## Tonight's Game Preview

The Cedarville University Yellow Jackets host the Wilberforce University Bulldogs tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. Tonight's game is the final regular season home game of the 2012-13 season.

Cedarville is 15-8 on the year including Tuesday's 79-61 league win over visiting Urbana University.

Wilberforce, an NAIA II independent program, brings a 10-17 record into tonight's game. The Bulldogs posted an 88-72 win against visiting UC-Clermont on Wednesday night.

Senior Zimmy Nwogbo, a 6-foot-7 forward, leads the Yellow Jackets in scoring and rebounding. Nwogbo, the reigning G-MAC Basketball Athlete of the Week, is putting in 18 ppg and bringing down 8 boards per game. He tops the CU squad with 26 blocked shots and is second with 31 steals. Nwogbo tops the Jacket squad with an impressive .654 field goal pct. on 151-of-231.

Senior guard Austin Foote is second on the team

in scoring with a 11.5 ppg average. He has produced a 34-38 (.895) effort from the free throw line and paces the team with 40 three-point field goals. Foote is eighth all-time at CU with 195 three-pointers and is 35th on the all-time scoring list with 1,163 points.

Zach Brown, a 6-foot-3 senior point guard, is the third Yellow Jacket in double figures with a 10.2 ppg scoring average. He leads Cedarville with 109 assists (4.7 apg). He is tied for second on the team with 32 three-point field goals.

Brian Grant, a 6-foot-8 junior, is averaging 7.9 points per game, a second-best 5.7 rebounds per contest and is connecting on 76-of-142 from the field for a .535 mark.



## Austin Foote's Latest Weekly Blog

#### February 11, 2013

Two weeks left of the regular season. Wow! I was recently reminded of how fast time passes when my professor announced that our mid-term test was next week. My first thought was, already? Are we really almost half way through my final semester as a Cedarville student and athlete? Time is fleeting and our lives are short no doubt. No wonder the Lord tells us to live everyday to its fullest. There is so much joy available to us through life in Him, but in all honesty little time to enjoy it. Whew, feel like I am about to start preaching so I will switch to a less somber note.

Our team continues to roll through our opponents. We have been playing our best basketball of the year. Defensively we have kept teams to a decent shooting percentage, turned the ball over less, and shared the ball really well. Oh, and we're finally shooting the ball well...could have used that a little earlier in the year. As I reminisce, I always wish we could have learned to play this well, as a team, earlier in the season. I actually hope that the teams that follow will learn to click with each other relatively quicker that we have. However, perhaps it is just the nature of the game where you continue to get better and better as time goes on. And you don't always want to be playing your best basketball at the beginning of the year because playing consistently well is hard to maintain. Your best play always wants to come during tournament time.

We have four more games until our conference tournament. If we succeed in beating our next two opponents then we will have solidified home court advantage during our conference tournament. Achieving smaller goals, such as home court advantage, Sophomore guard Marcus Reineke adds 7.8 ppg and a 23-25 effort (.920) from the charity stripe. He is hitting an outstanding 32-of-68 three-point field goals for a .471 mark - second-best all-time at CU in a single season.

Jason Cuffee, a 6-foot-4 sophomore guard, leads the team in long-range shooting with a .478 performance (32-of-67) - tops all-time at CU in a season. Cuffee is adding 7.7 points and 3.2 rebounds per game. He has a third-best 34 assists on the year.

Wilberforce is under the direction of head coach Terry Futrell a former assistant coach with the Yellow Jackets.

The top performer for the Bulldogs is 6-foot-4 freshman forward Sean Cassidy. He is scoring 16.1 points per game while adding 5.7 rebounds per night. Cassidy has hit 48 three-point field goals on the season.



Levert Bristol, a 6-foot-4 junior forward, is the leading rebounder for Wilberforce. He is bringing down 7 boards per game while adding 14.3 ppg. Bristol has played in seven games for the Bulldogs.

Rachaun Thompson, a 6-foot-1 junior guard, leads WU with 58 assists and 34 steals. He is hitting in double-digits with a 13 points per game mark. He is the most dangerous deep threat with 58 field goals behind the arc.

Tonight's game is the 82nd meeting all-time between the two long-time Greene County rivals. Cedarville holds a 62-19 edge including two wins last year - a 74-59 verdict at the Central State Classic on Dec. 2, 2011 and a 79-59 win on Feb. 7, 2012 at Cedarville.



First things first - Cedarville trailed Urbana 36-28 with under two minutes remaining in the first half. Cuffee completed an 8-0 run with a three-pointer and a jumper to knot the score at 36-36 at the break.

The Yellow Jackets scored the first five points of the second period and never trailed. It was 58-51 at the 9:15 mark when CU answered with a 19-8 spurt to put it out of reach.

Nwogbo racked up a double-double of 27 points and 11 rebounds to go along with three assists. Cuffee buried four threepointers and finished with a career-high 20 points.

Zach Brown dished out a game-high seven assists and came away with three steals. He and Marcus Reineke hit a pair of threepointers apiece.

The Jackets shot 58 percent from the field in the second half and were 6-of-11 outside the arc while outscoring Urbana, 43-25. The Blue Knights dip to 9-15 and 0-4 G-MAC.

## Looking Ahead

The Yellow Jackets final two regular season games are on the road. Cedarville travels to Central State on Tuesday, February 19 for a key Great Midwest Athletic Conference battle. The game, which determines the G-MAC regular season champion is scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. tip-off.

CU closes out the 2012-13 regular season with a non-league game in South Euclid, Ohio on Saturday, February 23 at Notre Dame College.

Cedarville will participate in the G-MAC postseason tournament to be held at the #1-seed from March 7-9, 2013.
