Today's Games

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Ohio Valley University Fighting Scots in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference doubleheader today at Lady Jacket Field.

Cedarville enters action today with a record of 20-9 (5-3 G-MAC) and a seven-game winning streak. CU swept visiting West Liberty in non-conference action yesterday by scores of 9-1 (6) and 13-1 (5).

Ohio Valley is 11-17 (2-4 G-MAC) including a pair of losses at the University of Charleston yesterday - 11-0 (5) and 4-0.

Cedarville's Nicole Davis, a junior third baseman/outfielder, continues to lead the team in hitting with a .394 mark. She has team-highs in hits (37), triples (6), runs (28), total bases (59) and slugging pct (.628). Davis is tied for second on the team in doubles (7) and is third in RBI's (18).



Rookie Christina Kirkpatrick is CU's second-leading hitter with a .376 average and a second-best eight stolen bases.

Kelsey Chapman, a senior catcher/pitcher, leads Cedarville in home runs (2) and runs batted in (28) with a second-best slugging percentage of .598. Chapman, batting .370 at the plate, is also 4-1 in the circle with an impressive 1.12 earned run average. She is CU's all-time leader in doubles (48), home runs (14) and RBI's (131).

Carlyn Hanzel is CU's fourth-leading hitter with a .351 batting average and a second-best 20 RBI's. The sophomore outfielder ranks third in total bases with 45 and slugging percentage with a .464 mark.

Junior Rachel Bull, ranked third all-time in stolen bases with 87, has a team-high 25 swipes in 27 attempts this season.

Junior hurler Courtnie Spain has an 8-4 record and a 1.81 ERA with a staff-best 73 K's in 69 2/3 innings of action. Classmate Cecelia DeBartolo is 8-3 on the year with a 3.65 earned run average.

Donna O'Bryant, a senior outfielder, is the leading run producer for Ohio Valley with seven doubles, three triples, a pair of HR's and 23 runs batted in.



Madison Wallace is the top hitter for the squad with a .369 batting average including 24 hits and six stolen bases.

The pitching staff is led by sophomore Kristine Brown with a 6-8 record, 12 complete games and 54 strikeouts in 91 innings.

Cedarville owns a 3-1 lead in the all-time series with the Fighting Scots. The teams split a twinbill last April 3 in Cedarville. The Lady Jackets took the first game 5-4 in nine innings while OVU captured game 2 by a 6-2 verdict.

Last Time Up

CEDARVILLE, Ohio - Jessica Palm drove in four runs and Carlyn Hanzel added three hits and three RBI's as Cedarville completed a non-conference sweep of West Liberty with a 13-1 romp yesterday afternoon. The Lady Jackets won the opener, 9-1.

Cedarville matched its run total with 22 hits while stretching its winning streak to seven in a row. Both games were halted early by the eight-run mercy rule.

Palm went 2-for-3 in the nightcap with her biggest hit a three-run double. Hanzel finished 3-for-3 with a double and three runs scored.

Rachel Bull, Nicole Davis, Christina Kirkpatrick, and Carol Anne Rice scored two runs each. While CU had just eight hits, they benefitted from seven walks and a hit batter.

Winning pitcher Cecelia DeBartolo, 8-3, allowed just one hit over 4 1/3 innings. Jennifer Spann recorded the final two outs.

It took a while for the Lady Jackets to get going in the first game. They went hitless in the opening three innings before ripping 14 hits over the final three frames.

Davis went 3-for-4 and equaled a school record with two triples. Kelsey Chapman was 3-for-4 with a triple, three runs scored, and two RBI's. Kirkpatrick and Shannon Muldowney contributed two hits apiece.

Courtnie Spain, 8-4, posted another win inside the circle. She surrendered just two hits and struck out six.

Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced an average of 24.7 victories per year including a school-record 35 wins in 2012. The Lady Jackets have produced three consecutive winning seasons for the first time in school history.



Rowe guided Cedarville to its second straight NCCAA Midwest Region championship in 2012 and their eighth national tournament appearance. His team was the Great Midwest Athletic Conference runner-up during the league's first year in 2013.

Rowe has coached one NCCAA National Player of the Year, six NCCAA All-Americans, and 25 All-Region performers. Ten of his players

have been recognized as scholar-athletes.

Prior to coming to Cedarville, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.

Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. All four of their children have graduated from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009.
