THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Friends:

As you can see, our Bulletin this month emphasizes our Teacher Training Program. The relationship we now have with Central State College, will enable us to offer a B.A.degree to our students who complete the work at Cedarville, and at the same time qualified students may receive the B.S.in Education from Central State. With this cooperative arrangement between the schools we see no reason why our graduates can not be accepted as public school teachers in any state, providing of course, they meet the qualifications of both schools. We are encouraged by the number of young people who are taking advantage of this program in teacher training.

The enrollment for next fall continues to increase over anything which we have experienced so far. At the end of June the enrollment of new students was twice that of one year ago. At the present time we have 116 new applications. We have talked to others, and have heard from still more who indicated their interest in coming to Cedarville. We would urge any prospective student who plans to find a place in Cedarville next fall, to send in an application immediately. We are trying to provide adequate housing and class-room facilities for the increased student body.

As soon as classes closed last June, we began a remodeling program for the cafeteria. This will be completed by August 1, and will include an enlarged dining area, remodeled kitchen facilities and a completely changed exterior of the building. At the present time, the first section of the new dormitory is up to the second floor and we are now waiting for the flexicore so that the final stages of the building may be completed. The footers have been poured for the enlargement of Milner Chapel. In addition to all of this building, there are repairs and improvements being made on some of our existing buildings. All of this work is being done because of of the increased interest in this Christian liberal arts college. Pastors and people in our churches have encouraged us to go ahead with this enlargement program in order that we may train the young people who are interested in this type of education.

As you can well understand, all of this building and improvement will cost money. We have estimated that the buildings alone for this summer will run close to \$75,000. Within a few days, we hope to have printed material available, describing the method which we will use to finance these projects. This will give our friends an opportunity to invest their money in a cause which will not only bring them 5% interest on the investment, but will also put their money to work in giving a Christian education to many young people who are asking for it. If you are interested in investing your money in this manner, we will be happy to hear from you. Perhaps some who read these lines may have money which they can give to the Building Fund during these days when the need is so pressing.

As we consider God's blessing upon this school, we are reminded of a verse in Psalm 118, which says "This is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes." We look back over a few years and say "henceforth hath the Lord helped us," and on that basis, we can most certainly say henceforth we can expect Him to do greater things. We shall greatly appreciate your prayers as we plan for the future.
