# Tonight's Game Preview

Kayla Jenerette's Weekly Blog

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Central State University Marauders tonight in a Great Midwest Athletic Conference game in the Callan Athletic Center as part of the annual Alumni and Li'l Sibs Weekend.

Cedarville, with an 8-8 record (4-2 G-MAC), has won five of their last six games including their most recent action - an 89-63 league win at Ohio Valley on Thursday, January 23.

Central State, 5-8 overall with a 1-5 mark in the G-MAC, snapped a six-game losing streak with a 91-83 conference win at Salem International on Thursday, January 23.

Head Coach Kirk Martin, in his 13th year with the Cedarville program, is 321-94 (.773). He has posted 11 20-win seasons with the Lady Jackets.

Cedarville is averaging 75.7 points per game while allowing opponents 72.6 points per outing. The Lady Jackets lead the G-MAC in free throw shooting (.739) and assists per game (17.6).

Senior Kayla Jenerette is one of three players hitting in double-digits for CU. The 5-4 guard continues to lead Cedarville with a 15 ppg scoring average. Jenerette, with a fourth-best career .802 mark at the free throw line, is 49-of-62 this year for an .814 effort. She paces the team with 33 three-point field goals and ranks fourth all-time with 225 long-range shots. Jenerette, with 1,637 career points, is just six tallies away from moving into #10 all-time at Cedarville.

Kaya Linkous, a 5-10 sophomore forward, is Cedarville's second-leading scorer at 11.8 ppg and rebounder at 5.3 boards per game. She is coming off a career-high 25-point effort in the victory at Ohio Valley.

The third Lady Jacket in double digits is junior Deborah Gordon. The 5-11 forward is adding 10.7 points per game while leading CU in rebounding with 7.1 boards per contest including a team-high 42 offensive caroms.

Junior guard Raegan Ryan is the team's fourth-leading scorer at 9.7 points per contest. She paces the squad in assists (74) and is tied for the lead in steals (21). Ryan has hit a third-best 18 field goals from behind the arc.

Kaysie Brittenham, a 5-9 sophomore guard, is averaging 7.6 points per game while hitting a second-best 24 three-point field goals with a .444 effort (24-54) - fourth-highest in the G-MAC.

Central State is under the direction of Head Coach Sheba Harris - a former Marauder who was a three-time NAIA I All-America selection.

CSU is scoring 72.2 points per game while allowing opponents 71.6 points per contest. The Marauders are hitting .400 from the field including just a .194 effort from behind the arc. Central State tops the G-MAC in rebounds per game (48.5) and defensive three-point field goal percentage (.245).

The offensive attack of the Marauders is paced by Iniquia Snell with 15.8 points per game. The 5-7 junior guard also leads the team with a .568 field goal percentage.

Jasmine Cooper, a 6-0 junior forward, is the top rebounder with 8.5 boards per night - second-best in the G-MAC. Sophomore guard Veronne Clark leads with 40 assists and 27 steals.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Marauders by a 21-16 margin. The Lady Jackets swept both games played last season - a 70-62 win on January 26 in Cedarville and a 75-54 verdict on February 19 at CSU.

### January 28, 2014

# **Last Time Out**



Kayla Linkous erupted for a career-high 25 points to lead five players in double figures as Cedarville hit the road to pound Ohio Valley, 89-63, in Great Midwest Athletic Conference action on Thursday, January 23 in Vienna, West Virginia. Cedarville has won five of its last

Linkous returned to the starting line-up and contributed big time. She went 8-for-10 from the field and converted 9-of-12 charity tosses.

Kayla Jenerette totaled 12 points, 5 assists, and 3 steals. Lauryn Robinson matched her season-high with 12 points.

Taylor Vander Plas scored 11 points while Raegan Ryan produced 10 points and 8 assists. Danielle Spiliotis vanked down 10 rebounds as CU won the battle of the boards, 43-36.

The Jackets shot 53 percent in the first half and hit four three-pointers for a 43-30 lead at the break. They hit 53 percent of their shots again in the second period and ballooned the spread to as much as 31 points.

Coach Martin summarized the game, ""I'm proud of this group. We've really been doing a great job of sharing the ball. We had five players in double figures, outrebounded them by seven on the boards, and held them to 31.7 percent shooting on the defensive end protecting the basket."

# Looking Ahead



Next week, the Lady Jackets begin a five-game G-MAC road trip. On Thursday, Feb. 6 CU will be at Davis & Elkins for a 5:30 pm tipoff with the Senators. Cedarville takes on Alderson Broaddus on Saturday, Feb. 8 in a 2:00 p.m. encounter against the Battlers. The following week is a critical two-game stretch - at Kentucky Wesleyan on Thursday, Feb. 13 (6:30 p.m.) and at Trevecca Nazarene on Saturday, Feb. 15 (3:00 p.m.). Cedarville travels to Salem International on Tuesday, Feb. 18 for a 5:00 p.m. tip-off with the Tigers in the game originally scheduled for January 25.



# Head Coach Kirk Martin

Kirk Martin has been the head women's basketball coach at Cedarville University since the 2001-02 season. After building the Lady Jackets into one of the top NAIA programs in the country, he has guided them to a successful transition in NCAA Division II.

Martin's teams have averaged 26 wins per season during his tenure. CU has amassed one NCCAA title, two NAIA Division II national runner-up finishes, and six conference championships.



Prior to Martin's arrival, the Lady Jackets had won 20 games in a season twice. He has accomplished the feat 11 times including back-to-back 35-win campaigns in 2004 and 2005.

Cedarville was 20-10 last winter in its first active NCAA season and posted a 24-8 mark during its NCAA provisional year in 2011-12. The Jackets captured the NCCAA Midwest Region banner each year, were the 2012 NCCAA runner-up, and also claimed the 2012 Ohio Independent Championship.

CU made its eighth and final appearance at the 2011 NAIA Division II National Tournament which featured a surprising run to the quarterfinals. The Lady Jackets knocked off perennial powers Saint Francis (Ind.) and Ozarks before losing to unbeaten Davenport to finish the season 24-10.

Martin guided Cedarville to five straight NAIA national tournament appearances from 2003 through 2007 including back-to-back runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. The Jackets ended up with a 17-8 record at the event with a semifinals achievement in 2007, quarterfinals efforts in 2006 and 2011, and two second round showings.

Martin's club owned American Mideast Conference titles from 2003 through 2007 assembling an 86-4 record during that timespan. CU ran off three straight undefeated league campaigns in the AMC South Division from 2004 through 2006 which included a conference-record 72-game winning streak.

Martin was able to lead a young Lady Jacket squad to a strong finish and the NCCAA national title in 2008. He was named the NCCAA National Coach of the Year.

Martin took over the coaching reigns at his alma mater in 2001-02 and promptly guided Cedarville to a 23-10 record - at the time a school record for the most wins in a single season. The Jackets posted a 15-5 mark to finish fourth in the 19-team AMC. They were the only league school to beat the top three teams in the standings and all three were ranked in the NAIA Division II Top 25.

Martin came to Cedarville after developing Southeastern High School into one of Ohio's elite Division IV girls' basketball programs. He brought with him an impressive list of credentials produced at a school where he was employed since graduating from Cedarville College in 1976. He earned his master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Dayton in 1982.

Martin coached Southeastern, located just eight miles away in South Charleston, Ohio, to a 297-34 record for a .897 winning percentage during a coaching career that spanned 1986-97 and 1999-2001. He led the Trojans to the Ohio Division IV state championship in 1996, one state runner-up finish, and to 11 Kenton Trace Conference championships including ten straight. Southeastern assembled a 162-game KTC winning streak, won all 11 district title games they ever played in, and advanced to the Division IV Sweet 16 in 11 of his last 12 years.

Martin never had a losing season at Southeastern and earned numerous honors for his team's accomplishments. He was tabbed state Coach of the Year in 1989, was twice named Southwest District Coach of the Year, was a four-time District 9 Coach of the Year, and was a sixtime Clark County Coach of the Year. He was inducted into the Cedarville University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998 for his coaching accomplishments.

Kirk and his wife, Vicki, reside in Springfield. The Martins have three married children, who along with their spouses are all CU graduates, and five grandchildren.

Christina Curtner has been named the G-MAC Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for the first time this season, and is the first Trojan to earn the honor this season. Curtner helped the Trojans stay on pace with Kentucky Wesleyan for the top spot in the G-MAC with a road victory over Ursuline on Saturday.

Curtner came close to posting a triple-double, scoring 16 points, pulling down nine rebounds and dishing out nine assists. She also added a pair of steals in the victory. Her single-game stats ranked eighth in scoring, fourth in rebounding, leader in assists, and third in three-pointers made in games played last week by G-MAC members.

The win propelled TNU to a current conference-best four-game win streak. The win also kept TNU in a tie for first place in the G-MAC standings with KWC at 7-1.

Curtner, who was G-MAC Athlete of the Week last season during conference play (2/11/13), is third on the team in scoring (10.9), third in rebounding (4.3), and leads the team in assists (4.1). Within the G-MAC she ranks fifth in assists, fourth in assist to turnover ratio, 12th in FT%, and 18th in scoring.


