

### Today's Games

The Cedarville University softball team hosts the Walsh University Cavaliers in a doubleheader today at Lady Jacket Field. Cedarville, with a record of 24-13, had their seven-game winning streak snapped after dropping two games at Notre Dame OH on Saturday. Walsh, in transition to the NCAA II, is 24-12 on the season including splitting a doubleheader at Urbana on Thursday. A 2-1 setback in game one against the Blue Knights ended a Walsh 10-game winning streak.

Cedarville's Kelsey Wilson continues to provide a major portion of the offense in 2012. The sophomore outfielder/infielder is hitting .537 with a team-leading 65 base hits, 39 runs scored, 11 doubles, 36 RBI's, 93 total bases, a .769 slugging pct. and 23 stolen bases.

Junior Kenleigh Ludlow is second on the batting charts having steadily pushed her average to an impressive .419 mark. She is second to Wilson with 44 hits and 14 stolen bases.

Sophomore Shelby Young is the third-best hitter on the squad. The outfielder is hitting .364 with 43 base hits and five doubles while ranking second to Wilson in runs batted in with 28.

Sophomore Kelsey Warrington leads the Lady Jackets with four HR's while ranking third in runs batted in (26). She is second on the team lead in doubles (9) and total bases (58). Warrington is tied for first in the CU all-time home run category with nine.

The Cavaliers, under the direction of former Walsh pitcher Jaime (Aeschlimann) Porter - in her second season as head coach, are led offensively by senior pitcher/first baseman Kelsey Ford with a .444 batting average. She also paces the team with 57 total bases. Ford is 9-2 with a 2.69 ERA in 78 innings of action in the circle.



Walsh is hitting .351 as a team with 70 doubles, 11 triples and 13 HR's.

The Cavs leads the all-time series with Cedarville by a 26-14 margin. Walsh took two-of-three from CU last season including an 11-2 win in South Euclid, Ohio that eliminated the Lady Jackets from the AMC Tournament. The two teams also played to a 12-12 tie in the second game of a twinbill on March 30, 1996 one of just two ties in Cedarville's 28-year softball history.



#### Last Time Up

Notre Dame College continued its mastery of the Lady Jackets by cooling them off twice by scores of 5-4 and 6-2 on Saturday in South Euclid, Ohio.


The Falcons broke a 2-2 tie with two runs in the fourth inning of the opener. Shelby Young was 3for-4 with three RBI's. Kelsev Wilson had two doubles and scored twice.



Shelby Young Cedarville took a 1-0 advantage into the sixth

runs in the frame, three of which were unearned. Kenleigh Ludlow was 3-3 while Courtney Teague was 2-for-3 for the Lady Jackets, 24-13 overall.

The Falcons limped into their home opener with a record of 5-15 while Cedarville, on the other hand, had won seven straight and 14-of-15. With the outcomes. NDC has solved the Jackets nine straight times.

## Head Coach Wes Rowe



Wes Rowe has been the head softball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He is the school's 10th head coach since the fast-pitch program started in 1985.

Rowe's methodical rebuilding campaign has produced 87 victories thus far including a school-record 32 wins in 2011. He guided the Lady Jackets to their second NCCAA Midwest Region championship last spring and their seventh national tournament appearance.

Rowe took a young Lady Jacket squad and won 18 games during his inaugural campaign followed by 16 wins and then 21. He coached his three NCCAA All-Americans and has had eight scholar-athletes.

Prior to assuming his current position, Rowe was the girls softball varsity assistant coach for one year at Milan High School in Michigan. He served as head coach of the Michigan Dominators 18U travel team for three seasons.

Rowe's 2005 squad won four tournaments while the 2004 team placed 4th out of 44 teams at the USSSA World Series and earned the Sportsmanship Award in voting by all competing teams. His 2003 club finished 5th in the NSA World Series and 7th in the Super World Series.

Rowe was the assistant coach of the Michigan Mustangs 16U team in 2002 that finished as the USSSA World Series runner-up. He previously served as head coach of the Calvary Christian Academy baseball team in Ypsilanti, Mich. for the 2000 campaign.


Rowe is a 1978 graduate of Cedarville College. He was a starting outfielder during his four-year Yellow Jacket baseball career.

Wes and his wife, Ann, reside in Cedarville. They have had three of their children graduate from the University including Charissa, who was a four-year outfielder for the Lady Jackets from 2006 through 2009. Their son, Sam, is a senior at the University.

Kelsey Wilson returns for another season with the Lady Jackets following a stellar rookie
