideast Conference setback on Saturday night.

The Cavaliers never trailed in winning their 10th straight game and they took advantage of a horrendous shooting night by the Jackets. Cedarville, who has consistently been one of the most accurate field goal percentage squads in the country, made just one of its first 16 shots and missed its first nine three-point attempts.



It was a 31-24 difference by the intermission and the bulge ballooned to 18 points midway through the second half. The Jackets shot a season-low 27.5 percent from the field and made just 6-of-32 three-pointers.

Rachel Hurley and Kayla Jenerette scored 10 points each for Cedarville, 15-5 overall and 6-1 AMC. Aubrey Siemon pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds.



"We back the Jackets!"



### Head Coach Kirk Martin





Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season and has built the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country. His teams have averaged 27 wins per season during his tenure.

Martin's team won the school's fifth American Mideast Conference championship in 2009-10 and finished 27-6 overall and 17-2 AMC. The Jackets were ranked No. 5 in the final NAIA Division II poll and ultimately advanced to the second round of the national tournament.

It was the second straight NAIA appearance for the CU women. They also earned an automatic berth in 2009 by fin-

ishing second in the demanding AMC.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year

Martin guided CU to five straight NAIA Division II national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets sport a 15-7 record at the event with a Final Four achievement in 2007, an Elite Eight effort in 2006 and two Sweet 16 showings.

Martin's club owned the American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2003 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Cedarville was rated No. 5 in the final 2006-07 NAIA Division II national poll en route to a 27-7 record. They held down the No. 1 position in 2005-06 which was the second straight year that the Lady Jackets accomplished the feat. They rolled to a 29-4 record overall which included a 19-game winning streak.

The Lady Jackets nearly met their ultimate goal of a national title in 2004-05 while posting a 35-2 record. Other highlights that season included an NAIA No. 1 ranking for the final six weeks of the season, a 22-game winning streak, and a second straight 18-0 run through the AMC South Division.

Martin's 2003-04 ball club produced a memorable campaign while being ranked as high as No. 2 in NAIA Division II. Among the team's many achievements were setting a school record for the most wins in a season with a 35-3 record, rolling to a perfect 18-0 league mark, and assembling a school-record 23-game winning streak.

Cedarville had a 31-3 overall record in the 2002-03 season, posted a 21-game winning streak, claimed the AMC South Division with a 17-1 mark, and won the inaugural AMC championship game. The Jackets were ranked as high as No. 3 in the country and qualified for the NAIA Division II national tournament for the first time in school history where the team advanced to the Sweet 16.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish 4th in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25. Cedarville qualified for the AMC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of the last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a six-time Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Martin serves as a lecturer in the Department of Exercise and Sport Science at Cedarville. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children: older daughter, Amy Fourman, who is a former Lady Jacket volleyball and basketball player, resides in Enon, Ohio with her husband, Aaron, along with their two children; younger daughter, Kelly Mangin, resides in Beavercreek, Ohio with her husband, Bryan, and their son; and son, Brent, is a former member of the Yellow Jacket golf and tennis teams, lives in Dayton with his wife, Rachel.



### Davenport Spends Third Week at Top of NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll

KANSAS CITY, Mo. - For the third-straight week, Davenport (Mich.) holds the top position on the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches' Top 25 Poll, the NAIA announced Monday. The Panthers, who are the only undefeated team remaining, collected all 16 possible first-place votes with 436 points. Northwestern (lowa) stays put at No. 2 with 422 points, while the rest of the top five received a shake up. Morningside (Iowa) jumped back to No. 3 with 408 points. Saint Francis (Ind.) moves up to No. 4 with 385 points and Black Hills State (S.D.) rounds out the top five with 374 points.

Head coach Mark Young has his top-ranked Davenport squad sitting at 23-0, 8-0 Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference. Playing their last seven of eight games at home, the Panthers hosted then-No. 14 Cornerstone (Mich.) on Jan. 19. Davenport secured an 81-61 victory over its conference foe, handing the Golden Eagles their third loss in league play. Following the Top-25 win, the Panthers manhandled Michigan-Dearborn at home on Jan. 22, by jumping out to a 59-27 lead at the break en route to the 107-68 win. No. 2 Northwestern (21-1, 12-0 Great Plains Athletic Conference) has strung together eight-straight wins since it was unseated from the top spot in the Jan. 10 poll. The Red Raiders ran off with a 98-76 win over then-No. 18 Briar Cliff (lowa) on Jan. 19. Senior guard Becca Hurley led the charge with a game-high 29 points. With that performance, she became just the fifth player in program history to score 2,000 career points. The Red Raiders finished off the week by defeating Midland (Neb.), 91-65, on Jan. 22.

Morningside (18-3, 9-2 GPAC) steps back into the No. 3 spot, replacing Sioux Falls (S.D.). The Mustangs have recovered from their 70-66 loss at home to Sioux Falls on Jan. 15 with three wins in-a-row. Chelsie Trask's 23-point outing powered an 81-62 win over Dakota Wesleyan (S.D.) on Jan. 19. Morningside then traveled to Doane (Neb.), where it locked up an 82-59 win against the Tigers on Jan. 22

Saint Francis (19-4, 8-1 Mid-Central College Conference) shifts up one spot to No. 4. The Cougars have won 10-consecutive games dating back to Dec. 22, including wins over Huntington (Ind.) and Bethel (Ind.) last week. USF survived a 65-63 scare against Huntington on Jan. 19, but had no problem defeating the Pilots 79-56 on Jan. 22. Down 24-23 at halftime, Black Hills State fought back to register a 62-53 win against Dickinson State (N.D.) on Jan. 21. The following day, the Yellow Jackets once again battled back from a first-half deficit and posted a 80-74 victory over then-No. 17 Minot State (N.D.) on Jan. 22.

Twelve conferences are represented on the Top 25 poll, led by the GPAC with five teams: Northwestern, Morningside, No. 6 Sioux Falls, Mount Marty and No. 20 Briar Cliff. Three leagues, American Mideast Conference, Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference and MCCC, had a trio of teams garner national ranking


